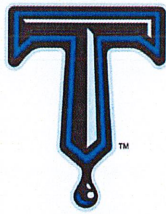

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

LHP Zach Root (1-0, 7.27 ERA)

The 22-year-old was selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 1st round of the 2025 draft out of the University of Arkansas.

He is the #8 ranked prospect in the Dodgers organization according to MLB Pipeline.

Root spent his first two collegiate seasons at East Carolina where he was 8-5 in 32 career games (24 starts) while giving up 106 hits, 66 runs, 60 ERs, 10 HRs and 47 walks with 123 strikeouts in 117.1 IP. He also recorded one save.

In his one season with Arkansas, Root was 9-6 with a 3.62 ERA while giving up 82 hits, 47 runs, 40 ERs, 7 HRs and 35 walks with 126 Ks in 99.1 IP.

In his 17 professional starts, Root is 4-3 with a 3.01 ERA while giving up 51 hits, 29 runs, 23 ERs, 2 HRs and 32 walks with 92 Ks in 68.2 IP.

In his 15 starts with Great Lakes, Root was 3-3 with a 2.40 ERA while giving up 42 hits, 22 runs, 16 ERs, 1 HR and 29 walks with 79 Ks in 60.0 IP.

In his last start for Great Lakes on July 24 against Lansing, Root received the loss after pitching 5.2 innings and giving up 3 hits, 3 runs, 2 ERs and 6 walks with 5 strikeouts in 5.2 IP.

With Great Lakes, right-handed hitters hit .172 with 50 strikeouts in 134 ABs and left-handed hitters hit .232 with 29 strikeouts in 82 ABs.

Root finished April 0-1 with a 7.20 ER. In May he was 0-0 with a 0.00 ERA, in June he was 2-1 with a 3.08 ERA and in July he was 1-1 with a 1.62 ERA.

In his two starts for Tulsa, Root is 1-0 with a 7.27 ERA while giving up 9 hits, 7 runs, 1 HR and 3 walks with 13 Ks.

In his last start against Corpus Christi on August 6, Root pitched 6.0 innings and gave up 5 hits, 3 runs, 1 HR and 0 walks with 10 Ks, earning his Double A win.

In his professional career, Root is 2-2 with a 3.31 ERA in 9 home games and is 2-1 with a 2.70 ERA in 8 road games.

In his professional career, right-handed hitters are batting .185 with 61 Ks in 162 ABs and left-handed hitters are batting .239 with 31 Ks in 88 ABs.

GAMEDAY NOTES

The last time a Tulsa player had an 100 RBI season was Joe Koshansky (109) in 2006 and the last time a player scored 100 runs in a season was Tim Wheeler (105) in 2011. Both are single season franchise records. Josue De Paula has 86 RBI and 92 runs scored this season.

Tulsa currently sits 1.0 game behind Springfield in the TL North Second Half with 28 games remaining in the regular season. The Drillers have never won both the first and second half titles in the same season. Tulsa also leads by 10.0 games for the best overall record. The 2018 Drillers were the last team to have the best overall record in the TL finishing 74-65.

The Drillers 63.6% winning percentage puts them on an historic pace as no Drillers team has ever won 60% of its games for an entire season, and it has been nearly 100 years since a Tulsa professional team has won at a better pace. The 1932 Tulsa Oilers, who played in the Class A Western League, finished with a 98-48 record and a .671 winning % and were the last Tulsa team to win at a higher %. The winningest Drillers team by total wins was the 2019 squad that finished with 78 victories (78-51). The Drillers team with the best winning % was the 1992 team. They finished with a 77-59 record and a .566 winning %.

The Drillers currently have the second-best full-season record among full-season Minor League teams. Bowling Green has the best record in Minor League Baseball at 75-34.

