### LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox took down the Richmond Flying Squirrels 5-3 in 11 innings on Sunday afternoon. Right-handed starter Alex Pham allowed Richmond to take a 1-0 lead in the first on an RBI single from Sean Roby, but kept the Flying Squirrels off the board from there, striking out five through five frames. Bowie tied the game in the sixth, as Jackson Holliday came home on an RBI double from Donta' Williams. Holliday gave Bowie the lead in the top of the eighth when he scored from third on a wild pitch, before Richmond matched it with a Donovan Walton RBI single in the bottom half. That carried the game into extras, where a Holliday single gave the Baysox a 3-2 lead in the tenth, before the Flying Squirrels once again answered on an RBI infield single from Ismael Munguia. In the eleventh, the Baysox would take the lead for good on an RBI single from Silas Ardoin and an RBI double from Maxwell Costes. Right-hander Conner Loeprich, who entered the game in the tenth, recorded the last four outs for Bowie without allowing a run, picking up the win in the process.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve enter this week with an overall record of 50-55. The Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, the Curve are just 16-21 in the second half, last place in the Southwest division and five games out of a playoff spot. Overall this season, Bowie is 8-10 against Altoona, including a series split at Prince George's Stadium in mid-May. The Curve's 843 strikeouts as a team this season are the fewest in Double-A and the fourth-fewest in Minor League Baseball. Altoona's active roster is highlighted by four of the Pirates' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, consisting of LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 5 PIT/No. 89 OVR), LHP Jackson Wolf (No. 14 PIT), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 22 PIT), and OF Matt Gorski (No. 25 PIT).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Sean Sullivan is set to take the ball tonight for Altoona. Sullivan's 81 innings are second-most on the Curve roster this season, but his 12 home runs allowed are also the second-highest total on the team, with right-handers hitting 10 of the 12. Sullivan is coming off a career-high-matching seven inning start against Erie last Wednesday, allowing just two runs while scattering seven hits, with a walk and five strikeouts as well. This season, against Bowie, Sullivan has gone 1-1 through three starts with a 3.60 ERA (six ER in 15 IP). Last time against the Baysox on 6/22, he allowed nine hits and a career-high seven runs through 4.2 innings on three home runs (Billy Cook, Coby Mayo, TT Bowers), but only four of those runs were earned, thanks to two Altoona errors on the evening. An 8th round draft pick of the Pirates in 2021 from the University of California, Berkeley, the right-hander features a low-90s tailing fastball, alongside a mid-80s changeup and slider.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers joins Bowie from High-A Aberdeen after one of the best performances across Minor League Baseball in the month of July. The No. 9 prospect in the O's system, per MLB Pipeline, hit .397 last month - second-highest in Minor League Baseball among players with at least 60 plate appearances, while his 1.185 OPS was fourth-best and led the Orioles' minor league system. Beavers also led the Baltimore farm with his .494 on-base percentage in the month of July. He's picked up right where he left off with Bowie in the month of August, hitting .300 with a .417 OBP through his first 10 games. Beavers has already notched four multi-hit games with the Baysox and seven in his last 12 games overall.

### HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Top prospect Jackson Holliday has had a stellar start at the Double-A level. Holliday is coming off a 9-for-26 week in Richmond, including his third five-hit game of his season on Friday. Holliday has hit safely in 14 of 18 games this season, reaching safely on 16 occasions. This season, across three different levels, Holliday ranks top five in the Orioles' organization in batting average (3rd - .342), on-base percentage (1st - .461), slugging percentage (4th - .537), OPS (1st - .998), triples (1st - 7), and walks (1st - 73). Holliday's on-base percentage also leads all of Minor League Baseball. He is also the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday and the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

### SWING IT LIKE SILAS!

C Silas Ardoin has made a name for himself at the plate in Double-A so far with Bowie. After hitting just .215 through 68 games with High-A Aberdeen, Ardoin is hitting .308 (8-for-26) after eight games at the new level. Ardoin notched the go-ahead single in Sunday's 11-inning victory over the Richmond for his third RBI at the new level. Ardoin already brings plenty of plate discipline and defensive versatility to the Baysox, joining Bowie with a walk rate of nearly 20% and a caught stealing rate of nearly 30% from behind the dish in his time with Aberdeen.

