NEWS AND NOTES

FARM REPORT: In the updated Baseball America Top 100 Prospect Rankings released earlier today, the **Milwaukee Brewers have eight prospects currently inside the Top 100**, led by no. 4-overall prospect Jesus Made, who is slated to begin his season tonight with Double-A Biloxi. Four of the eight prospects are currently on Nashville's active roster: **INF Cooper Pratt** (#51), **INF Jett Williams** (#66), **RHP Logan Henderson** (#88), and **OF Luis Lara** (#99).

AS THE CROW FLIES: RHP Coleman Crow will make his second start of the season and fourth overall of his Triple-A career on Friday night for Nashville. The Brewers no. 27-rated prospect worked 4.2 IP last Saturday night in Norfolk where he allowed two earned on six hits with six strikeouts and a pair of walks.

PITCH CITY: Nashville spun their first shutout of the season with Thursday's 4-0 win. The club set a single-season franchise-high with 16 shutouts last year and led all of Triple-A in shutouts a season ago.

ZAMOR-A ZA BETTER: Infielder Freddy Zamora had himself a night as he went 2-for-3, with two RBI and added his first double of the season against the Knights. The 2025 Fan Favorite of the Year earned himself 18 multi-hit games for the Sounds last season and begins his 2026 campaign with multi-hit performances in each of his first two games played. **Dating back to the end of the 2025 season, Zamora has recorded four-straight**

multi-hit games and has hit safely in each of his last six Triple-A games since September 1, 2025. During the span, he is hitting .400 (10-for-25) with two doubles, two RBI, and three runs scored.

LARA-BOARD!: Outfielder Luis Lara knocked in another RBI in Thursday's game versus Charlotte and **tied Tyler Black and Greg Jones for the team lead with his fifth RBI of the year**. He now has a RBI in back-to-back games after having two different stretches of three-straight games with a RBI during his time with Double-A Biloxi last year, his last came August 20-22. The Brewers' no. 12-rated prospect (MLB Pipeline) set his single-season career-high with six straight games with a RBI from April 14-20 during the 2024 season at High-A Wisconsin. Even after his 1-for-4 night on Thursday, Lara is hitting .375 through six games and is tied for fourth in the International League with his nine hits.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Outfielder Eddys Leonard notched his third double of the season in four games with Nashville. Leonard currently leads the team in doubles (3) this season and is tied for second in the International League. Last season, Leonard hadn't seen his third double fall until April 23, 2025 against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp. He posted 18 doubles with Triple-A Gwinnett last season and has a single-season career-high of 32 doubles with High-A Great Lakes during the 2022 season.

STALL BALLIN': Right-hander Garrett Stallings made his first start of the season (two appearances) and shut the Knights offense down. He posted 3.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits, one walk and fanned two batters in the process. Stallings streak of tossing scoreless innings increases 3.1 IP after Thursday night. He set his single-season career-high last season with five consecutive games without allowing a run (6.1 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 4 K) from April 1-May 7, 2025, with Nashville.

DON'T STREZ: Peter Strzelecki tossed a clean sheet over his 1.2 IP in relief of Carlos Rodriguez. Strzelecki entered the game with the bases loaded and one out in the top of the fourth inning and induced a pair of groundouts to limit the damage. The right-hander posted seven scoreless appearances in his limited 18 games between Triple-A Indianapolis and Durham last year. Entering his appearance on Wednesday night, Strzelecki had allowed a .395 BAA with the bases loaded (17-for-43) and 37 RBI.

FITZ-MAGIC: After pitching two scoreless innings, LHP Brian Fitzpatrick has not allowed a run through his first two appearances of the season (3.0 IP). Fitzpatrick worked seven scoreless games during his 13-game stint with the Sounds to end the 2025 season. Six of the 14 earned runs he has allowed during his Triple-A tenure came in his Nashville debut on August 9 in 0.2 IP against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp. Since then, Fitzpatrick has not allowed more than two runs in any of his 14 appearances.