The Drillers have a team batting average of .259 against Arkansas this season and a 5.73 team ERA. In his seven games played against the Travelers, Mike Sirota leads the team, batting .370 and pitchers Aidan Foeller, Luke Fox, Kelvin Ramirez, Jacob Kmatz and Christian Ruebeck have not allowed an earned run against Arkansas in 28.0 combined innings.

The Drillers have hit 33 home runs in the last 14 games, which is the third most in all of Minor League Baseball during that span.

The Drillers are currently 5-5 in August and have a team batting average of .254. Tulsa has a 5.20 ERA in August and has struck out 113, which is tied for the second most in Double A.

Over the past 47 games, Tulsa has a .260 team batting average, the fourth best in the TL, and has drawn 238, the most in the TL during that span. Tulsa starting pitchers are 10-11 and have a 6.01 ERA over the last 47 games, which is the highest in Double A, and the relievers are 18-8 have a 3.75 ERA in that span, which is the second lowest in Double A. Tulsa pitchers have also given up 57 home runs during that span with 49 coming in the last 36 games.

The Drillers have recorded 379 of their 648 RBI this season and 78 of their 153 home runs while batting .267 against relievers compared to batting .267 against starters.

Tulsa's 35 home wins are the most in the TL and the second most in Double A behind Richmond with 38. The 35 road wins are the most in Double A.

Since the Drillers ended their season-long, five-game losing streak on May 16, they are 50-23 and leads Double A batting .276, in hits (685), runs scored (481), home runs (115), walks drawn (378) and OPS (.848). Tulsa has also scored at least six runs in 46 of the last 73 games.

Tulsa has 39 comeback victories this season with 21 coming at ONEOK Field and 18 on the road. The Drillers have scored 122 combined runs in the eighth and ninth innings, which are the second most in the TL. The Drillers largest comeback win was when they rallied from five runs down twice on April 22 at Frisco in game two of a DH and on June 13 against Wichita.

The Drillers are 39-15 when scoring first and have scored first in 33 of 56 road games and in 21 of 53 home games.

Josue De Paula currently leads active players in the TL in average at .314, hits with 129, runs scored with 92, doubles with 31 and OPS at .967.

The Drillers have allowed a combined 239 runs (211 ER) to score in the first, second and third innings for a 5.75 ERA, which is the second highest ERA in those innings in Double A.

Tulsa's offense also leads Double A for the most combined runs scored in the first, second and third innings with 237.

Tulsa's pitching staff has issued 548 walks, the second most in Double A. The Drillers offense leads Double A in walks drawn with 561.

The Drillers have a .263 team batting average against left-handed pitching, which is the second highest in the TL and the third highest in Double A. Tulsa is also batting .268 against right handers, which leads the TL and is the third highest in Double A.

Eighty-three of the Drillers 153 home runs have been hit with runners on base, which are the most homers with runners on base in Double A.

The Drillers have a 1.78 ERA in the ninth inning, which is the best in Double A and are hitting .284 in that inning, which is the second best in Double A.

De Paula has reached base in 14 consecutive games and 31 total during that span. During the streak he is batting .340 with five home runs, 15 RBI and 13 walks.

Logan Wagner has reached base in all six games played since joining the Drillers.

The Drillers have had the most ABs with the base loaded in Double A at 146. With the bases loaded, Tulsa is batting .260 with 38 hits, 7 home runs and drawn 24 walks.

DRILLERS WIN THIRD STRAIGHT- The Tulsa Drillers earned their third straight win on Wednesday night at ONEOK Field by defeating the Arkansas Travelers 9-8. Tulsa came from behind twice in the game as they first fell behind on Josh Caron's solo home run in the second inning. The Drillers battled back to score three in the third inning and four in the fourth to take their biggest lead of 7-3. In the sixth, Arkansas took an 8-7 lead by scoring five runs on an RBI single and Charlie Pagliarini's grand slam. The Drillers tied the game in the sixth inning using Mike Sirota's RBI single and took the final lead in the seventh when Logan Wagner singled to right to score Jake Gelof.