### HOME COOKING

IF/OF Billy Cook has done it all for the Baysox this season. Cook leads active qualified Bowie players in games played (94), home runs (17), RBI (62), slugging percentage (.457), OPS (.776), and stolen bases (24). Cook has swung the bat particularly well within the friendly confines of Prince George's Stadium, where he is hitting .273 this season with an OPS of .878. 13 of Cook's 17 home runs have also come at home. This season, Cook has flashed the versatility, playing five different positions (1B, 2B, RF, CF, LF) and holding every slot in the batting lineup at least once this season.

- Made his second straight Opening Day start on 4/8 at TB; became the first Orioles pitcher to start back-to-back Opening Days since RHP Chris Tillman started three straight from 2014-16, the second lefty to do so since Dave McNally started three consecutively from 1969-71, and the fourth O's left-hander to start multiple Opening Days in team history (since 1954) along with McNally, Steve Barber (1963, 65-66), and Mike Flanagan (1978, 86)
- Left his second start of the season on 4/13 vs. MIL with left forearm tightness; placed on the 10-day Injured List with a left elbow sprain on 4/14 and transferred to the 60-day Injured List with a left elbow strain on 4/17
- Underwent UCL reconstruction surgery (Tommy John) on 4/27, performed by Dr. Keith Meister, and missed the rest of the season

PROFESSIONAL CAREER

**2021:** Threw the sixth no-hitter in Orioles history in a 6-0 victory on 5/5 at T-Mobile Park against the Mariners...Was the first Orioles no-hitter since a combined effort by Bob Milacki, Mike Flanagan, Mark Williamson, and Gregg Olson on 7/13/91 at OAK, and the first individual no-hitter by an Orioles pitcher since Jim Palmer on 8/13/69 vs. OAK...It was the first 9.0-inning complete game of his career, while he became the first left-handed pitcher to throw a no-hitter in Orioles history, and his 12 strikeouts were the most by an O's hurler in a no-hitter...Became the first Kansas-born pitcher to throw a no-hitter since Walter Johnson in 1920...The only base runner reached on a dropped third strike, wild pitch, and was later caught stealing by C Pedro Severino; according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Means was the first pitcher to throw a non-perfect no-hitter in which the opposing team did not record a walk, hit-by-pitch, or error...Became the second pitcher in AL history to throw a no-hitter with 12+ strikeouts and zero walks, joining Félix Hernández, who had a perfect game on 8/15/12...Threw 26-of-27 first-pitch strikes (96.3%), only missing on the 18<sup>th</sup> batter of the game with two outs in the sixth inning; the highest first-pitch strike percentage in a complete game since 1990...Became the only pitcher since 2000 to face at least 25 batters in a game and have a higher first-pitch strike percentage was MIN's Brad Radke on 6/30/04 (27-of-28, 96.4%)...Recorded 26 swinging strikes (14 via the changeup, 8 via the four-seam fastball, 3 via the slider, and 1 via the curveball), the most in a game by an Orioles pitcher since pitch tracking began in 2008...Became the first pitcher since Edinson Vázquez on 6/31/17 to face the minimum in a no-hitter and have it not be a perfect game; the last to do so with no walks or hit batters was Terry Mulholland on 8/15/1990...Named the American League Player of the Week on 5/10, the first Orioles winner since Trey Mancini on 9/23/19, and the first Orioles pitcher to accomplish the feat since Arthur Rhodes in August of 1994...Made his first career Opening Day start on 4/2 at Boston, becoming the 41<sup>st</sup> Opening Day starter in Orioles history...Became the first pitcher in Orioles history to work at least 7.0 innings while giving up one hit-or-less and not allowing a run in a start at Fenway Park...Became the 17<sup>th</sup> pitcher in Major League history, and first Oriole, to go at least 7.0 innings while allowing one hit-or-less in a start on Opening Day; he is the third pitcher in Major League history to do so without issuing a walk, joining Irv Young (1906) and Jordan Zimmermann (2019)...Joined Mike Mussina (5/30/97) and Jim Palmer (5/12/67) as one of three Orioles to throw at least 7.0 innings, allowing one hit-or-less, no runs, and no walks in a start...Tallied a career-high 12 quality starts, surpassing the 11 he made in 2019...According to *Baseball Reference*, his 1.6 WPA led the O's, 1.0 higher than the next closest pitcher on the club...Registered a career-long 19.0 scoreless innings streak from 5/5-19...Became the 12<sup>th</sup> pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 200 batters in the first 48 games of their career when he struck out Mark Canha on a foul tip in the fifth frame on 4/30 at OAK...Gave up a career-high 30 home runs, surpassing his total of 23 allowed in 2019; homers accounted for 45 of his 64 total runs allowed (70.3%)...Tallied the first extra-base hit of his career (2B) on 9/20 at PHI...It registered an exit velocity of 102.7 mph, tied for the second-hardest-hit ball by an O's pitcher in the *Statcast* era (since 2015) with Mike Wright, Jr. (1B) on 5/23/15, behind only a Yovani Gallardo 106.5 mph single on 6/29/16; first extra-base hit by an Orioles pitcher since Zack Britton (HR) on 7/31/11...Spent time on the 10-day Injured List with a left shoulder strain from 6/6-7/20 after being removed from his start on 6/5 vs. CLE in the first inning.

