YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Yard Goats, 9-6. Trailing, 6-4, entering the seventh, Richmond scored five runs to take the lead. **Ismael Munguia** and **Yoshi Tsutsugo** hit RBI singles to tie the game. **Brady Whalen** hit a go-ahead, two-run single and **Victor Bericoto** singled in a run to open a 9-6 lead. Relievers **Mat Olsen**, **Wil Jensen** and **Ben Madison** worked through the final four innings to close out the game. Richmond took a 1-0 lead in the first on a double-play groundout by Tsutsugo, but Hartford's Jordan Beck tied the game with an RBI double in the bottom of the first. In the second, the Yard Goats scored three runs to take a 4-1 lead. Munguia brought in a run with a sac fly in the fourth to close the gap to two. In the fifth, Bericoto and **Logan Wyatt** each drove in a run to the game, 4-4. In the fifth, the Yard Goats took a 6-4 lead with a two-run homer by Drew Romo. Richmond closed the series with four wins in the final five games.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from May 16-21 and split another six-game series at Canal Park from July 18-23 coming out of the All-Star Break.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 38-26 in their last 64 games since June 18, tied with Somerset for the best record in the Eastern League in that span. They went 6-6 on the last road trip to Portland at Hartford, including winning four-of-the-last-five in Hartford last week. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 4.00 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 462.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 623.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.84 ERA, which is the fourth-lowest in Double-A. Richmond hitters have homered 24 times over the last 12 games since August 22, which is the most in the minors during that time frame.

THE RUBBERDUCKS have gone 5-2 in their last seven games but are 6-9 in their last 15 games, including dropping six straight from August 18-24. Akron's roster includes two of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including 2B Juan Brito (No. 7) and OF Petey Halpin (No. 22). MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes six Akron players, including Brito (No. 6), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 19), Halpin (No. 20), LHP Doug Nikhazy (No. 26), LHP Will Dion (No. 27) and INF Milan Teletino (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his 25th start of the season and his third against the RubberDucks. He last pitched last Wednesday at Hartford and threw five scoreless innings. Murphy has matched his season high in innings pitched (5.0) in each of his last two starts. In three starts since August 18, Murphy has posted a 1.29 ERA (4 ER/23.1 IP). Over his last 16 starts since June 4, Murphy has gone 0-6 with a 3.30 ERA (22 ER/60.0 IP) and 63 strikeouts, lowering his season ERA from 6.15 to 4.32. He first faced the RubberDucks on May 18 at The Diamond and allowed one run in three innings with five strikeouts and four walks. He pitched at Canal Park on July 19 and allowed two runs (one earned) over four innings with five strikeouts in a loss. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect. **For more on Murphy, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Will Dion makes his 14th Double-A start and his second against Richmond. Last time out, he pitched four innings and allowed two runs with a Double-A-high eight strikeouts against the Baysox in Akron on Wednesday. In his last five outings dating back to August 5, Dion has posted a 1.54 ERA (4 ER/23.1 IP). On July 19 against Richmond at Canal Park, Dion tossed six scoreless innings, allowing two hits with seven strikeouts. Dion was selected by Cleveland in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of McNeese State. Last year between Low-A Lynchburg and High-A Lake County, Dion went 8-5 with a 2.11 ERA in 25 starts. He was named a Carolina League Post-Season All-Star and an MLB.com Guardians Organization All-Star. Dion began this season with High-A Lake County and went 3-0 with a 1.87 ERA in nine outings (four starts).

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 12 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are in second place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, one game behind the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half, and two games ahead of the Bowie Baysox. Akron is six games back in fourth. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels have homered 24 times in their last 12 games dating back to August 22, which is the most in the minors during that span. Last Thursday in Hartford, the Richmond hitters combined for eight home runs, which set a new single-game franchise record. It was also tied for the most homers by a team in a single game in the minors this year, even with an eight-homer performance by Sugar Land at Albuquerque on May 7. It was also the most homers in an Eastern League game since the Harrisburg Senators homered eight times at Erie on June 18, 2006.

