**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve continue a six-game set with the RubberDucks. Altoona and Akron play 15 times against each other in the season's first 39 games.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Altoona dropped their fifth straight game on Wednesday morning, 8-7. **Kervin Pichardo** rocked a three-run homer in the loss.

**BEER HERE:** Infielder **Seth Beer** recorded his 8th career 4-hit game on Wednesday, April 24 against Bowie when he went a perfect 4-for-4 at the plate.

**A WEEK TO FORGET:** Altoona dropped 5-of-6 games in their series at Bowie from April 16-21. Since the adoption of the 6-game series schedule in 2021, the Curve have lost 5-of-6 five times, most recently from 6/13-18/2023 at Somerset. Twice in Bowie (7/26-31/2022) and twice in Akron (8/31-9/5/2021 and 8/2-7/2022) the Curve have dropped five-of-six in a series.

**QUIET BUS RIDES:** Altoona suffered back-to-back walkoff defeats at Bowie on April 19 and 20th, marking the first time that the Curve have lost in that fashion since their last trip to Bowie on August 19 and 20, 2023.

**JUST GIVE US A CHANCE:** Top prospect starting pitchers **Bubba Chandler**, **Sean Sullivan** and **Braxton Ashcraft** each turned in their best outings of the season during Altoona's series at Bowie. Combined they went 1-0 with a 1.88 ERA (3 ER / 14.1 IP) allowing just 16 hits, 2 BB and 9 K's.

**GOOD WITH GUT:** Catcher **Abrahan Gutierrez** is off to a strong start at the plate to begin the season, leading regular players in batting average through 16 games played with a .314 mark. After reaching base in 16-of-18 games to start his Curve tenure in 2023, Gutierrez has at least one hit in 10-of-14 games played with 5 multi-hit games. Among catchers at the Double-A level, Gutierrez ranks 2nd in Batting Average (.314) and 10th in On-Base Percentage (.340).

**WE'LL TAKE THE LEAD:** OF **Matt Fraizer** knocked the 42nd leadoff home run in Curve history on April 19 at Bowie. In 2023, Altoona had 4 leadoff solo home runs, two by **Liover Peguero** and two by **Jackson Glenn**.

**FINALLY, SOME POWER:** After hitting just 3 home runs in the first 10 games of the season, Altoona swatted a pair of homers on April 18 at Bowie. **Seth Beer** (solo homer) and **Jackson Glenn** (2-run homer) each took a trip around the bases in a 7-6 win. Altoona's 9 home runs hit through 16 games ranks 25th among 30 Double-A teams.

**GENERATION Z:** Infielder **Tsung-Che Cheng** had a stretch of ten straight plate appearances in which he reached base safely from Saturday April 6 to Wednesday, April 10. In his ten plate appearances he drew 7 walks, reached on an error and had a pair of hits. Cheng drew at least one walk in each of his first four games this season, twice he's walked three times in a game. Cheng's 12 walks lead the Eastern League entering play on Thursday, April 25 and he reached base safely in 7 straight games played to start the season.

**THE MAJOR LEAGUE CURVE:** Altoona's group features several staff and players with previous major league experience. On the coaching staff Manager **Robby Hammock** played 182 games in the major leagues with the Arizona Diamondbacks, highlighted by catching Randy Johnson's Perfect Game. Pitching Coach **Fernando Nieve** made 99 major league appearances with the Astros and NY Mets in his playing career, Catching and Game Planning Coordinator **Taylor Davis** played 22 games with the Cubs and Pirates before joining the coaching ranks this off-season and Bench Coach **Gary Green** played 106 games in the majors with the Padres, Rangers and Reds. Among the players, **RHP Isaac Mattson** made five appearances for Baltimore in 2021 and INF **Seth Beer** played 43 games with Arizona across the 2021 and 2022 seasons.

