RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (21-17)

AT

Fresno Grizzlies (24-14)



RHP Edgardo Henriquez (1-1, 3.26 ERA) vs. LHP Mason Green (2-1, 2.78 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes complete a six-game road trip against the Fresno Grizzlies today, with the final game of a six-game set against the Colorado Rockies' Cal League affiliate. The Quakes return home on Tuesday to face Visalia.

VS THE GRIZZLIES: This will be the sixth of 12 head-to-head meetings in 2022 between the two clubs and the last of six straight at Chukchansi Park. Last season, the Quakes went 2-4 in six head-to-head meetings, all of which were played in Fresno. The Grizzlies will come to LoanMart Field in July for their visit to Rancho in franchise history.

LAST GAME: The Quakes endured their first shutout of the 2022 season, as Fresno gave them a 9-0 blanking on Saturday night at Chukchansi Park. Julio Carrion broke up a no-hit bid with a clean single to open the sixth inning, as Carrion's two hits were the only two of the game for the offense. Fresno starter Victor Juarez (3-0) was brilliant, striking out seven, while allowing one hit and one walk over six innings. Quakes' starter Maddux Bruns (0-1) suffered his first career defeat, as he allowed four runs (three earned) on three hits with two walks over 3.2 innings.

LOSING SERIES: Last night's loss assured the Quakes of just their second series loss of the year and their first six-game series loss of the season. The only other series loss the Quakes have suffered was in Visalia to start the year, as they dropped two of three to the Rawhide. The Quakes are 3-2-2 over their first seven series of the year, with their three series wins all coming within the South Division, one against each opponent.

ONE-SIDED HOME RUN RACE: The Fresno Grizzlies and the Quakes are the top two home run hitting teams in the league, with Fresno having hit eight more round-trippers (48) than Rancho (40) in 38 games. In this series though, the Quakes have been out-homered, 8-1, with their lone round-tripper coming off the bat of Luis Rodriguez in Friday night's win. The Grizzlies' home run leader is Hunter Goodman, who has nine long-balls, good for third in the league. Diego Cartaya leads the Quakes with eight and is fourth in the league.

FALL FROM FIRST: The Quakes' recent skid has seen them fall out of first place in the South Standings, as they now trail Lake Elsinore by one full game. The Storm have been beating up on the Visalia Rawhide this week, winning four of five at Valley Strong Ballpark. The Rawhide will come to Rancho Cucamonga this week, where the Quakes have won five of six.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes' offense took a hit, as outfielder Jose Ramos was promoted to Great Lakes of the Midwest League on Monday. Rated as the 14th-best prospect in the Dodgers' system, Ramos has been an offensive leader for the Quakes in 2022, batting .277 with six homers and 23 RBIs in 28 games. Taking his spot on the roster is Gaige Howard, an infielder who was an undrafted free agent in 2021 out of the University of New Orleans. The Quakes also added RHP Adolfo Ramirez, a member of the 2021 Quakes (1-2, 6.91 ERA, 11 G, 1 GS). Ramirez comes from Great Lakes, where he made just two relief appearances so far in 2022, allowing one run on one hit and two walks, with three strikeouts over 2.2 innings.

LOADED WITH PROSPECTS: The Quakes now have five players that Baseball America and MLB Pipeline have rated as Top-30 within the organization. They are led by the Dodgers' number-one overall prospect, catcher Diego Cartaya. Cartaya broke out in 2021, as he appeared in 31 games with the Quakes, hitting .299 with 10 homers and 31 RBIs, before suffering a season-ending back injury. Cartaya is back in Rancho to at least start the year and is in good health. He's joined by LHP Maddux Bruns (#12), INF Alex De Jesus (#20), OF Luis Rodriguez (#25) and OF Jake Vogel (#29).

EDGARDO HENRIQUEZ: The Quakes will go with Edgardo Henriquez in the finale, as he makes his eighth appearance, seventh start and second against Fresno this series. In the series opener against Fresno on Tuesday, he scattered three hits and three walks over four scoreless innings in a no-decision. Henriquez signed with the Dodgers out of Venezuela in 2018.

MASON GREEN: Lefty Mason Green takes the mound in the final game of the series, as he makes his first career appearance against Rancho and his seventh overall start. In his last outing, he allowed one run on six hits over five innings in a no-decision at Visalia on May 15. He's allowed just one run over his last two starts (12 innings). Green was Colorado's 12th-round pick out of Central Missouri in the 2021 draft.
