

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones fell at the hands of the BlueClaws, 6-3, on Friday night...The loss means the best Brooklyn can salvage is a series split as Jersey Shore has taken three of the first four games of the set... The Phillies' High-A affiliate scattered their six runs across five different frames.. On the filp side, all of Brooklyn's scoring came in the 8th and 9th innings, proving to be too little, too late...C **Drake Osborn** enjoyed a multihit affair, as did IB-RF **Ryan Clifford**, who extended his hitting streak to six games in the defeat... Cyclones batters struck out a combined 16 times, good for the most in a single game this season.

WOODEN AIR CONDITIONER: Cyclones pitchers have created a ton of additional breeze via strikeouts in 2024...Entering play on Saturday, Brooklyn has registered 144 strikeouts in 109.1 innings, which is tied with Winston-Salem and Greenville (both of whom have played slightly more innings) for the most in the South Atlantic League...Not only have the Cyclones racked up the punchouts, they have limited walks, too...Brooklyn enters the day tied for the third-fewest free passes (44) in the circuit...As a team, the 'Clones have a 31.2% strikeout rate and a 9.5% walk rate.

WIZARD OF OS: C **Drake Osborn** has been unstoppable at the plate to start the 2024 season...On Friday, the 25-year-old reached base four times thanks to an error and went 2-for-3 at the dish with a double, a walk... Osborn has reached base safely in all seven games he's played, hitting .409 (9-22) with a 1.155 OPS and adding two doubles, a home run, and three RBI... Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 25 plate appearances, the Corpus Christi, Texas native leads the circuit in on-base percentage (.519) and is third in OPS (1.155).

CLIFF NOTES: 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford** enters Saturday's matchup on a personal and team season-high six-game hitting streak and 10-game onbase streak...Over the six-game hit streak since Saturday's doubleheader, the 20-year-old is 7-for-21 (.333) with two doubles, three RBI, and two walks...His on-base streak stretches since April 9...During that span, Clifford is 9-for-34 (.265) with four extra-base hits — including a home run — four RBI, and six walks.

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP Justin Lawson has been resplendent for the Cyclones out of the bullpen to start his professional career...The Mets' 15th-round pick in 2023 did not pitch after the draft but has tossed five shutout frames since debuting on April 9 vs. Asheville...The 23-yearold tossed three spotless frames for the save in his maiden appearance and needed just eight pitches for another save on Thursday...Lawson has thrown 73.7% (42/57) of his pitches for strikes and holds a 41.2% strikeout rate and a 5.9% walk rate.

GRAB SOME PINE: RHPs Calvin Ziegler, Jordany Ventura, Sean Reid-Foley, Justin Lawson, and Ben Simon united to punch out 18 Asheville batters in Sunday's walk-off victory...RHPs Calvin Ziegler, Josh Hejka, Dakota Hawkins, and Joshua Corneilly also combined to strike out 18 Wilmington hitters over 9.2 innings in April 7's loss at Wilmington...The 18 strikeouts by Cyclones pitching are the most for the franchise in a single game since July 23, 2016, vs. Aberdeen...RHP Justin Dunn (5), LHP Kyle Regnault (2), and RHP Nabil Crismatt (11) combined to whiff 18 IronBirds over 9.0 innings in a 7-2 win...The multiple contests with 18+ strikeouts are tied for the most by a Cyclones team since 2005...Brook-lyn also accomplished the feat in a pair of extra-inning games in 2016 and two nine-inning games in 2008...The single-game franchise mark for team strikeouts is 22 set in a 20-inning, 3-2 loss vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016.

HAVE A DAY, KIDI: INF **Nick Lorusso** enjoyed his best day as a Cyclone in Sunday's series finale against Asheville...The 2023 9th-round selection by the Mets belted a game-tying solo home run in the third and then followed suit with a walk-off blast with Brooklyn down to its final out in the ninth... The walk-off home run was the first for the Cyclones since C **Hayden Senger** clubbed a game-ending three-run home run in the bottom of the 12th in Brooklyn's 6-5 win over Hudson Valley on May 23, 2021...Lorusso also sandwiched a double between his two home runs, setting a new career high with three base hits.

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** stole another base in Sunday's series finale and is 8-for-8 to start the season...The eight swipes are tied for third in the South Atlantic League...Entering Saturday, De Los Santos is second on the Cyclones' all-time stolen base list (45)...He is three steals shy of matching UTL **Jaylen Palmer**'s (48) all-time record...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is seventh across the Minors for swipes

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn will play their first full six-game road series of 2024 against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore possess six of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Justin Crawford (4), SS Bryan Rincon (9), INF William Bergolla (12), OF Emaarion Boyd (17), OF Hendry Mendez (23), and LHP Samuel Aldegheri (24)...Last season, the BlueClaws won the season series against the Cyclones, 15-11, including a 11-6 record at ShoreTown Ballpark...Brooklyn leads the alltime series since 2021, 47-40 (.540).

