#### **ACKER SHINES IN LOSS TO CARDINALS:**

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Springfield Cardinals 7-6 on Wednesday evening from Riders Field. Springfield (25-16, 62-48) started the scoring for the second straight night against Frisco (23-18, 67-43) starter Dane Acker when Jimmy Crooks led off the top of the fourth inning with a solo homer. The St. Louis Cardinals No. 2 prospect Tink Hence delivered 4.0 scoreless, one-hit innings with six punchouts. In the top of the fifth, Dakota Harris doubled to open the frame and later scored on an RBI triple by Chris Rotondo. Bryan Torres extended the lead to 3-0 by singling to right. Trailing 3-0 in the bottom of the sixth, Frisco sent 10 batters to the plate and manufactured five runs to take the lead. The inning was highlighted by two run scoring wild pitches and RBI singles from **Cody Freeman**, **Josh Hatcher** and **Maximo Acosta**. Acker appeared in the top of the seventh, marking the first time he has pitched into the seventh frame in his career. He picked up a strikeout before exiting the game with a final line of 6.1 innings, allowing three runs on 11 hits and no walks with six strikeouts. The Riders tacked on an insurance run on the home half of the eighth inning where **Aaron Zavala** doubled home Hatcher to make it a 6-3 advantage for Frisco. **Skylar Hales** worked 1.2 innings of scoreless, one-hit baseball to preserve the 6-3 lead to the top of the ninth. Springfield opened the ninth with three consecutive hits against **Andy Rodriguez** (2-2) followed by a sacrifice fly and an error that brought the Cardinals back within a run. Crooks tied the game with a sacrifice fly before R.J. Yeager delivered the go-ahead run on an RBI single. Offensively, the Riders were outhit 16 to seven as the offense saw two multi-hit games coming from Alejandro Osuna and Hatcher.

RoughRiders starting pitchers have been dominant over their last 14 games, owning a 1.89 ERA (15ER/71.1IP). Overall, Frisco has allowed just 40 earned runs in their last 14 games for a 2.95 ERA (122.0IP). The Riders have played incredibly close games over the last 14 games with 12 of the 14 games being decided by three runs or fewer (Frisco is 5-7 in those games).

Over the last 20 games, the Riders are fourth in the Texas League with a .707 OPS, second with a .257 batting average and are sixth with 3.9 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .181 (32-for-177) with runners in scoring position over their last 20 games.

#### READY TO ROCK(ER):

RoughRiders starting pitcher **Kumar Rocker** has been fantastic in his three starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the three starts, he has pitched 11.0 shutout innings, allowing just five hits and one walk with 16 strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 11.9 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

### **HOME COOKING:**

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-17 at Riders Field this season. The Riders have now lost back-toback home games for the first time since late May. At home this season, Frisco has a +70 run differential, a 3.82 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .756 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-26 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .638 OPS (10th in the league). Cody Freeman is slashing .341/.397/.590/.987 at home this season with nine of his 13 home runs. His .341 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

#### OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 33 games, he is hitting .302 (39-for-129)/.397/.512/.909 with 14 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 18 RBIs. Over his last 30 games, he is batting .310 (36-for-116)/.413/.526/.939 with 12 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 18 RBIs. He has reached in 30 of his 33 games with the Riders. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game.

#### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen is the second-best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.25 ERA, which is also the sixth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.51), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .232 BAA is on pace to be the second-best in the franchise's history (.228 in 2021).

WFRE GOING DANCING:
The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (2.40), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

#### **ABOUT KUMAR**

-Pronounced "KA-mar", not "KOO-mar".

-Son of Tracy and Lalitha Rocker. Tracy played defensive tackle for Auburn in the 1980s. He was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 2004 and is the current defensive line coach for the Tennessee Titans. Uncle, David, was a DT for the Rams in the early 1990s as well.

-His name "Kumar" translates to "prince" or "young child" in Hindi as a nod to his mother's Indian heritage. Mother's parents emigrated from India to Maryland in 1965.

-Drafted origionally by the Colorado Rockies in the 38th round of the 2018 draft after being named the Gatorade Georgia Baseball Player of the Year at North Oconee High School in Bogart, Georgia, but did not sign. Parents valued education and he chose to go to college.

-Played football for two years at North Oconee as well, but chose baseball.

-Broke out at Vanderbilt University as a freshman in 2019, winning College World Series Most Outstanding Player for the Commodores' championship team, going 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA in the College World Series. Additionally named D1Baseball.com and Baseball America Freshman of the Year and The Tennessean 2019 Sportsperson of the Year after a 12-5 season with a 3.25 ERA over 22 games with 16 starts. In 99.2 innings, he struck out 114 with 21 walks.

-His freshman season was highlighted by a no-hitter against Duke in the Super Regional round. He walked just two while striking out 19 batters in the 131-pitch no-no.

-After a COVID-shortened 2020 season, he teammed up with former RoughRider and Ranger pitcher Jack Leiter once again to create one of the best 1-2 punches in college baseball history. In 2021, Rocker was a unanimous First Team All-American, leading the nation with 14 wins and 179 strikeouts over his 20 starts (122.0 innings) with a 2.73 ERA.

-Drafted by the Rangers in 2022 after year in Indy Ball. \*see 2022 season below\*

# **2024 SEASON**

-Entered the season as the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com. Ranked as the No. 3 prospect when he joined the RoughRiders on July 26th.

-Made Double-A debut on July 26th in front of 9,151 fans at Riders Field, striking out four in his first two innings and finishing with four strikeouts over his three innings, allowing just a twoout single in the first inning to Dodgers No. 1 prospect Dalton Rushing.

-Struck out eight over four innings on August 9th at Midland, allowing just three hits and not walking a batter. He threw just 51 pitches.

#### **2023 SEASON**

-Made Rangers MiLB debut with High-A Hickory, going 2-2 with a 3.86 ERA, striking out 42 over 28.0 innings to just seven walks. His 37.8 percent strikeout rate was tied for eighth among all MiLB players with at least six starts.

-Was removed from start on 5/17 with elbow discomfort and underwent "Tommy John" surgery (performed by Rangers team physician Dr. Keith Meister) on 5/22. He missed the remainder of the season.

#### 2022 SEASON

-Drafted by the New York Mets in the 1st round of the 2021 draft (10th overall), but did not sign.

-Prior to being drafted by Rangers, played for Independent Tri-City Valley Cats, making five starts, going 1-0 with a 1.35 ERA with 35 strikeouts to four walks over 20 innings. Valley Cats (in Troy, NY) was managed by former Ranger Pete Incaviglia.

-Did not see action in Rangers system after 2022 draft.
