Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, play the fourth in a six-game series at the first half East Division champion Dayton Dragons, High-A affiliate of the Cincinnati Reds. The Lugnuts won the opener, but the Dragons have prevailed in each of the last two contests to tie the 15-game season series at 6-6.

Last Night: Dragons 7, Lugnuts 3. Mason Neville homered twice and Ryan McCrystal drilled a pair of RBI doubles, helping the Dragons overtake the Nuts in front of a Thursday night crowd of 7,527 at Day Air Ballpark. Nate Nankil knocked a two-run homer, his third home run of the season, in the loss.

Starting Spotlight: Pitt Panther Mitch Myers makes his third start for Lansing after returning to the Midwest League from Class-AA; Myers is returning from an Achilles injury that ended his season on June 1 last year. This is his eighth career appearance against the Dragons. Conversely, Kyle McCoy makes his first start against Lansing.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play Dayton through Sunday, take a day off, and then continue this two-week Ohio road trip to Lake County. The next home game: 16 days away.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 15 (Steven Echavarria), No. 17 (Zane Taylor), No. 22 (Nate Nankil) and No. 29 (Nathan Dettmer). Baseball America's re-ranking of A's prospects placed Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and Nathan Dettmer at No. 21.

Hello, Philadelphia! 2025 Lugnuts shortstop Leo De Vries was named to the American League All-Star Futures Game roster alongside fellow Athletics prospect / Midland RockHounds southpaw Jamie Arnold. The game will be held Sunday, July 12, at Citizens Bank Park. De Vries competed in the Futures Game last year, too, when he was in the Padres' organization... and struck out against Lugnuts alum Gage Jump.

Welcome to High-A: Following Midwest League debuts on Tuesday and Wednesday from catchers Logan Sauve and Bryan Arendt, OF Jake Reinisch went 1-for-3 with a single and a walk in his High-A debut last night, becoming the 1,004th all-time Lugnut. Next in line, P Ben Hansen, who was acquired via trade Wednesday from the Boston Red Sox for 2021-22 Lugnuts infielder Brett Harris.

TGIF: UT Gunner Gouldsmith is batting .452/.528/.548 (14-for-31, 1 HR) in Friday games.

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have utilized 21 position players and 23 different pitchers (plus position player Gunner Gouldsmith, who tossed a scoreless inning on May 8 at South Bend) this season.

Be Back Soon: Right-hander Tzu-Chen Sha has returned to Taiwan to fulfill a military obligation and is expected to rejoin the Lugnuts next week in Lake County.

Pitcher's Best Friend: These are the top two teams in the Midwest League at turning double plays, with the Lugnuts' total of 82 double plays in 76 games leading all of High-A, while the Dragons (76 double plays) rank second.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, Carlos Beltrán went on to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

JULY 3 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2013: The end for Roberto Osuna: 1 2/3 innings, 10 hits, 7 runs allowed at Lake County while Alex Anthopoulos watched, and then off to undergo Tommy John surgery. The Captains won, 10-5, behind 21 hits – with Logan Vick, Joseph Sever and Anthony Santander each collected four hits.

2024: In front of 9,917, the largest crowd in High-A this season – and larger than 29 of 30 Double-A teams and 17 of 30 Triple-A teams – the Lugnuts eked out a 2-1 victory over the Fort Wayne TinCaps at Jackson® Field™. Sahid Valenzuela delivered an RBI single in the third inning and Will Simpson followed two batters later with an RBI double off of Fort Wayne starter Jagger Haynes, supplying all of Lansing's offense.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... transferred to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.
