Tonight: The Lugnuts look to right the ship after dropping the last three games to Great Lakes following a victory in the series opener, sending right-hander **Colin Peluse** to the mound against Great Lakes Loons right-hander Logan Boyer. Tonight marks the fifth game in a stretch of 12 home games in 13 days as well as the fifth meeting of 24 between the two teams this year.

Off the Field: The first 1,000 fans in attendance will receive the first of four 25th Anniversary Lugnuts Bobbleheads, a Mark Prior Bobblehead giveaway commemorating Prior's rehab starts in Lansing in 2004, presented by Sparrow. Tomorrow is a Capital City Market Kids Day, with Kids Run the Bases after the game.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB.TV with audio available online via <http://milb.streamguys1.com/lansing> featuring broadcasters **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jakska**.

Last Night: Loons 4, Lugnuts 2. The Loons scored four runs on five straight hits in the third inning against Lugnuts starter **Reid Birlingmair** and then hung on tight; Lansing stranded 13 runners on base, going 3-for-17 with runners in scoring position -- with only one of those three hits, a **Shane Selman** RBI triple, bringing home a run.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland Athletics, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Meet the Boss: **Scott Steinmann** is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

Roster Stability: The Nuts have made only one roster move this year, placing starting pitcher **Jeff Criswell** on the Injured List and adding relief pitcher **Brandon Withers** from Extended Spring Training on May 12th. In the process, Withers became the 835th player in team history.

Highs and Lows: The Lugnuts have scored at least seven runs in a game eight times this season... but have also scored two runs or fewer in a game on ten occasions, last night being the tenth, and the third straight game of two runs or fewer.

A Hail to Arms: The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.08 earned run average and has walked the fewest batters (65), struck out the most hitters (237) and recorded the best GO/AO ratio (1.47) in the league. In fact, the Lugnuts' GO/AO ratio rates third in MiLB behind Charlotte (1.59) and Rancho Cucamonga (1.55), and the Lugnuts' team ERA is seventh-best in all of the Minors.

A Breath of Relief: The bullpen has been a strength for the Lugnuts, with a 2.55 ERA and 152 strikeouts compared to 33 walks in 109 1/3 innings. **Jack Weisenburger** (Rockford H.S. / University of Michigan) has struck out 22 batters in just 9 2/3 innings, whiffing the side last night.

Offensive Impact: The Lugnuts lead the league in hits (174), total bases (293) and doubles (50), and rank second in slugging percentage (.404) and third in batting average (.236) and OPS (.721).

Thou Shalt Not: Stealing bases has been a difficult proposition against the Nuts, who have nabbed a league-best 12 runners in 29 attempts, led by **Drew Millas** throwing out eight of the 23 runners who've attempted to steal against him.

An Eagle Flying High: Infielder **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) is first in the league in HBPs (7), second in OBP (.429), second in runs scored (18), tied for second in steals (13), tied for second in extra-base hits (11), tied for third in doubles (7) and fifth in OPS (1.002).

Streiking: Outfielder **Michael Guldberg** enters play today on a 17-game on-base streak, hitting .299 (20-for-67) with six walks and two HBPs in that span. Infielder **Max Schuemann** is on a 16-game on-base streak (19-for-62, .306, with five walks and six HBPs).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2017: Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., blew his top, and the Lugnuts lost at home to the Loons, 5-3, on two Great Lakes runs in the ninth. Bo Bichette had tied the score at both 2-2 and 3-3 with RBI singles in the fifth and seventh innings respectively. After Keibert Ruiz and Gersel Pitre provided RBI singles for the Loons in the ninth, the Nuts put the tying runs at the corners for Vladdy, but Christian Stolo struck out the 18-year-old on the 11th pitch of an at-bat to end the game. Guerrero and his teammates argued that he had foul-tipped the pitch, which was smothered in the dirt by catcher Steve Berman, who was then inadvertently struck in the head by Guerrero's backswing and crumpled in a heap. The game's final image saw the Lugnuts swarming and shouting at home plate umpire Tanner Dobson, who hurriedly made his exit, while the downed Berman received medical attention.

Major League Lugnuts: Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher **Ty Tice** '18 and outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, with the duo making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals.

Familiar Settings: 14 of the 30 Lugnuts players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members **Scott Steinmann**, **Don Schulze** and **Anthony Phillips** all have experience in the league.

A Lineup of Starters: The Lugnuts have used nine starting pitchers this year, namely: **Seth Shuman** (May 4, May 15, May 27); **Brady Basso** (May 5, May 12, May 19, May 26); **Richard Guasch** (May 6, May 20); **Reid Birlingmair** (May 7, May 14, May 21, May 28); **Stevie Emanuels** (May 9, May 16, May 23); **Rafael Kelly** (May 11, May 18, May 25); **Jeff Criswell** (May 8); **Shohei Tomioka** (May 13); and **Colin Peluse** (May 22).

A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You: **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University, and **Jeff Criswell** (Portage Central H.S.) and **Jack Weisenburger** (Rockford H.S.) are the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverines to play in Lansing (following **Troy Miller**, **Jake Fox** and **Rich Hill**).

Finally: Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielders **Michael Guldberg** and **Jake Suddleson** are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. Outfielder **Jake Suddleson** and first baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (**Michael Guldberg**, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (**Brady Basso**, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (**Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger**, Michigan); Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (**Cobie Vance**, Alabama, and **Ryan Gridley**, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (**Stevie Emanuels**, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. **Jake Suddleson** and **Patrick McColl** played together at Harvard, **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and **Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger** pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year.



