Tonight's starting pitcher, Luis Medina, was also the starter for this game. On that day, Medina began the game with six no-hit innings, before being tagged for a run in the 7th inning. The Patriots had a 4-run lead entering the 7th inning, before the eventual league champion Akron RubberDucks won 5-4. WALKING MAN: Jeisson Rosario has drawn a walk in 8 straight games entering today, the

longest active streak in the Eastern League and tied for the 3rd-longest streak in the league this year. Over his last 10 games, Rosario is hitting .276 with a .448 OBP and .913 OPS. **ELIJAH IS EVERYWHERE:** After collecting two

hits in each of the first four games of this week's series, Elijah Dunham now has a team-leading 16 multi-hit games. Over his last 11 games, Dunham is 14-for-40 slashing .350/.447/.500/.947 with 9 SB, now making for 22 SB on the year to rank third in the Eastern League.

HAPPY TRAILS: Ezequiel Tovar now has 11 hits this series, the most of any player in any series vs. the Patriots this season. In total this season. Tovar is 18-for-48 (.375/.995) against Somerset, the most hits that any player has against the Patriots this season. Tovar is the league leader in hits (83) and AVG (.327). After today the Patriots will not face the Yard Goats again until August.

CAREER NOTES

- Beginning MLB rehab assignement for the Yankees as he works his way back from left Achillies tendinitis, added to the IL on 5/24.
- Initially acquired by the Yankees in a trade with the Reds on 12/28/15. Traded to the Cubs on 7/25/16 in exchange for a package that included INF Gleyber Torres. After Chapman helped lead the Cubs to a World Series victory in 2016, he re-signed with the Yankees on 12/15/16, agreeing to a five-year, \$86 million contract. In 2019, he agreed to a three-year \$48 million extension with the Yankees, which goes through the end of the 2022 season.
- Entering 2022, has averaged 14.94 K/9.0IP in his career (603.2IP, 1,002K), the best ratio in the Major Leagues since at least 1900 (min. 300.0IP)
- Since 2010, entering this season, Chapman led all Major League relievers in K/9.0IP ratio and ranks third in strikeouts, trailing only Craig Kimbrel (1,026) and Kenley Jansen (1,022).
- One of 13 pitchers in Major League history to record 1,000K as a reliever... according to Elias, Chapman was the fastest reliever ever to reach that mark in terms of innings pitched, reaching the milestone in 602.1 innings (on 9/30/21)... surpassed Craig Kimbrel's previous mark (612.2IP)... Chapman (623 relief appearances) was just one of four pitchers to reach 1,000K as a reliever in fewer than 700 relief appearances, joining Goose Gossage (559 relief appearances), Craig Kimbrel (630 relief appearances) and Kenley Jansen (684 relief appearances).
- He is also one of 13 pitchers in Major League history (since saves became an official stat in 1969) to record at least eight 30-save seasons (2012-16, '18-19, '21)...only Mariano Rivera (15), Trevor Hoffman (14), Lee Smith (10), Joe Nathan (9) and Billy Wagner (9) have recorded

more... has three 30-save seasons with the Yankees (2018-19, '21), joining Mariano Rivera (15) and

Dave Righetti (4) as the only Yankees pitchers to record at least three such seasons.

- His 89.0% save percentage (306-for-344) entering 2022 is the second-highest among active pitchers (min. 100 saves) behind Craig Kimbrel (89.6%).
- Reached 500K in 292.0 IP (on 7/19/15), becoming the fastest to 500K (by IP) in MLB history, surpassing Craig Kimbrel's record (305.0 IP), set in 2015.
- Struck out at least one batter in a Major League-record 49 consecutive relief appearances from 8/21/13 8/13/14 (50.2IP, 100K).

2021 (with NYY)

- Went 6-4 with 30 saves (in 34 chances), a 3.36 ERA (56.1IP, 21ER) and 97K in 61 relief appearances...was named to his seventh career All-Star team...opponents hit .182 (36-for-198, 9HR); LH .116 (5-for-43, 1HR); RH .200 (31-for-155, 8HR).
- His 15.50 K/9.0IP ratio was the second-highest among Major League relievers, trailing only Milwaukee's Josh Hader (15.65)...struck out 39.9% of his batters faced (97K, 243BF), the fourth-highest strikeout rate in the Majors among relievers.
- Ranked eighth in the Majors and fifth in the AL in strikeouts among relievers.
- His 30 saves were ninth in the Majors and third in the AL...also recorded a career-high six wins (previous: five wins in 2012 with Cincinnati).
- Allowed a career-high 9HR (previous: 7HR in 2013 with Cincinnati)...did not allow more than 3HR in each of his previous seven seasons from 2014-20.
- Made 61 relief appearances, his most since 2015 (65).



