**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 9-7. Bowie scored three unearned runs in the first aided by two Richmond errors to take a 3-0 lead. **Will Wilson** hit a solo homer in the third inning to close the score to 3-1. John Rhodes hit a two-run homer in the fourth to extend the Baysox lead to 5-1. The Flying Squirrels closed back within a run in the fifth with an RBI single by Wilson, a run-scoring groundout by **Donovan Walton** and an RBI triple by **Shane Matheny**. The Baysox scored four runs in the seventh to stretch their lead to 9-4. Richmond scored runs in the eighth with a wild pitch and a sac fly by **Logan Wyatt** to pull within three. In the ninth, an **Andy Thomas** sac fly brought Richmond within two, but they stranded the potential tying runs on base.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Richmond won four-of-five in Bowie from April 25-29 and went 3-4 in a series at Prince George's Stadium from June 13-18. The two teams split the most recent series at The Diamond from July 4-9, with the Flying Squirrels taking the first three and the Baysox winning the last three. Richmond needs one win in the next two games to clinch a winning record against Bowie for the season.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 27-17 in their last 44 games since June 18. They went 2-4 in last week's series at Altoona and are 2-2 in this series against the Baysox. Over the last 49 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 2.97 ERA (61 ER/185.0 IP) and have allowed 13 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.81 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 386.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 526.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.61 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A and the 10th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors. In five games dating back to Sunday, the Richmond offense has scored 38 runs (7.6 per game), which is the second-most in the league in that stretch.

**THE BAYSOX** went 4-2 in last week's home series against the Sea Dogs after going 1-5 the previous week on the road against the Patriots. Bowie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including SS Jackson Holliday (No. 1), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 9), OF Jud Fabian (No. 14), 3B Max Wagner (No. 15), OF John Rhodes (No. 21), OF Billy Cook (No. 28) and RHP Alex Pham (No. 30). Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes six Baysox players, including Holliday (No. 1), Fabian (No. 10), Pham (No. 17), Wagner (No. 19), Beavers (No. 21) and Rhodes (No. 29). Holliday is also rated as the No. 1 prospect in baseball.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his 21st start of the season and his fourth against the Baysox. He last pitched on Sunday at Altoona and surrendered two runs over three innings in a no-decision, striking out three. He pitched at Prince George's Stadium on April 29 in the second game of a doubleheader and allowed one earned run over four innings. On June 15 in Bowie, Murphy was charged with a loss, allowing two runs in four innings. He also pitched against the Baysox on July 8 at The Diamond and received a loss after allowing four runs in two innings of work. Against the Baysox this year, Murphy is 0-2 with a 6.30 ERA (7 ER/10 IP). In his last 12 starts since June 4, Murphy is 0-5 with a 3.86 ERA (18 ER/42.0 IP) with 47 strikeouts and 18 walks. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect. **For more on Murphy, see page two.**

**FOR BOWIE:** Right-hander Tyler Wells makes his second Double-A start this year. Last time out, he threw 3.1 innings and allowed one run, a solo homer by Nick Yorke, on Saturday against the Sea Dogs. He has spent most of this season in the Orioles' starting rotation, going 7-6 with a 3.80 ERA. Through the end of his July when he was optioned to Bowie, Wells ranked tied for third in the majors in WHIP (1.02), but he was 1-2 with a 6.43 ERA in five July starts. Prior to the All-Star Break, Wells was 7-4 with a 3.18 ERA in 18 games (17 starts). In his three outings out of the All-Star Break, we went 0-2 with an 11.00 ERA with nine walks in nine innings. Wells was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 15th round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Cal State San Bernardino. He was selected by the Orioles in the 2020 Rule 5 Draft and made his MLB debut in April 2021.

**STARTING STRONG:** In last week's series, Richmond starting pitchers opened the set throwing 20 innings without allowing a run until the third inning on Saturday night. Last Tuesday, **Carson Seymour** held the Curve scoreless through five innings, allowing one hit with a season-high nine strikeouts. **Spencer Bivens** threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit, in his start last Wednesday night. Last Thursday, **Wil Jensen** allowed two hits over four scoreless innings, his third scoreless outing in three starts this season. **John Michael Bertrand** threw five scoreless innings in his start last Friday night. **Hayden Birdsong** made his Double-A debut last Saturday and threw two scoreless innings before allowing three runs in the third. **Ryan Murphy** allowed two runs in his three innings on Sunday afternoon. To open this week's series, Seymour picked up a win, allowing one run over five innings. On Wednesday, Bivens allowed one run over 3.1 innings. Bertrand surrendered one run over five innings on Thursday. Richmond starters have a 2.10 ERA (9 ER/38.2 IP) in 10 games since August 2.

**PLAYOFF CHASE:** With 32 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are leading the Southwest Division Second-Half standings by one game over the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half. Akron, Bowie and Harrisburg are all tied for third place entering play today, two games behind Richmond. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (343,162) and average attendance (6,475) this year. They are also 13th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

**ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN:** **Shane Matheny** has reached base 38 times in his last 16 games since July 25 (19 hits and 19 walks), hitting .358 (19-for-53) with two homers, four doubles, two triples and 12 RBIs adding a .521 on-base percentage. He is currently riding a 12-game on-base streak, which is tied for the fourth longest active streak in the league. In that stretch since July 29, Matheny has reached base 29 times, batting .366 (15-for-41) with 14 walks and a .518 on-base percentage. He also has a seven-game hit streak dating back to August 4. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 127 walks, moving ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

**GLDW SHOW:** Over his last 26 games since July 1, **Jimmy Glownke** is batting .310 (27-for-87) with four homers, seven doubles, 20 RBIs and nine walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On July 29 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He is hitting .389 (7-for-18) in his last six games since August 2 with two doubles, three walks and six RBIs.

**LOGAN'S LIFTOFF:** On Tuesday night, **Logan Wyatt** drove a three-run, go-ahead homer. It was his 12th-overall home run of the season, which is the seventh-most in the Giants minor leagues. It was also his first home run since he went deep three times in a five-game stretch from June 23-30, snapping a 26-game homerless drought. Over a 21-game stretch from July 6-August 5, Wyatt hit .156 (10-for-64) with eight walks and four RBIs. In his last five games since August 6, he is batting .353 (6-for-17) with a homer and five RBIs and four runs scored.

**A ROBUST RETURN:** **Sean Roby** is slated to play his first game for the Flying Squirrels this season. Last year, he set several franchise records, including the team's single-season home run record with 25 in just 89 games. After missing the start of the season with an injury, Roby has homered 12 times in 41 games between the ACL Giants Black and the High-A Eugene Emeralds. On Thursday, he homered twice, including a walk-off home run, in his last game with Eugene before rejoining Richmond.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 5 - on IL), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 7), RHP **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 12), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 16), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and **Jose Cruz** as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
