NEWS & NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: WHITECAPS 9, CHIEFS 1

A day after the Chiefs put up 13 runs on 13 hits, Peoria's offense fell flat, scoring just one run on four hits in Sunday's loss at LMCU Ballpark in their last road game of the season...West Michigan opened the scoring in the fourth inning when Stephen Hrustich hit a two-run single to make it 2-0 Whitecaps...Peoria got on the board in the sixth when Sammy Hernandez lifted a towering solo homer to cut the deficit to 2-1...Martinez turned in his longest start with Peoria, tossing 5.2 innings of four-run ball on four hits while he struck out seven and walked none...The Whitecaps pulled away in the bottom of the sixth with a Hrustich RBI single and a throwing error on a steal brought in another run to make it 6-1... Christian Santana broke the game open in the seventh with a three-run homer to stretch the Whitecaps' lead to 9-1... West Michigan used five pitchers to throw nine innings of one-run ball...

SERIES NOTES

- This week's set marks the third and final series between the Chiefs and River Bandits this season, with all three series coming in the second half of the season. Quad Cities has won each of the first two series four games to two.
- Through 12 games of the season series, Quad Cities has outscored the Chiefs 103-65.
- The River Bandits are batting .315 with a .934 OPS against the Chiefs - the highest marks by any Chiefs opponent this season. Peoria is batting .248 with a .749 OPS against QC.

THE 12 GAME TREK

The Chiefs finished their 2026 road slate by finishing 5-7 on their 12 game road trip, losing five of six at Lansing and taking four of six at West Michigan. Of the 12 games played on the trip, eight were been decided by three runs or fewer. Chiefs pitching turned in a 4.05 ERA (3rd best in the MWL in that span) with a 1.44 WHIP (9th) on the trip. Peoria batted .213 (11th) with a .661 OPS (11th).

STRONG STARTS

Chiefs starters combined to allow eight earned runs in 31.1 innings last week. Peoria's 2.30 starter ERA ranked third in the MWL last week at West Michigan and its 45 strikeouts were the most in MiLB and MLB.

STRIKEOUT RECORD REACHED

With **Jack Martinez's** fifth strikeout on Sunday, the Chiefs broke the franchise record for most strikeouts in a season, striking out 1,241 through 125 games. The previous record was 1,236, set in 2022 with a pitching staff that included future big leaguers **Michael McGreevy**, **Gordon Graceffo**, **Chris Roycroft** and **Ryan Loutos**. Peoria ranks third in the Midwest League and sixth in High-A in strikeouts.

HIGH-FIVE!

Brayden Smith finished Saturday night's game 5-6 with four singles and a home run, becoming the first Chief to rack up five hits in a game since **Iván Herrera** did so on July 14, 2019 vs Great Lakes. It marks the ninth 5+ hit game in the Midwest League this season. Smith entered the game 1 for his last 20.

700 CLUB

After a 13-run outburst Saturday night, the Chiefs have scored 700 runs this season, marking the first time since 2009 that Peoria's offense has reached the milestone. Despite the historic amount of offense, the Chiefs rank just 6th in the Midwest League in runs scored with 701. The franchise record for runs is 759, set in 2004.

IRON MAN

Chiefs infielder **Jalin Flores** has played 108 of the team's 125 games this season (86%) - the most by a Chief since 2024. If Flores reaches 110 games played, he'd be the first to do so since 2023, when four Chiefs racked up 114+ games.

CLEAN NINTH

The Chiefs have allowed a ninth-inning run just three times since June 20, including last Wednesday at West Michigan. Peoria's 1.84 ninth-inning ERA is fourth-best in affiliated baseball this season

DOZER PARK FACTOR

The home of the Chiefs has proved to be the most homer-friendly ballpark in the Midwest League this season. Through 59 games at Dozer Park this season, teams have combined for 170 home runs (2.8 per game) - the most in the Midwest League. The league's .800 OPS at Dozer Park is the third highest among MWL stadiums.

SCOUTING REPORT

Throws: FB (Mid-90s, carry), SL (low-80s), CV (mid-70s), CH (low-80s)

Baseball America Draft report (July 2025): Van Dyke began his college career at Seminole State (Fla.) JC before transferring to Stetson in 2024, where he struggled initially but emerged as a dominant closer as a senior in 2025. He posted a 1.52 ERA with 71 strikeouts and 16 walks over 47.1 innings, earning third-team All-America honors. A strong, 6-foot-2, 255-pound righthander, Van Dyke attacks hitters with a lively 91-93 mph fastball that touches 97 and produced a 37% miss rate thanks to its carry. His primary secondary is a low-80s slider with sharp tilt that drew an eye-popping 49% miss rate. He'll also occasionally show a mid-70s curveball and a low-80s changeup, but rarely uses them.

SEASON NOTES

LAST TIME OUT - 8/26 at WM: Struck out 11 Whitecaps in 5 innings of one-run ball - the most strikeouts by a Chief since Brycen Mautz struck out 12 on 8/20/24.