**2020:** Struck out seven straight Rays batters on 9/20 vs. TB (two in the first inning, three in the second inning, two in the third inning) to match the Orioles club record for consecutive strikeouts set by Sammy Stewart in 1978...Struck out a career-high 12 batters on 9/20 vs. TB, the only Baltimore pitcher to record double-digit strikeouts in a game in 2020...Led Orioles pitchers in strikeouts (42), tied with RHP Alex Cobb for the most starts (10), and finished second with 43.2 IP...Surrendered at least one home run in nine of his 10 starts...Started the season on the 10-day Injured List (left shoulder fatigue) and was activated prior to his start on 7/30 vs. NYY...Over his final four starts, he went 2-1 with a 1.55 ERA (4 ER/23.2 IP) with three walks and 30 strikeouts...Posted a 9.31 ERA (10 ER/9.2 IP) in the first inning...Started six of his 10 games at home, pitching to a 1-3 record and 7.06 ERA (17 ER/21.2 IP); compared to a 1-1 record and 2.05 ERA (5 ER/22.0 IP) in four road starts.

**2019:** Named to his first career American League All-Star team, the Ione Orioles representative...Finished second in American League Rookie of the Year voting, the first Orioles runner-up in the Rookie of the Year voting since 2002 (RHP Rodrigo López)...According to *STATS, LLC*, he was the fifth rookie in Orioles history (since 1954), and first since 1966, to be named to the All-Star team, joining RHP Chuck Estrada (1960), 1B Jim Gentile (1960), INF Ron Hansen (1960), and C Andy Etchebarren (1966)...Became the first homegrown Orioles starter to make the All-Star team since Hall of Famer RHP Mike Mussina, who made five All-Star appearances with the O's (1992-94, 97, 99)...His 2.50 first-half ERA (23 ER/82.2 IP) was the best amongst Orioles rookies since 1954 (min. 80.0 IP)...Led all Orioles pitchers in wins (12), ERA (3.60), Quality Starts (11), and WHIP (1.14)...According to *Baseball Reference*, he led the O's and all AL rookies with a 4.5 WAR...Led all rookie pitchers (min. 155.0 IP) in opponent batting average (.234), and ranked in the top 10 among rookie pitchers in: opponent OPS (2<sup>nd</sup> - .702), WHIP (2<sup>nd</sup> - 1.14), K/BB (2<sup>nd</sup> - 3.18), ERA (3<sup>rd</sup> - 3.60), K/9 (3<sup>rd</sup> - 7.03), winning percentage (3<sup>rd</sup> - .522), wins (4<sup>th</sup> - 12), opponent SLG (4<sup>th</sup> - .417), HR/9 (4<sup>th</sup> - 1.34), strikeouts (5<sup>th</sup> - 121), and quality starts (6<sup>th</sup> - 11)...Made his first Opening Day roster...Earned his first Major League win in his first appearance of the season on 3/31 at NYY, pitching in relief (3.1 IP, 5 H, ER, HR, BB, 5 K)...Made his first career start on 4/9 vs. OAK (3.0 IP, 4 H, 5 R, ER, HR, BB, K - L)...Recorded his 100<sup>th</sup> strikeout of the season on 9/5 vs. TEX when he struck out Nick Solak, becoming the sixth left-handed rookie pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to reach the 100-strikeout plateau (last: 2012 - Wei-Yin Chen)...His 121 strikeouts were tied with Erik Bedard for the seventh-most by a rookie pitcher in Orioles history...His 12 wins were tied with LHP Wei-Yin Chen as the most by an Orioles left-handed rookie in team history (since 1954)...Held left-handed hitters to a .184 (26-for-141) clip, which ranked eighth-lowest in the AL and 13<sup>th</sup>-lowest in the majors...According to *Statcast*, his four-seam fastball had 13.3 inches of vertical movement, 2.8 inches more rise than an average MLB fastball; the 2.8 inches of rise against the average ranked second in the majors (min. 1,000 pitches) behind Houston's RHP Justin Verlander...Pitched to a 7-4 record with a 2.50 ERA (23 ER/82.2 IP) in 18 games (14 starts) in the first half...Made 18 appearances (16 starts) at Oriole Park, pitching to a record of 8-5 with a 2.74 ERA (28 ER/92.0 IP); his home ERA was the fifth-lowest at Oriole Park in a season (min. 90.0 IP)...His 2.74 home ERA was the best by a first-or-second-year Orioles pitcher since Mussina in 1992 (2.65)...In 19 games (16 starts) following a loss, Means went 7-5 with a 3.23 ERA (34 ER/94.2 IP) and a 1.07 WHIP...Finished the month of June with the sixth-lowest ERA in the majors and third-lowest in the AL with a 1.71 ERA (4 ER/21.0 IP) (min. 20.0 IP).

