YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Senators, 6-2. **Ryan Murphy** started and allowed one run, a solo homer by Brady House in the first, over five innings with six strikeouts to pick up his first win of 2024. Richmond tied the score, 1-1, in the second with an RBI groundout by **Adrián Sugastey**. In the fourth, the Flying Squirrels took a 2-1 lead when **Damon Dues** reached on an infield single and a throwing error allowed **Carter Howell** to score. Richmond scored four runs in the fourth to stretch the lead to 6-1. **Vaun Brown** hit a two run double and later scored on a wild pitch. **Will Wilson** brought in a run with a bases-loaded walk to cap the inning. Harrisburg closed the score to 6-2 in the sixth with a sacrifice fly by Cortland Lawson. **Wil Jensen** entered in the seventh and allowed one baserunner, a single in the ninth, over three innings with five strikeouts to close out the save. Dues reached base four times, going 3-for-4 with a walk. Howell had two hits, including a triple, and walked twice.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This is the first of three series between the two teams this season. The Senators come to Richmond for a six-game series from July 9-14. The Flying Squirrels return to Harrisburg for a six-game set from August 13-18. In 2023, the Flying Squirrels went 13-8 against the Senators, including a 3-6 mark at FNB Field and a 10-2 record at The Diamond.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS reached the postseason for the second consecutive season in 2022 and the fourth time in franchise history, winning the Southwest Division Second-Half title. They were eliminated by the Erie SeaWolves in the Southwest Division Series. The team went 74-64 overall, the second-best record in the Southwest Division. In the first half, the Flying Squirrels jumped out of the gate in first place for most of the first month of the season, but slid down the stretch and finished 33-36, fourth in the Southwest. In the second half, the Flying Squirrels surged to a 41-28 record, finishing three games ahead of Erie in first place. The Flying Squirrels spent 57 percent (79 games) of the season in first place in the division. Richmond's 74 wins this year were the third-most in franchise history and their .536 winning percentage was the second-best, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556). After starting this year 1-4, the Flying Squirrels are 4-3 in their last seven games.

THE SENATORS went 59-77 last year and finished in last place in the Southwest Division for the third consecutive season. This year, they started the season 1-5 but have won their last two games. They went 2-3 in last week's road series at Altoona. Among the Eastern League leaders, Dylan Crews is tied for second in RBIs (9) and Brady House is tied for fourth in hits (11). The Harrisburg roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF Dylan Crews (No. 1), 3B Brady House (No. 3), 3B Yohandy Morales (No. 4), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 8), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 17), RHP Cole Henry (No. 24) and C Israel Pineda (No. 25). Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes seven Harrisburg players, including Crews (No. 1), House (No. 3), Morales (No. 5), Hassell (No. 7), Pinckney (No. 19), Henry (No. 22) and LHP Andrew Alvarez (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Matt Frisbee makes his third appearance and his second start of the season. He pitched out of the bullpen in his season debut on April 7 at Somerset and threw three scoreless innings. On Saturday, he made his first start since 2022 and worked three innings against the RubberDucks and allowed three runs. In his 11 career outings against the Senators, Frisbee is 4-1 with a 2.55 ERA (12 ER/42.1), including going 4-1 with a 2.29 ERA (9 ER/35.1 IP) in his six starts. Frisbee is in his fourth season pitching with Richmond and has gone 17-14 with a 4.70 ERA in 67 games, including 38 starts. Frisbee has 234 strikeouts in his Richmond career, which is fifth-most in team history. He also ranks third in franchise history (min. 150 IP) with 8.60 K/9. On May 13, 2021, Frisbee threw six perfect innings in a combined no-hitter with Joey Marciano, Matt Seelinger and Patrick Ruotolo, the first nine-inning no hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise record with 13 strikeouts and allowed one hit, a fourth-inning single by rehabbing Red Sox outfielder Kiké Hernández, over six scoreless innings. Last year, Frisbee spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-0 with a 4.54 ERA in 27 appearances, his first season working primarily as a reliever. Frisbee was selected by the Giants in the 15th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of UNC Greensboro. For more on Frisbee, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Cole Henry makes his third start of the season. He made his season debut on April 6 against the SeaWolves and allowed four runs (three earned) over 1.2 innings. Last Saturday, he threw three hitless innings and walked four batters, allowing one unearned run. Dating back to 2022, Henry has pitched 19 games (15 starts) for the Senators, going 0-3 with a 5.01 ERA. He has faced the Flying Squirrels twice in his career. On May 12, 2022, he threw four innings and allowed one earned run with four strikeouts. He last faced Richmond on July 15, 2023 and worked two scoreless innings. Last season, Henry made 10 appearances (six starts) for the Senators, going 0-2 with a 10.31 ERA (21 ER/18.1 IP). Prior to last season, he had thoracic outlet syndrome surgery and missed the start of the season until May. He was added to Washington's 40-man roster after the season. Henry is rated by Baseball America as the No. 22 Nationals prospect and No. 24 by MLB.com. He was selected by the Nationals in the second round (55th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft out of LSU.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt hit his first homer of the year on Saturday night, a three-run shot to give the Flying Squirrels a lead in the third inning. His next game in the lineup, the series opener at Harrisburg on Tuesday, he added a solo homer in the second inning. Last year, Wyatt combined to hit 17 homers between High-A Eugene and Double-A Richmond, which was tied for fifth in the Giants organization. He hit nine homers in his 64 games with Richmond last season. Since his Double-A debut on June 14, 2023, Wyatt leads the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.250), SLG (.450) and OPS (.783), ranks second in homers (11) and third in RBIs (39).