**PROSPECT PARTY:** The Curve roster features six players that are ranked in the Pirates Top-30 prospects by MLB.com, including four in the Top-10 and two players ranked among the top-100 prospects in all of Minor League Baseball. MLB Pipeline ranked Pittsburgh's minor league system as the ninth best among all organizations entering 2024. Headlining the returning group of position players for the Curve are No. 8 Pirates prospect INF **Tsung-Che Cheng** and No. 21 Pirates prospect OF **Jase Bowen**. On the pitching side, three are ranked in the Pirates Top-10 by MLB.com include No. 4 LHP **Anthony Solometo**, No. 5 RHP **Bubba Chandler**, and No. 7 RHP **Braxton Ashcraft**.

**THE 'DUCKS, MADE OF RUBBER:** Greg DiCenzo takes over for the 'Ducks after spending last season as the Bench Coach at Triple-A Columbus. 2024 is DiCenzo's fourth season working in the Guardians system after spending 12 years as the Head Coach for Holy Cross where he led his team to 20 or more wins 10 times. Akron has several top prospects in their lineup including OF Chase DeLauter, OF Petey Halpin, INF Milan Tolentino and INF Kahlil Watson.

**THE FIRST QUACKER:** Rodney Boone takes the ball for Akron on Thursday night. Boone makes his second start, fourth overall appearance of the season tonight. He tossed 4.2 scoreless innings of relief against Altoona on April 7, allowing 1 hit, 2 walks and 3 strikeouts. Boone was Cleveland's 8th round pick in 2021 out of UC Santa Barbara. The Orange, CA native attended Tustin HS in Tustin, CA. Boone lists his favorite sports teams as the New England Patriots, LA Dodgers and Houston Astros and enjoys jet skiing, body surfing, hiking and playing with his dogs in his spare time.

**2024:** Named to Altoona's Opening Day roster...

**2023:** Named to Altoona's Opening Day roster... Finished the season ranked 6th in the Eastern League in ERA (3.88), also ranked 8th in batting average against (.245), 12th in innings pitched, (113.2) and 6th in WHIP (1.27)... Allowed 2 runs or fewer in 13-of-21 starts... Made his Double-A debut on 4/15 at Erie, tossing 2.1 scoreless innings before hitting his pitch limit... Tossed 14.1 consecutive scoreless innings to begin his Double-A career, longest by a Curve pitcher since Roansy Contreras threw 18.2 IP to start the 2021 season... Matched his career-long outing with 6.0 innings of 2-run ball against Akron on May 11... Did so again in his next outing on 5/17 at Bowie, retiring 15-of-16 batters to begin his start... Tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on 5/23 vs. Hartford, took a no-decision after leaving with a 3-0 deficit and Altoona rallied for 6 runs in the 8th in a 6-3 win... Shaved his head on 5/31 in solidarity with cancer survivors at Altoona's Game of Hope... Placed on 7-Day IL on 6/9 (retro 6/8) with a calf injury, activated on 6/16... Matched his career-high with 7 runs allowed (4 earned) on 6/22 vs. Bowie... Made his first appearance post-All Star break in a one-inning relief outing on July 18 vs. Reading... Tossed his first career complete game as a professional in a 7-inning affair with Erie on 8/9 in the first of a doubleheader, first CG by a Curve pitcher since Trey McGough in 2021 (5.0 IP) and first 7-inning CG since Domingo Robles in 2019... Struck out a season-high 9 batters on 9/7 vs. Harrisburg, allowed only 4 1B's in the victory... Bounced back from a bumpy month of July (8.37 ERA), going 6-0 with a 2.82 ERA (14 ER / 44.2 IP) in his last 8G (6 ST) 37 batters and walked just 14 while holding opponents to a .227 average against... Altoona earned a win in each of his final 8 appearances of the season after August 1...

**2022:** Spent the entire season with High-A Greensboro... Made 20 appearances with 15 starts, going 2-5 with a 4.68 ERA in 75.0 innings... Made his professional debut on 4/13 at Winston-Salem, allowing one unearned run on three hits in 3.0 innings... Struck out career-high 11 batters on 5/31 vs. Wilmington, allowing four runs on four hits in 5.0 innings... Picked up five or more strikeouts in 5 appearances during the season... Tossed season-long 6.0 shutout innings on 6/18 vs. Hudson Valley... Matched the feat on 6/30 at Hickory with 6.0 shutout frames...
