Inland Empire 66ers (20-15, 52-49) AT RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (17-18, 53-48)



RHP Kelvin Caceres (3-2, 3.77 ERA) vs. LHP Maddux Bruns (0-2, 4.11 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes finish the home stand with the final game of a six-game series against the Inland Empire 66ers. Tonight is Baseball Card Set Giveaway, going out to 1,500 fans in attendance, courtesy of Yamaava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the 24th of 30 head-to-head meetings with Inland Empire this year and the last of 18 here at home. Rancho is 11-12 against Inland Empire this year, 9-8 here at home.

LAST GAME: The Quakes overcame 14 walks on Saturday night, holding Inland Empire to just three hits in a 9-4 win over the 66ers at LoanMart Field. Bubba Alleyne and Dalton Rushing each had three hits at the top of the order and Yunior Garcia continued his hot streak, as he had three hits and two RBIs to lead Rancho's 13-hit attack. Starter Peter Heubeck continued his stellar work on the mound, as he gave the Quakes 2.1 innings of scoreless work to get Rancho going. Reliever Jerming Rosario (4-6) notched the win, allowing just one unearned run over 2.1 innings of scoreless relief. Inland Empire starter Chase Chaney (3-4) was hit with the loss, as he allowed six runs (five earned) on nine hits over 4.2 innings.

PLAYOFF UPDATE: The Quakes have dropped three of five in this current series and are now three games behind Inland Empire in the Second Half Standings. If the Quakes can't win the second half, they'll be rooting for the First Half Champion Lake Elsinore Storm to do so, as that would mean the Quakes would need to finish with the next best overall record. Currently, the Quakes (53-48) have a one-game lead over Inland Empire (52-49) overall.

PLENTY O' MOVES: The Quakes made a total of nine roster moves on Thursday, after making six on Wednesday. Thursday's additions included the activation of catcher Yeiner Fernandez from the Temporary Inactive List and four players who were all drafted in the 2022 draft. Catcher Dalton Rushing (second rounder), outfielder Nick Biddison (fourth rounder), infielder Sean McLain (fifth rounder) and outfielder Kyle Nevin (11th rounder) all made their debuts last night. Gone from the active roster are infielder Hector Martinez (released) catcher Jorge Puerta and Javier Armas (sent to the ACL), and catcher Marco Hernandez (placed on the Developmental List). Congratulations goes out to Damon Keith and Austin Gauthier, who were promoted to Great Lakes of the High-A Midwest League on Wednesday. Both hitters rank amongst the league leaders in several categories in 2022. Taking their respective spots on the roster are a couple of 2022 draft picks, infielder Taylor Young (Louisiana Tech University) and outfielder Chris Alleyne (University of Maryland). In addition, RHP Jon Edwards was placed on the Developmental List on Wednesday, while RHP Huei-Sheng Lin was activated from the Developmental List. On Tuesday, right-hander River Ryan was promoted to High-A Great Lakes.

NEW GUYS ALREADY CHIPPING IN: The Quakes have added several new players to the roster who are already contributing. Bubba Alleyne is 6-for-13 (.462) with four runs scored in three games, while Dalton Rushing is 5-for-7 (.714) with two RBIs over two games so far. Kyle Nevin got in the hit column last night for the first time in three games, as he recorded his first two hits as a pro and his first RBI in the 9-4 win. Sean McLain homered on Friday and Taylor Young had the game-winning hit on Thursday. Still looking for his first hit as a Quake is right fielder Nick Biddison (0-for-7).

MADDUX BRUNS: Maddux Bruns makes his 16th start of the year and his fourth against Inland Empire. In three starts against the 66ers, he's 0-1 with an ERA of 11.25, allowing five runs on four hits, but with six walks over just four innings of work. In his last outing overall, he allowed one run on one hit with one walk and four strikeouts over two innings in a no-decision in game one of this series against Inland Empire on August 2. Bruns was drafted in the first round of the 2021 draft out of UMS-Wright High School in Mobile, Alabama.

KELVIN CACERES: Right-hander Kelvin Caceres makes his 30th appearance and first start of the year, his seventh appearance and first start against the Quakes. In six outings against Rancho, he's 0-1 with a 5.23 ERA, allowing seven runs (six earned) on three hits, but with 11 walks over just 10.1 innings. His last outing was on Thursday, when he allowed just one walk over what was a scoreless inning of relief. Caceres was signed by the Angels in 2018 out of the Dominican Republic.