GRANTING WISHES: Grant McCray has worked eight walks this season, which is tied for fourth in the Eastern League. After hitting .050 (1-for-20) in his first six games to open the season, he is batting .333 (4-for-12) with a homer, a double and three RBIs in his last three games. On Sunday afternoon at The Diamond against Akron, McCray hit his first Double-A homer, a three-run shot in the sixth to extend Richmond's lead in a 5-1 win. Last season with High-A Eugene, McCray hit 14 homers led the Northwest League in hits (126), totals bases (206), runs (101) and stolen bases (52).

GLOW SHOW ON THE ROAD: Jimmy Glowenke is batting .333 (7-for-21) in his five road games this season compared to .105 (2-for-19) at The Diamond. Last season with Richmond, Glowenke hit .323 (42-for-130, 7 HR, 28 RBI, .963 OPS) in his Double-A road games compared to .171 (20-for-117, 0 HR, 2 RBI, .501 OPS) in his 37 home games at The Diamond.

PAY YOUR DUES: In his six games for the Flying Squirrels this year, **Damon Dues** is batting .417 (5-for-12), which is the highest in the Eastern League (min. 15 PA). He has also walked six times and has a .611 on-base percentage, which is tops in the league (min. 15 PA). On Thursday, Dues reached base four times, going 3-for-4 with a walk. Dues signed with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent in 2021 out of Wright State University.

GRAND LARCENY: The Flying Squirrels are the only team in the Eastern League perfect in its stolen base attempts this season, going 13-for-13. The 12 stolen bases are tied for sixth in the league overall. **Brett Auerbach** is 4-for-4 in steal attempts and his four steals are tied for fifth in the league. In 2023, the Flying Squirrels were 124-for-153 (81.1 percent) in stolen base attempts, the highest percentage in franchise history, surpassing the previous record of 77.6 percent in 2021.

STRONG ARMS: The Richmond pitching staff has combined for 123 strikeouts this season, third-most in the Eastern League. Flying Squirrels starters have combined for a 3.06 ERA (16 ER/47.0 IP) this year, which is third-best in the league behind Akron (2.06) and Erie (2.66).

CLOSE CALLS: This season, the Flying Squirrels have played six games decided by one run, going 2-4 in those games. Their six one-run games are the most in the Eastern League this season. The Flying Squirrels began the season with a 5-4 loss at Somerset on April 5, lost 2-1 to Akron last Tuesday, won 2-1 on a walk-off error last Thursday against the RubberDucks, picked up a 3-2 win over Akron on Friday. Richmond lost 3-2 against Harrisburg to open this week' series before falling 5-4 on Wednesday night. Of the Flying Squirrels' seven losses this year, they have dropped four by one run, one by two runs and one by three runs.

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Reggie Crawford (No. 9), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20) and Sugastey (No. 24).