- In 2021, set career highs in wins (6) and strikeouts (133), pitching most of the season in Somerset. Tied for second on the Patriots in starts last season with 14. His 133 strikeouts were the 4th-most in the Yankees MiLB system.
- Represented both the Yankees and Patriots with a scoreless inning of work in MLB's 2021 All-Star Futures Game. In the winter, he played for the Indios de Mayaquez of the Peninsula Winter League, where he was named PWL Pitcher of the Year and a Post-season All-star.
- He has been recognized in both MLB Pipeline and Baseball America list of Top 15 Yankees prospects each of the past five years, including this year (2018-22).
- In 2019, spent vast majority of season with Low-A Charleston, going 1-8 with a 6.00 ERA in 20 starts. After being promoted to High-A Tampa, he spread one earned run across two starts and 10.2 innings pitched with 12 strikeouts.
- Spent entire 2018 season with Rookie-level Pulaski. Started 12 games, went 1-3 with a 6.25 ERA.
- Split 2017 season between the DSL Yankees and Pulaski, combining to go 2-2, 5.35 ERA.
- In 2016, started three games for the DSL Yankees 1, pitched 4.1 innings, gave up one run.
- Medina began hitting 100 mph with his fastball as a 16-year-old in June 2015, a month before he signed for \$280,000 out of the Dominican Republic.

COACHING STAFF



DAN FIORITO ★ MANAGER

Born and raised in Yonkers, NY, Dan Fiorito enters his sixth season with the Yankees organization and his first as Somerset's manager. Fiorito is also the Yankees' Roving Upper Level IF/OF Instructor. He served as the manager of High-A Hudson Valley in 2021, after making his managerial debut in 2019 with the GCL Yankees East. Fiorito also had been slated to manage the Yankees' former short-season Single-A affiliate, Staten Island in 2020,

before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He served as the defensive coach at the Yankees' former Single-A Charleston affiliate in 2018, after making his professional coaching debut as defensive coach with the Yankees' former Rookie-level Pulaski affiliate in 2017.

His playing career began when he was signed by the Yankees as a non-drafted free agent in 2012. Over four seasons as an infielder in the Yankees system, he batted .240 (264-for-1102) with 107 runs, 52 doubles, six triples, seven home runs and 98 RBI in 322 career minor league games. Fiorito played three years at Manhattanville College (Purchase, NY) and is a 2008 graduate of Fordham Prep (Bronx, NY).



GERARDO CASADIEGO ★ PITCHING COACH

Gerardo Casadiego will begin his first season in Somerset and 10th in the Yankees organization. He held the same position in Hudson Valley last season, where the Renegade staff ranked second in the High-A East division in strikeouts (1,308, sixth in MiLB) and third in ERA (4.12). The Venezuela native has also previously served as the pitching coach for former Rookie-level Pulaski (2017-2019), DSL Yankees 1 (2014-2015) and DSL Yankees 2 (2016).

JAKE HIRST ★ HITTING COACH

Jacob Hirst will serve as hitting coach in his first season with Somerset and fourth with the Yankees organization. He was the hitting coach for Hudson Valley in 2021, when the Renegades' batters ranked second among High-A East clubs in triples (33) and OBP (.341), third in doubles (217) and fourth in home runs (156), batting average (.255), slugging percentage (.446) and OPS (.787). The Iowa native served the same role with the GCL Yankees West (2019-2020).



AARON BOSSI ★ DEFENSIVE COACH

Aaron Bossi begins his first season with Somerset after making his coaching debut in the same role with Hudson Valley in 2021. His prior experience for the organization was assisting rehabbing players at the minor league complex from 2017-2019. The St. Louis, MO native was signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Yankees on June 24, 2016 as a catcher/infielder. He played in 22 games for the GCL Yankees East in 2016.