VS QUAD CITIES: Has made two starts against QC; has allowed 11 ER on 15 hits in 7.2 innings... Has taken the loss in both contests (8/5, 7/9).

SLOW STARTS: 43% of runs allowed this season (PEO & PMB) have come in the 1st inning (23 runs). Opponents batting .321 with 1.032 OPS in first inning.

AN INTERESTING DAY: Became one of just five High-A pitchers since 2021 to throw six shutout innings, walk five batters and record a win on 5/27 at WIS...

ON THE BEACH: Opened the season with Single-A Palm Beach, pitched to 1.64 ERA in 33 innings... Did not allow an earned run in 19.1 innings in April (4 starts), striking out 21 while walking three...

ABOUT TY

ORIGIN STORY: Drafted by the Cardinals in 10th round of 2025 draft out of Stetson... Pitched four seasons of college ball: two at Seminole State Junior College (Sanford, FL), two at Stetson... Did not pitch a lot in High School, said that his original goal was to simply make the HS varsity team.

WHAT HE'S SAYING: "I've always prepared and studied maybe too much. I think when I'm most successful, it's when I realize that I'm good enough to throw whatever, and my stuff is good. I don't need to throw the pitch that gets the hitter out, he needs to hit my pitch to get a hit.... Just leaning into more of what I do."

ALWAYS BE CLOSING: Served as the Hatters' closer during his senior season, posting 9 saves with a 1.52 ERA in 47.1 IP... Was named to All-ASUN 1st Team, Baseball America All-America 3rd team... Helped Stetson to NCAA Tournament.

COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO ESPINOZA

MANAGER

Roberto Espinoza, 37, returns to Peoria for his second season guiding the Chiefs and his 13th season coaching with the Cardinals organization. He is the lone returner from the team's 2025 coaching staff. Espinoza's career in baseball began as a catcher, as the Cardinals signed the Palo Aragua, Venezuela as an international free agent in 2006. Espinoza played five Minor League seasons, including parts of three seasons with the Quad Cities River Bandits. Espinoza began his coaching career in 2013 as the hitting coach for the Appalachian League's Johnson City Cardinals. The former backstop is no stranger to the big leagues, having served as a bullpen catcher for St. Louis in 2014 and as a coach during the stretch run of the 2020 season. Espinoza managed Johnson City from 2017 through 2019, winning the Appy League Championship in his final season. He spent the next four seasons (2021-24) managing the FCL Cardinals. He collected his 200th managerial victory on May 18, 2025 with Peoria's 7-1 win over Cedar Rapids.

MIKE HABAS

HITTING COACH

Mike Habas (HAH-biss), an experienced MiLB hitting coach, will spend his first season in the Cardinals organization with the Peoria Chiefs. Habas joins the Cardinals after spending the last two seasons with the Fredericksburg Nationals, helping guide the FredNats to the 2024 Carolina League title. The Chicago native began coaching in the professional ranks with the Gary SouthShore RailCats (2017-18) before spending four seasons with the Brewers (2019-2023). Habas played college baseball at South Suburban College, Moraine Valley College and North Greenville University.

MICHAEL OH

PITCHING COACH

Michael Oh, 28, joins the Chiefs for his second season in the Cardinals organization. The Northbrook, Illinois native began his time coaching in the pro ranks with the Palm Beach Cardinals last season, guiding a number of future Chiefs hurlers. Oh pitched four seasons of college baseball, one at North Iowa Area Community College, two at North Carolina and one at Charlotte. After completing his career with the 49ers in 2022, he was added to the Charlotte coaching staff as the pitching coordinator. He was promoted to pitching coach for the 2024 season, where he guided the 49ers to the program record 10.45 K/9 rate.

BENCH COACH

Another newcomer to the Cardinals organization, Jason Eary will spend his first season coaching professional baseball in Peoria. Eary joins the Cardinals organization after three seasons with St. Louis University, where he coached Billikens infielders. Eary got his coaching start at UNLV, where he served in a player development role. A Las Vegas native, Eary earned an undergraduate degree in Kinesiology from Cal-State Fullerton, where he worked as a baseball manager for four seasons, including the Titans run to the College World Series in 2017.

WADE STAUSS

ASSISTANT COACH

A familiar face to Chiefs fans, Wade Stauss will spend his first full season as a coach in Peoria. Stauss, 26, was signed by the Cardinals as an undrafted free agent in 2021 after four seasons at Southeast Missouri State. The catcher played 26 games with the Chiefs across two seasons, including a two-home run game on June 28, 2022 at Quad Cities. Stauss played at all four full-season levels of the Cardinals system and appeared in 138 games before transitioning to coaching prior to the end of 2025.

KILY GILBERT

ATHLETIC TRAINER

Kily Gilbert is the Chiefs certified athletic trainer after she joined the Cardinals system in November after a previous stint with the Houston Astros. Gilbert originates from southern Oregon and attended Oregon State for her undergraduate and master's studies. She obtained a Bachelor of Science degree in kinesiology in 2019 and her master's degree in athletic training in 2021. Gilbert worked with the OSU football team when she was a student. She was a former intern for the San Francisco 49ers.
