### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On June 15, 2016, the Sounds routed Memphis 16-3 at First Tennessee Park. Nashville had a huge lead early after scoring eight runs in the third inning to make it 12-0. Andrew Lambo boasted a 4-for-5 game with a triple and 5 RBI. Chad Pinder, Ryon Healy and Joey Wendle also had 3 hit days. Dillon Overton (7.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R 0 ER, 6 K) took the win.

**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds play the Memphis Redbirds in game two of a six-game series. Memphis took yesterday's series opener 7-3 behind homers from Ali Sanchez and Conner Capel. Birthday boy Josh Lindblom starts for Nashville, facing James Naile for Memphis.

**Josh Lindblom:** Celebrating his 35th birthday, Josh Lindblom starts for the Sounds in tonight's contest. The right-hander is 1-4 with a 4.13 ERA (56.2 IP/26 ER) in 11 games (10 starts) for Nashville this season. He took his third consecutive loss in his last outing on June 9 vs. Norfolk, working 5.0 innings in game one of a Thursday doubleheader. Lindblom gave up four runs (all earned) on five hits and three walks. The Lafayette, Ind. native struck out five Tides on 97 pitches (62 strikes). Despite his recent struggles, Lindblom holds the eighth-best WHIP (1.24) in the International League among qualified pitchers. He also has the ninth-best ERA in the league. Lindblom was a MiLB.com Organization All-Star with Nashville in 2021, going 5-4 with a 3.10 ERA in 22 games (20 starts). He also pitched in eight games for Milwaukee last season, ending with a 9.72 ERA in 16.2 innings. Lindblom signed as a free agent with Milwaukee following the 2019 season. He was originally drafted by the Dodgers in the Second Round of the 2009 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Purdue University.

**James Naile:** 29-year-old James Naile goes for Memphis in game two of the six-game set. In his seventh professional season, Naile is 2-2 with a 3.68 ERA (36.2 IP/15 ER) in 23 games (2 starts) with the Redbirds this year. Naile appeared in relief on June 10 vs. Durham. He pitched 2.0 innings, allowing a run (earned) on four hits in Memphis' 4-0 loss. His last start came on June 3 at Charlotte (4.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 3 K). A Missouri native, Naile signed with the Cardinals as a free agent in March. He went 8-0 with a 4.04 ERA in 51 appearances (no starts) with Triple-A Las Vegas in the Athletics organization in 2021. Naile totaled 26 starts for the Sounds in 2016 and 2018, going 8-11 with a 4.79 ERA. He was drafted by Oakland in the 20th Round of the 2015 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of UAB.

**2022 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 50, Second: 11, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Superlatives:** Yesterday, the Sounds dropped to 6-5 in series openers and 16-14 in road games...13-6 against NL affiliates...15-18 when allowing at least one home run and 12-20 when opponents score 4+ runs.

**On The Road Again:** Nashville enters tonight's game with a 16-14 record on the road, as compared to 20-10 at home. Despite the W/L difference, Sounds hitters have a .416 slugging percentage and .754 OPS on the road compared to .389 and .743 at home. Mario Feliciano (.347, 26-for-75) and David Dahl (.301, 28-for-93) are leading the Sounds offensively away from home.

**Walking in Memphis:** Jon Singleton picked up his league-leading 46th walk in last night's 7-3 loss to the Redbirds. The lefty has walked at least once in each of his last seven games.

**Clutch RBI for Tyler White:** Infielder/DH Tyler White collected two more RBI Saturday night and has a team-high 9 multi-RBI games. Both RBI on Saturday were with two outs to bring White's two-out RBI total to 15 on the season - also a team-high. With running in scoring position this year, White is hitting .298 (14-for-47). In his last 12 games, the North Carolina native is batting .300 (12-for-40) with 7 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 9 RBI and 6 walks.

**Hangin' On:** The Sounds' lead in the International League West Division is down to a half game over the Memphis Redbirds. Nashville has had the top spot to themselves since their 4-3 win over Norfolk on May 5 (35 games).

**The Nashville List:** Saturday's win for Rick Sweet was his 183rd as manager of the Nashville Sounds. It's the sixth-most managerial wins in franchise history. Pete Mackanin is fifth on the list with 186 wins.

**He Gets On Base:** Jonathan Davis' 23-game on-base streak came to an end in yesterday's 0-for-4 night. Despite this, the outfielder has the second-best OBP in the International League (.412), trailing only Worcester's Rob Refsnyder's .429 on-base percentage.

**Earn It:** Despite yesterday's loss, the Nashville pitching staff leads Triple-A with a 3.69 ERA. Buffalo checks in at second with a 4.03 ERA. The Sounds also lead Triple-A with eight shutouts.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

**LAST OUTING:** Lindblom took the loss in game one of a doubleheader vs. Norfolk on June 9. Pitching 5.0 innings, he allowed four runs (all earned) on five hits and three walks. Lindblom notched five strikeouts, with 62 of his 97 pitches being strikes.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Lindblom has faced the Redbirds a total of 11 times in his career. Overall, he is 5-0 with a 3.38 ERA in nine starts, facing Memphis in 2009 and 2010 with Albuquerque, 2013 with Round Rock and 2021 with the Sounds. Last season, Lindblom won both of his starts against the Redbirds (12.0 IP, 12 H, 6 R, 5 ER, 3 BB, 17 K). He set a career-high of 12 strikeouts in his last start against Memphis, on August 20, 2021.

- Tossed 5.0 shutout innings in his first start of the year on 4/9 vs. Durham.
