SPRINGDALE, AR – After trading leads several times throughout the night, the Naturals pulled away for good in the tenth on Independence Day on Monday, beating the Tulsa Drillers 7-6 in 10 innings on walk-off single from **Seuly Matias**.

- After Tulsa took a 2-0 lead in the first, Northwest Arkansas stormed ahead in the third, as **Logan Porter** singled in a run and **John Rave** singled in two for a 3-2 lead ... the Drillers tied the game in the fifth and took a lead in the top of the sixth, but the Naturals countered in the bottom of the sixth and tied the game back up, as Matias scored on a wild pitch and **Tyler Cropley** connected on his first home run of the season.
- In the seventh, **Robbie Glendinning** singled home **Nick Loftin** for a 6-5 lead, but down to their final strike in the ninth, the Drillers tied the game with a home run, forcing the Naturals into extras.
- Eric Skoglund** took the mound in the top of the 10th, and stranded the placed runner on second base, retiring all three Drillers hitters he faced.
- With Rave beginning the bottom of the 10th inning on second as the placed runner, Matias wasted no time bringing him home, as the Naturals right fielder lined a ball to right-center field, his second walk-off hit of the season to score Rave from second base.
- After starter **Alec Marsh** struck out seven across 5.1 innings, where he allowed four runs, the Naturals bullpen did its best to keep the game close. **Walter Pennington** was tagged for a home run as soon as he entered the game in relief of Marsh, then settled down to throw 2.0 innings on just the one run.
- Jonah Dipoto** took over for Pennington, looking for a five-out save and retired four straight, including three on strikeouts, before surrendering the game-tying home run.
- Matias, after his single in the 10th and walk-off home run in early June, is now the 11th player in Naturals history to produce two walk-off hits in one season, the last being **Emmanuel Rivera** in 2019.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 7-5 all-time when playing on July 6

On July 6, 2017, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Corpus Christi Hooks, 9-4 at Whataburger Field in Corpus Christi. Catcher **Nick Dini** went 2-for-5 in the game with a solo home run in the fourth inning and scored four runs as well, reaching on errors two separate times in addition to his two hits. Relief pitcher **Richard Lovelady** earned his second win of the season, throwing 3.0 perfect innings, from the 5th to the 7th, while striking out four, his second of five straight appearances without allowing an earned run to begin his Double-A career.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 18 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
9 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 28-5, while when scoring six runs or less, just 6-36.
The Naturals are 22-10 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 12-31.
The Naturals are 31-11 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 3-30 when out-hit by their opponent.
When the Naturals score first, they are 22-13, whereas 12-28 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 4-16 in one-run games this season, meaning 16 of their 41 losses (39.0%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the tying run at the plate or on base in 17 losses this season (including 12 of their one-run losses).
In three games this season (4/26, 7/1 & 7/2), the Naturals have entered the last inning trailing Amarillo by five runs, proceeded to score four runs and put the tying run on and either bring the winning run to the plate or put it on base, but failed to tie the game or win.

Yo, You WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 75 games, the Naturals have stolen 100 bases in 119 attempts (average 1.33 steals/game, 84.03% success rate).

- 100 steals ranks second in the Texas League, tied fifth in Double-A and tied 27th in the Minors.
Maikel Garcia's 23 steals (in 26 attempts) ranks third in the Texas League and tied fifth among all Double-A hitters/basestealers.
The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 50 of 75 games this season (66.7%), including 26 games with two or more steals ... there have been three occasions where the team has stolen five bases, with perfect 5-for-5 steal efforts as a club on 5/13 vs. Wichita and 5/21 @ Arkansas.
The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 14 times, meaning 28 of 100 steals this year (28.0%) have come on a double-steal.
Naturals players have stolen two bases in a game 11 times, led by FOUR two-steal games from Garcia.

ROCKIN' ROBBIE

After slumping for much of June, first baseman Robbie Glendinning has begun to heat back up in the last two weeks.