(115)...He broke INF **Walter Rasquin**'s (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023.

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** powered his first extra-base hit and home run, as well as earning his first RBIs of 2024 in Game 1 on Saturday... The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in all three categories with 43 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 94 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Álvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

HOME OPENER: The Brooklyn Cyclones opened up their 66-game home schedule last Tuesday evening vs. Asheville with a 3-0 win...The shutout marked the first for Brooklyn in a home opener since a 3-0 victory in 11 years... The Cyclones last blanked an opponent in their home debut on June 20, 2013, vs. Aberdeen...RHP John Gant (5.0 IP), RHP Tim Peterson (2.2), and LHP John Mincone (1.1) combined for the win...The 'Clones are now 17-5 all-time in their first home game of the season.

YOUTH IS SERVED: Gilbert Gómez takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, **José**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

FAMILIAR FACES: Out of the 32 players on the Cyclones' current roster, 16 of them have previous experience playing on Coney Island...Jeffrey Colón, Joshua Cornielly, Felipe De La Cruz, Jordan Geber, Josh Hejka, Joey Lancellotti, and Jordany Ventura return to the bump, while Drake Osborn and Christian Pregent are holdovers behind the dish...Ryan Clifford, Mateo Gil, William Lugo, D'Andre Smith, and Junior Tilien are back in the infield, as Stanley Consuegra and Omar De Los Santos are set to roam the outfield.

GENIUNE DRAFT: Eight members of last summer's New York Mets' draft class are with the Cyclones early in 2024...Pregent returned to the roster, while second-round selection RHP **Brandon Sproat** and third-round pick two-way player **Nolan McLean** are scheduled to make their High-A debuts...RHP **Noah Hall** (7th), INF **Nick Lorusso** (9th), RHP **Brett Banks** (11th), RHP **Ben Simon** (13th), and RHP **Justin Lawson** (15th) round out the group...RHP **Dakota Hawkins**, who signed as an undrafted free agent, is also with the club.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Ryan Clifford** (No. 5), **Brandon Sproat** (11), **Nolan McLean** (15), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF **Wilfredo Lara** (23)... MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 93rd-best farmhand in all of baseball.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his first start of the year during Game 2 of last Saturday's doubleheader vs. Asheville...Did not allow a run on five hits over four innings... Did not walk a batter and tied a career-high with seven strikeouts...Plunked one batter and induced a double play... Tossed 59 pitches and 43 strikes (72.9%)...Relieved by RHP **Alan Perdomo** in the top of the fifth with Brooklyn leading, 3-0...Cyclones went on to win the finale, 3-1...Brooklyn also was victorious in the lid-lifter, 6-2.

GOING TO GLENDALE: Following the 2023 regular season, Geber was chosen to represent the New York Mets as a member of the Glendale Desert Dogs in the prestigious Arizona Fall League...In five starts, the 24-year-old compiled a 1-2 record with a 6.00 ERA (12 ER in 18.0 IP), walking only three and striking out 15...Geber played alongside former Cyclones RHP Nolan Clenney, RHP Brendan Hardy, INF **Rowdey Jordan**, RHP **Trey McLoughlin**, C **Kevin Parada**, INF **JT Schwartz**, and INF **D'Andre Smith**.

2023: Started the season with the Brooklyn Cyclones before landing on the 7-day injured list on May 14...Joined the Florida Complex League Mets on a rehab assignment on July 19...Made three appearances (two starts), allowing four runs on eight hits in 5.1 innings...Rehab transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 6...Went 0-1 with a 13.50 ERA (8 ER in 5.1 IP) in two outings (one start)...Reinstated from the IL on August 14...In seven appearances (three starts), Geber collected a 3-1 mark with a 4.59 ERA (17 ER in 33.1 IP) with Brooklyn...Transferred to Double-A Binghamton for the remainder of the season August 31...Did not allow a run on 14 hits over 18.0 innings in three games (one start) with the Rumble Ponies.

MOUNT HOKIE: Geber split his college career between Mount St. Mary's University (Emmitsburg, Md.)...Spent four seasons with the Mountaineers...Named to the All-Northeast Conference First Team as a reliever in 2021...Tallied a 2-3 clip with a 3.88 ERA (26 ER in 60.1 IP) with 68 K's in 11 outings (10 starts)...Transferred to Virginia Tech for his graduate season in 2022...Accrued a 1-2 record with a 5.40 ERA (21 ER in 35.0 IP) and 40 whiffs in 16 appearances (seven starts) for the Hokies.

FIRST DRAFT: Geber became one of the first two players to sign with a Major League franchise straightout of the brand new MLB Draft League in 2022...The 23-year-old was the first member of the Keys to sign with a parent club since the league formed prior to the 2021 season...Former Cyclones' RHP **Joe Joe Rodríguez** was the first MLB Draft Leaguer to sign.