Last Outing: Made first start of the season, May 22nd - heavily anticipated prospect match-up vs. Fort Wayne southpaw Ethan Elliott never materialized, as Lugsnuts hammered Elliott for three solo home runs while Peluse gave up 10 hits and eight runs in 3 1/3 innings, en route to 12-7 Lugsnuts loss... allowed two hits but stranded the bases loaded in a scoreless 1st inning... gave up three runs on four hits in the 2nd, including a Grant Little two-run double... allowed a Jonny Homza solo home run in the 3rd... departed in the 4th with one out, one run in and the bases loaded, with new reliever Bryce Nightengale allowing all three inherited runners to score in a six-run TinCaps rally.

2021 in Lansing:

- Made 2021 debut by piggybacking Jeff Criswell and Shohei Tomioka on the fifth day of the season, Saturday, May 8th vs. Lake County, tossing three scoreless innings in the Lugsnuts' 2-0 four-hit shutout victory... worked with catcher William Simoneit, a fellow Demon Deacon, to form an all-Wake Forest battery... picked Bryan Lavastida off 1st base in the 6th inning... opened the ninth with two walks and was taken out in favor of Aiden McIntyre, who sewed up the win with two strikeouts and a comebacker.

- Pitched at Dayton, Saturday, May 15th... after Seth Shuman started and fired two perfect innings, twirled five strong innings of relief, allowing two hits and one run, one walk and seven strikeouts... gave up a Brian Rey solo homer while striking out the side in the 6th... departed with a 2-1 lead, but Michael Danielak gave up a two-run homer to Spillane in the 8th, leading to a 3-2 Lugsnuts loss.

Prospecting: Rated Baseball America's No. 26 A's prospect... "Not assigned to the alternate training site, Peluse committed to an at-home workout plan tailored to increase his leg strength and added 10 pounds of muscle. He arrived at instructional league showing significant velocity gains, much to the A's surprise... Peluse's fastball sat 96 mph and touched 98 at instructs, a marked increase from his low-90s readings in college. His slider was already a plus pitch, showing late life and more drop than a typical slider"... MLB Pipeline's No. 28 A's prospect, grading his fastball at 55, slider at 55, change-up at 50 and control at 45, writing about Peluse, "A ninth-round pick in 2019, Peluse has put himself on the prospect radar for the A's after showing up to the instructional league that consistently hit 97-98. Now carrying a power fastball, Peluse also brings a strong slider that flashes plus, as well as a changeup that is still developing. His command has always been solid going back to his days at Wake Forest, and it showed up in his debut season in the Class A Short Season New York-Penn League, walking just six batters across 24 innings. Approaching his first full season in the Minors in 2021, Peluse will get a chance to show what he can do with his improved repertoire. His repeatable delivery projects him to stick as a starter."

Draft Day: Taken 284th overall in the 9th round, 2019, and signed for \$149,300... highest of five Wake Forest players drafted in 2019... only one Demon Deacon was drafted in 2020, but it was Braves first-rounder Jared Shuster, taken 25th overall... one of 10 Lugsnuts drafted in 2019, including the 6th round (Seth Shuman), 7th round (Drew Millas), 10th round (Patrick McColl), 16th round (Brady Basso), 19th round (Jared McDonald), 20th round (Jack Weisenburger), 21st round (Shane Selman), 26th round (Elvis Peralta, Jr.) and 33rd round (Charles Hall)... college teammates with 2019 Lugsnuts third baseman Johnny Aiello.

Life as a Pro: Debuted with SS-A Vermont on June 28th, 2019... made four straight starts, not throwing more than three innings in any of them, and then moved to the pen, with five scoreless innings in relief July 27th... in final outing, struck out six in 3 2/3 at Lowell on August 8th.

College: Spent three years at Wake Forest University... began as a Tuesday starter as a freshman before moving to bullpen and pitching effectively (3.54 ERA, 20 G, 7 GS, 40 2/3 IP, 12 BB, 37 K), with three NCAA shutout Super Regional appearances at Florida... served as Sunday starter as sophomore and was Wake Forest's top starter statistically (3.87 ERA, 16 G, 14 GS, 83 2/3 IP, 26 BB, 63 K)... Friday starter as a junior (5.74 ERA, 15 GS, 80.0 IP, 12 HR, 36 BB, 71 K)... in total at Wake: 4.54 ERA, 51 G, 36 GS, 204 1/3 IP, 200 H, 21 HR, 74 BB, 171 K... pitched in summer ball for the Baltimore Redbirds in 2017 (6 G, 3 GS, 1.37 ERA, 26 1/3 IP, 4 ER, 7 BB, 21 K) and for the Chatham Anglers in 2018 (2.57 ERA, 2 G, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 4 BB, 10 K).

High School: At Middletown H.S., spent one year on wrestling team... was also a member of Sports Medicine and ROTC... in second start, junior year, on the Middletown Cavaliers baseball team, tossed no-hitter with 11 strikeouts at Wilmington Blue Rocks' Frawley Stadium, and then woke up the next day and couldn't move his arm... the injury led to Tommy John surgery, causing Peluse to miss entire senior season... still was rated No. 2 player in Delaware by Perfect Game.

Hometown: Middletown, Delaware, is in New Castle County, located in the northern part of the state just across from the Maryland border... it hosts the Olde Tyme Peach Festival each August and the Big Ball Marathon every Labor Day (a 24-hour baseball marathon for charity played with an oversized softball, the "big ball")... St. Andrew's School in Middletown was the site for the filming of Dead Poets Society (1989), starring Robin Williams, with the theater scene in the movie filmed at Middletown's Everett Theatre... there was also an episode of The West Wing filmed at St. Andrew's School... Tampa Bay wide receiver Chris Godwin is from Middletown and attended Middletown H.S.
