Today: The Lugnuts play the third in a six-game series with the archival Whitecaps at LMCU Ballpark, coming off losses in the first two games of the series. The two ballclubs first met in mid April in Lansing, where the Lugnuts dropped three straight games but recovered to win both games over the weekend to earn a six-game split.

Starting Matchup: The Nuts start right-hander **Mitch Myers**, Oakland's 12th-round selection in 2021 from Pitt who is coming off quality starts in each of his last two outings. The Whitecaps counter with Midwest League veteran right-hander **Wilkel Hernandez**, in his seventh appearance of the year.

Last Night: Whitecaps 9, Lugnuts 3. After collecting 17 hits in a 14-5 victory in the series opener, West Michigan came right back with 13 more hits in another romp, keyed by a five-run third inning that featured four consecutive two-out doubles off **Christian Fernandez**, wiping out an early 3-0 Lugnuts lead. **Justice Bigbie** walked, singled, doubled and homered in the winning cause for the Caps.

Hail to the Newcomer: Prior to yesterday's game, outfielder **Caeden Trenkle** was placed on the Injured List and outfielder **Clark Elliott** joined the squad from Single-A Stockton in a corresponding move. The 22-year-old Elliott starred at the University of Michigan, where he was named All-Big Ten 1st Team and the 2022 Big Ten Tournament's Most Outstanding Player en route to becoming the Athletics' 2nd round competitive balance (Round B) selection, 69th overall, in the 2022 draft. He is the no. 4 outfielder prospect in the organization (behind **Lawrence Butler**, **Denzel Clarke** and **Henry Bolte**) and the no. 16 prospect overall according to MLB Pipeline.

Happy Birthday! Infielder **Euribiel Ángeles** turns 21 years old today. Meanwhile, **Daniel Susac's** 22nd birthday is three days away and **Jack Owen's** 25th birthday arrives on the 26th.

Excelling in Texas: P **Grant Holman** made his Double-A debut yesterday with five strikeouts in two scoreless innings for the Midland RockHounds. In eight combined appearances between Lansing and Midland this year, the 2021 sixth-rounder has pitched 11 1/3 scoreless innings with 18 strikeouts and only four walks and six hits allowed (a WHIP of 0.79 and an average of .132 allowed).

Elsewhere in the System: In Triple-A, 2021 Nut (and former Eastern Michigan Eagle) **Max Schuemann** went 4-for-4 with two doubles, improving his average to .326 with the Aviators. And in Single-A, the Stockton Ports enjoyed a combined one-hit 2-1 victory behind **Jose Dicochea** (5 IP, 1 hit, 1 walk, 5 K's) **Jake Pfennigs** (3 2/3 hitless innings, 4 walks, 6 K's) and **Carlos Guarate** (1/3 IP). Dicochea, the ace of the Stockton staff, boasts a 2.14 ERA.

Streaking: Catcher **Daniel Susac** went 0-for-3 with a walk yesterday, reaching base for the 11th straight game. It was also his fifth straight game drawing a free pass. On the other side, infielder **Jack Winkler** finished 0-for-4, ending his own streak at 12 games.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Ángeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

2017: Justin Maese tossed a nine-inning complete game, striking out seven and allowing five hits, one walk and a second-inning run on 103 pitches (69 for strikes) in a 4-1 victory at Kane County. It was Maese's second of what would become three complete games for the year as well as the Lugnuts' 1,499th victory as a franchise. The former third-round pick spent last year pitching in Double-A for the Braves and is currently this year with Somerset (Double-A, Yankees, Eastern League).

In a Nutshell: Opened season as the Lugnuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though once again received a no-decision... the last Pitt Panther to start a game for the Nuts was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st overall pick in 2016, who made two starts for Lansing in 2016 and is now in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9 on social media.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

College Journey: Initially committed to University of Alabama, joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros)... upon transferring to Pitt, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.
