ABOUT LAST NIGHT...: The Vancouver Canadians used a trio of pitchers to shutout the Everett AquaSox (Mariners) 3-0 on Friday at Ron Tonkin Field, as the C's kept one of the most potent offenses in Minor League Baseball off-balance all night en route to their second consecutive win.

Right-hander Nick Fraze (W, 3-0) set the tone from the moment he took the mound. The Dallas, TX native needed just five pitches to set down the side in order in the opening frame and went on to twirl six scoreless stanzas in which he scattered two hits, walked one and struck out a season-high seven hitters. He has now logged three consecutive quality starts (six or more innings pitched, three earned runs or less) this season.

Vancouver got all the offense they needed in the bottom of the first. Luis De Los Santos led off with a single, stole second, went to third on a fly ball out and scored on a balk after disrupting starter Michael Limoncelli (L, 0-1) by feigning a steal of home. The inning continued with a walk, a base hit and a DJ Neal RBI infield single to make it 2-0.

Ryan Gold put the C's up 3-0 with a solo home run to start the bottom of the sixth for his second big fly of the year. He finished the day two for four.

After Fraze cruised through six stanzas, Brandon Eisert (H, 1) tossed a 1-2-3 seventh and navigated around a lead-off double in the eighth before Justin Maese (S, 2) escaped a two-on, two-out situation in the ninth by striking out Jack Larsen – the league's top hitter – to end the game and secure the second Canadians shutout of 2021.

FEELING SOXY: The Everett AquaSox (Mariners) hop into town this week for the first of 6 series between these two clubs, for a total of 36 head-to-head matchups. Everett will be a tall task for the C's; entering today, the Sox lead or are among leaders in all of Advanced-A in AVC (.247, 3rd), R (141, 2rd), H (183, 2rd), Te (317, 2rd), 2B (51, 1st), 3B (7, T-2rd), HR (23, T-5th), RBI (124, 3rd), BB (121, 2rd), OBP (.359, T-2rd), SLC (.427, 3rd) & OPS (.786, 2rd).

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

WALK IT LIKE THEY TALK IT: Vancouver leads all of Advanced-A with 129 walks. That number is good enough for sixth-most in all of Minor League Baseball and second-most for a team not based in the Low-A Southeast.

BLANKED: Last night's 3-0 win was the second time the C's have shutout an opponent and the first time Everett failed to score in a game this year.

GOOSE EGGS: The Vancouver pitching staff is in the midst of its longest scoreless stretch of the year; the C's last gave up a run in the seventh inning on Thursday, for a streak of 11.1 consecutive scoreless

DOWN SOUTHPAW: Despite hitting just .176 against left-handers this year, the Canadians are 2-0 in games started by a lefty.

BOUNCE BACK: After dropping the first two games of the series, Vancouver took game three 5-4 in walk-off fashion before last night's 3-0 effort. The C's have yet to lose more than two games in a row.

ON THE HILL: MLB.com's #9 Blue Jays prospect Adam Kloffenstein gets the ball for Vancouver tonight. After an electric start to the year in which he went 1-0 and allowed just one run in 12.1 innings pitched, the right-hander ran into some trouble in his last turn on May 22 against Hillsboro. That night, Kloffenstein surrendered a season-high seven runs on six hits with four walks in three innings pitched. Despite that, Kloffenstein has still limited opposing hitters to a .200 average this season. The 20-year-old has the potential to rocket through the Blue Jays system in the next two years with continued refinement of his four-pitch arsenal: a fastball, changeup, curveball and slider. He was one of the few players not at the alternate site to get significant playing time in 2020; the Jays gave him permission to pitch in the Independent Constellation Energy League in his home state of Texas where he faced much older hitters and gained valuable competitive experience. The Magnolia, TX native gave up a commitment to TCU to sign with Toronto as a third round pick in the 2018 draft.

Everett has tabbed southpaw Brandon Williamson as their starter. Ranked as the #10 Mariners prospect, Williamson turned in his worst outing of the year in his last start on May 22 in Spokane; that day, the 23-year-old surrendered four runs - the first he's allowed in three starts this year - on four hits in 4.2 innings pithced, though he did match a season-high with nine strikeouts. The lefty has commanding stuff; in his pro debut in 2019, he had one of the highest swing-and-miss rates in all of Minor League Baseball. This year his 26 strikeouts are the fifth-most in the High-A West. A native of Faimont, MN, Williamson was a second round pick in 2019 out of TCU.