HIT PARADE: Since Thursday, the Richmond offense leads the league in batting average (.331), hits (52), runs (38), total bases (89), doubles (10), homers (9), RBIs (37), OBP (.411), SLG (.567) and OPS (.978). They have picked up 15-or-more hits in three-of-their-last-four games. On Thursday, the Flying Squirrels scored 17 runs on 15 hits. On Friday, they scored 10 runs on 15 hits. They closed the long road trip with nine runs on 16 hits on Sunday afternoon at Hartford.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Of the Flying Squirrels' last 10 wins, they have scored the winning run in the seventh inning or later in seven of them. On August 17, **Victor Bericoto** hit a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning the beat Harrisburg after Richmond entered the inning trailing, 6-2, tying the largest ninth-inning comeback in franchise history. On August 19 against the Senators, **Sean Roby** won the game with a walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth. On August 23 at Portland, **Jimmy Glowenke** hit a go-ahead single in the top of the ninth inning at Portland to give Richmond a 9-8 win. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader at Hadlock Field, the Flying Squirrels rallied after trailing, 8-6, down to their final out in the seventh before **Brady Whalen** and Bericoto hit back-to-back homers to tie the game and **Logan Wyatt** hit a two-run, pinch-hit homer for a 10-8 win. On Wednesday at Hartford, Wyatt broke a 4-4 tie with a solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. On Saturday night, **Will Wilson** hit a go-ahead single in the eighth, starting a burst of seven runs over the next two innings in a 10-3 win. In the series finale at Hartford on Sunday afternoon, Richmond scored five runs in the seventh to take a 9-6 lead and won by that score.

BERICOTO BASHING: **Victor Bericoto** has homered six times in his last 10 games dating back to Thursday. In his last 16 games since August 16, Bericoto is batting .333 (20-for-60) with six homers, five doubles and 18 RBIs. On August 17 against Harrisburg, he hit walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap a four-run comeback, which was tied for the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. On August 24 at Portland, he homered and drove in two runs. He added another homer on August 26 at Portland. Bericoto hit a game-tying homer in the last inning of Game 2 of the August 27 doubleheader at Portland. Last Wednesday, he hit a two-run homer at Hartford. On the year, Bericoto leads the Giants system with 25 homers (16 with Eugene and nine with Richmond) and also leads the organization with 81 RBIs.

LONGBALL LOGAN: **Logan Wyatt** has homered four times in his last nine games since August 26. He hit a two-run homer in the ninth inning that night at Portland. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the seventh to lift Richmond to a 10-8 win over the Sea Dogs. Last Wednesday at Hartford, he launched a go-ahead, solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. Dating back to August 20, Wyatt is batting .341 (14-for-41) with five homers, three doubles and 12 RBIs. His 17 homers between Eugene and Richmond this season are tied for the third-most in the Giants organization.

GLOW SHOW: **Jimmy Glowenke** is has picked up 18 hits and eight RBIs in his last 11 games dating back to August 23, batting .563 (18-for-32) with three homers, two doubles and eight walks. He started this most recent hot stretch on August 23 at Portland, when he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the year, Glowenke is batting .355 (39-for-110) in road games, including all seven of his Double-A homers, compared to .184 (18-for-98) at The Diamond. Since July 1, Glowenke is batting .336 (46-for-137) with seven homers and 27 RBIs in 43 games. On Monday, Glowenke was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for his performance at Hartford last week.

ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN: **Shane Matheny** has reached base 66 times in his last 35 games since July 25 (36 hits, 29 walks, 1 HBP), hitting .295 (36-for-122) with six homers, seven doubles, two triples and 25 RBIs adding a .429 on-base percentage. In the last home series against the Senators, Matheny hit .412 (7-for-17) with three homers, one double, nine RBIs and three walks. He is hitting .205 (9-for-44) in his 10 games since. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 137 walks, ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

ALRIGHT, ALDRETE: On Thursday, **Carter Aldrete** hit three home runs in consecutive at-bats. He hit a two-run homer in the third inning, added another two-run homer in the fourth inning and hit a solo home run in the fifth. The three-homer performance tied the Richmond single-game franchise record. The last player to homer three times in a game was **Thomas Neal** on June 26, 2010 at Erie. Aldrete reclaimed the team lead in homers this year with 12. Prior to Thursday, Aldrete had not homered in his previous 36 games, back to his most recent home run on June 18.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 5 - on IL), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 7 - on IL), RHP **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 12), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 16), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and **Jose Cruz** as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