**2018:** Had his contract selected from Triple-A Norfolk on 9/24 and made his Major League debut on 9/26 (G1) at BOS (3.1 IP, 5 ER, 6 H, 1 HR, 4 K); struck out the first batter he faced (Mitch Moreland)...Went a combined 7-9 with a 3.72 ERA (65 ER/157.1 IP), 32 walks, and 130 strikeouts in 26 starts (28 games) for Double-A Bowie and Norfolk...Started the season with Bowie, going 1-4 with a 4.30 ERA (22 ER/46.0 IP), 13 walks, and 41 strikeouts in eight starts (7 GS) for the Baysox...Promoted to Norfolk on 5/18 and went 6-5 with a 3.48 ERA (43 ER/111.1 IP), 19 walks, and 89 strikeouts in 20 games (19 GS) for the Tides...Opponents hit .268 (166-for-619) against him, with left-handers hitting .206 (39-for-189) and right-handers hitting .295 (127-for-430)...15 of his 26 minor league starts were quality starts...Struck out a season-high 10 batters on 6/6 at Columbus in 5.0 innings of work.

**2017:** Named Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 1-1 in five starts with a 1.40 ERA (4 ER/25.2 IP) and 24 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .191 (18-for-94) batting average...Led all Orioles minor leaguers and ranked second in the Eastern League with 124 strikeouts...Ranked fourth in wins (9) among O's organizational pitchers...Tossed a season-high 8.0 scoreless innings on 7/1 at Akron, allowing six hits with four strikeouts and two walks...Went 4-0 in six games (5 GS) in July with a 2.39 ERA (10 ER/37.2 IP), 33 strikeouts, and nine walks.

**2016:** Began the season with Class A-Advanced Frederick...Recorded a season-high 10 strikeouts (6.0 IP) on 5/5 at Potomac (first double-digit strikeout performance of professional career)...In his last four starts with the Keys from 5/5-23, notched a quality start in each outing, going 2-0 with a 1.44 ERA (4 ER/25.0 IP) and 32 strikeouts...Held right-handed batters to a .211 clip (30-for-142) with the Keys...Went 3-0 with a 0.93 ERA (3 ER/29.0 IP) and 32 strikeouts in five home starts with Frederick...Debuted with Bowie on 5/28 and remained with the Baysox for the rest of the season...In his last five starts of the season from 8/14-8/4, he posted a 3.38 ERA (11 ER/29.1 IP).

**2015:** Ranked second on Class-A Delmarva in wins (9), strikeouts (89), innings pitched (118.1), and tied for second in games started (23)...Started Opening Night for the Shorebirds on 4/9 vs. Greensboro (W, 6.0 IP, 3 H, 7 K)...Won three consecutive starts from 5/28-6/19, going 3-0 with a 2.00 ERA (4 ER/18.0 IP) in those outings...Posted his first professional complete game after tossing a no-hitter on 7/31 vs. Charleston (W, 7.0 IP, 1 BB, 6 K, 1 HB)...Named the South Atlantic Pitcher of the Week for the period of 7/27-8/3 after throwing a complete-game shutout with six strikeouts on 7/31 (G1) vs. Charleston...Went 3-3 with a 1.69 ERA (6 ER/32.0 IP) in six July starts...Debuted with Frederick on 8/22.
