JUMBO SERIES: Jacksonville makes their second trip to Nashville this season and first since the three-game weekend series to begin the 2025 campaign. The Jumbo Shrimp claimed the International League First Half Championship with a record of 47-28 and are tied with Indianapolis for the best overall record in the International League at 65-42. The Sounds are 3-6 against Jacksonville this season and enter the series having dropped three straight in their last series on the road in Jacksonville.

CAR GO: Brewers' no. 24-rated prospect Carlos Rodríguez will make his 12th Triple-A start for Nashville to start the series on Tuesday night at First Horizon Park. He was the Opening Day starter for Nashville against Jacksonville and went 5.0 IP (3 H, R, 7 K)

FOUR MORE: Sounds' manager Rick Sweet enters the start of the Jacksonville series four wins away from passing Buddy Bailey for the third-most managerial wins in Minor League history. Sweet owns a career record of 2,414-2,216 and is already the Sounds all-time winningest manager.

BIG BRUCE: Bruce Zimmermann worked another solid 6.0 IP in the series finale Sunday against the RailRiders. The left-hander set his season-high with seven strikeouts, and the most he has collected since a six-strikeout game against the Durham Bulls on July 13. The seven strikeouts were four shy of his career-high 11, which he has recorded three times over his professional career. After Sunday's start, Zimmermann has worked 6+ innings over three consecutive outings for just the second time in his career. He last did it from May 26-June 18, 2023 with Triple-A Norfolk.

HOW DAZ HE DO IT: Daz Cameron continues to be one of the most dangerous hitters in the International League after Sunday afternoon's performance against the RailRiders. The outfielder blasted his 12th homer of the season, and his sixth since rejoining the Sounds roster on July 9. Cameron extended his hitting streak to five games and on-base streak to 16 games. He recently lost a season-high nine-game hitting streak on July 24, where he hit over .400 during that span. Against the RailRiders, Cameron was arguably the best offensive player for Nashville, going 6-for-15 with two extra-base hits and five RBI.

JUST HIM: Right-hander Justin Yeager came out of the bullpen for Nashville on Sunday afternoon and tossed another scoreless outing. He earned a strikeout over 0.2 perfect innings. Since being called up to Nashville in late July, Yeager owns a 0.00 ERA over 6 games and 5.2 IP, adding on six strikeouts and just two hits allowed. Yeager has not allowed an earned run since 6/28, going back to when he was with Double-A Biloxi. Over that span, Yeager has gone 11.1 innings without letting up an earned run and one run total with eight strikeouts.

ONE-RUN LOSSES: One-run games were a bit of a struggle for the Nashville Sounds early in the year and have continued to be over the team's last two months. Over Nashville's last 17 one-run games the Sounds are 7-10, including two one-run losses this past week to the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders. To begin the season, Nashville was under .500 through their first 10 one-run games with a 4-6 record. The Sounds offense is towards the bottom of the International League when trailing. The team ranks 15th in AVG in that category (.229) and have driven in just 122 runs in 61 games, 17th in the IL. The power numbers have shown to dip when the team trails, owning a .352 SLG, but does an effective job of working their way on base with a .334 OBP. In 31 total one-run games, Nashville is 14-17, but just 5-13 on the road including two losses this week to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

STEALING WITH FRIENDS: Raynel Delgado stole his 30th base of the season in game two of the doubleheader on Friday night and another in the series finale in Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on Sunday. He ranks fifth in the International League and T-8th in Triple-A with 31 steals. He joined Jared Oliva (32) with 30+ steals on the year. The pair are the first set of Nashville teammates since 2009 to have 30+ steals in the same season, and only the 4th set of Nashville teammates since 1988. Drew Avans is tied for 4th in Triple-A this season with 34 steals, including the 16 he had with Las Vegas to begin the season. Delgado/Oliva join the following Nashville teammates to have 30+ steals in the same season.