- The West Australian is riding 10-game hitting streak, during which he's collected EIGHT multi-hit games, including four straight to start the streak and four straight to start the month of July ... since June 24, Robbie is hitting .465 (20-for-43) with five doubles, seven home runs and a 1.591 OPS, including homers in his last four games at Amarillo.
His four-game homer streak, featuring five long balls, is just the fifth four-game homer streak in Naturals history and the second last week, after Nick Loftin opened the week with a four-game home run streak.
22 multi-hit games this season ranks third among Naturals hitters, 20 being two-hit games and a pair of three-hit games, both coming during this streak.
He has reached base in 59 of 65 games he's played this season (90.8%), with hits in 44 of 65.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop Maikel Garcia has reached base in 60 of the 70 games he has played in this season (85.7%), reaching base multiple times on a team-best 39 occasions, including a team-best 23 multi-hit games.

- In 333 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 121 times (84 hits + 37 walks), for a .367 on-base percentage.
Garcia has walked 37 times and struck out 56 times, a 0.66 K/BB rate that ranks third among Royals minor league hitters with at least 250 plate appearances.
The shortstop has the second-most hits in the Texas League (84), ranks third in the league in steals (23) and third in doubles (23), while tied sixth in runs scored (54) ... among all Double-A hitters, he ranks third in hits, tied sixth in doubles, tied seventh in runs scored and tied seventh in steals.
Maikel's 22 doubles are the most among all Royals Minor League hitters, while he ranks second in the organization with 83 hits, 23 steals and 53 runs scored ... he ranks tied third in the system in walks (37), tied fourth in total bases (116), tied fifth in extra-base hits (26), sixth in batting average (.289) and seventh in on-base percentage (.368).
His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for the 15th-longest in club history and tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

PUSHIN P(ORTER)

Catcher Logan Porter has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks FIFTH in on-base percentage (.453) and fifth among all Double-A hitters in OBP ... in the Texas League, he is fourth in OBP, eighth in OPS (.939) and ninth in batting average (.306).
Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage, ranks third in OPS and batting average and sixth in slugging percentage (.486) ... his 45 walks are the most in the system.
Porter has reached base in 50 of 55 games he's played this season (90.9%), with hits in 46 of 55 and 18 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
Porter's 17-game on-base streak between May 31 and June 23 is tied with Robbie Glendinning for the longest on the team this season, a stretch where he hit .321 (17-for-53) with 15 walks and a .493 on-base percentage.

TYLER, THE CREATOR (OF RUNS)

Naturals outfielder Tyler Gentry is as hot as they come, with a great series in Amarillo and fantastic start to his Double-A career.

- Gentry enters tonight's game on a seven game hitting streak, as he's hitting .423 (11-for-26) since June 26, with two doubles, four home runs and 11 runs batted in, having drawn six walks as well, for a 1.462 OPS.
Over his first 16 games at the Double-A level since joining the Naturals June 14, Gentry is batting .311 (19-for-61) with four doubles, seven home runs and 18 runs batted, over one RBI per game, with a 1.110 OPS.
He has hits in 11 of his first 16 games with the Naturals and has reached base in 13 of 16 games.
Gentry is the Royals' organization leader in batting average (.328), slugging percentage (.582) and OPS (1.002), while ranking second in on-base percentage (.420) behind Naturals teammate Logan Porter (.446) ... his 12 total home runs are sixth, while 41 runs batted in between Quad Cities and Northwest Arkansas are 8th.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

May: LHP Drew Parrish ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (3)

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
- May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.
- June 27 to July 3: OF Tyler Gentry** ... hit .435 (10-for-23) with two doubles, four home runs and 11 runs batted in, which was tied for the most in the league. Recorded 24 total bases with a 1.043 slugging percentage 1.543 OPS.

Pitchers of the Week (3)

- May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.
- May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.
- June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.
