### LUG•NOTES

**No June Swoon:** Though Lansing is hitting .213 as a team this month, **Daniel Susac** is slashing .310/.383/.452 with three doubles, a home run, five walks and two steals in 11 games. Reliever **Tyler Baum** has also been excellent, allowing one unearned run in five appearances spanning 6 2/3 innings, with two walks and seven strikeouts.

**Pitcher's Best Friend:** The Lugnuts have turned 10 double plays in their last four games, one more yesterday, and lead the Midwest League with 54 for the year.

**Moving Up by Traveling South:** On Tuesday, Lugnuts pitcher **Jack Perkins** and infielder **Sahid Valenzuela** were promoted to Double-A Midland (Texas). The A's 2022 fifth-round selection from Indiana, the 23-year-old Perkins finished his time in Lansing with seven shutout innings on Saturday night at South Bend, his third consecutive quality start. He leads the Midwest League with a 0.97 WHIP and ranks second with a 2.52 ERA and third with a .182 batting average allowed. This is his first trip to Double-A. The 25-year-old Valenzuela previously spent 25 games in Midland in 2022. A 13th-rounder in 2019 from Cal State Fullerton, he batted .262 with three doubles in 30 games with the Lugnuts.

**Rocking the Texas League:** Speaking of Midland and former Nuts, right-hander **Blake Beers** tossed seven strong innings, allowing two runs, walking none and striking out five in the RockHounds' 8-1 loss last night to Wichita. Beers is one of three Lugnuts (joining **Jake Garland** and **Jack Perkins**) to pitch seven innings this year for Lansing.

**One-Run Wonders:** Nine of the Lugnuts' last 14 games have been decided by one run; Lansing is 4-5 in those contests.

**Among the MWL Leaders:** Closer **Tyler Baum** is tied for third with six saves; outfielder **Jonny Butler** is second in the Midwest League with five triples; catcher **Daniel Susac** is fifth with 56 hits and ninth with a .286 average; and outfielder **Junior Pérez** is tied for eighth with 15 steals.

**First-Round Pedigrees:** The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 22-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C **Tyler Soderstrom**.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2012:** RF Chris Hawkins threw out two Fort Wayne TinCaps at home plate and 1B Kevin Patterson hit a go-ahead two-out three-run homer in the top of the 8th for a 5-4 Lugnuts win. (Patterson then homered twice more the next day at Great Lakes.)

**2014:** 30-year-old knuckleballer Frank Viola III tossed 6 2/3 scoreless innings, scattering eight hits and two walks and striking out one in a 3-0 win at Great Lakes.

**2019:** In the bottom of the eighth inning, the Lugnuts rallied for two runs on a DJ Neal RBI double and a Gabriel Moreno sacrifice fly to beat Bowling Green, 3-2. The Lugnuts win, as it turned out, denied the third-place Hot Rods from making the playoffs in the first half. Bowling Green then clinched a second-half playoff berth, denying the Lugnuts from making the post-season. The winning pitcher was 19-year-old lefty Naswell Paulino, who pitched a scoreless eighth in his only appearance of the year with the Lugnuts.

**Welcome to Lansing:** Jose Dicochea makes his Lansing debut tonight, becoming the 911th ballplayer in franchise history... he is the 10th different Nuts starting pitcher this season.

**In the Spotlight:** Dicochea was promoted from Single-A Stockton to Lansing on Tuesday to replace Jack Perkins, who was transferred up to Double-A Midland... coincidentally, an article about Dicochea had just been written by MLB.com A's beat writer Martín Gallegos a day earlier, quoting A's GM David Forst in including Dicochea's name among the top pitching prospects in the system (Royber Salinas, Gunnar Hoglund, J.T. Ginn and Joey Estes). Wrote Gallegos about Dicochea, "Dicochea, an eighth-round selection by the A's in the 2019 MLB Draft out of Sahuarita (Ariz.) High School, ranks just outside Oakland's Top 30 Prospects list. But his inclusion in that group from Forst speaks volumes about how highly he is viewed. In nine games (seven starts) for Single-A Stockton this season, Dicochea holds a 3.20 ERA with 47 strikeouts against 17 walks in 39 1/3 innings. He has held opposing batters to a .163 average, which ranks lowest among all California League pitchers with at least 30 innings pitched. Dicochea's development hit a snag early in his pro career after he underwent Tommy John surgery in 2021. Since his return from injury, the 22-year-old right-hander is taking a big step forward this season, showing off a fastball that consistently hits 95 mph along with a solid slider and a changeup he's recently added to his mix. A's assistant general manager and director of player personnel Billy Owens added, "He's off to a promising start. Averaging well over a strikeout per inning. Overall, his command has taken a step forward. He's definitely an interesting arm on the horizon."

**Home Cooking:** Also from Tucson: Alex Verdugo, four-time All-Star Ian Kinsler, two-time All-Star J.J. Hardy, Cardinals All-Star catcher Tom Pagnozzi and Ron Hassey... in all, Tucson ranks second behind Phoenix in producing Major Leaguers from the Grand Canyon State.

**Glory Days:** Boasting a 96 mph fastball, Dicochea was highly regarded coming out of Sahuarita High School, ranked the No. 1 prep prospect in Arizona by Baseball America entering the 2019 draft... twirled a no-hitter in the state semifinals... signed for \$400,000... signing scout: Scott Cousins... signed away from commitment to University of Arizona... senior year stats: 1.30 ERA, 54 IP, 24 H, 10 ER, 11 BB, 86 K... in addition to pitching, also starred at shortstop.

**Minor League Path:** Dicochea opened his professional career in the 2019 Arizona League after signing, but his 2021 campaign was halted in Single-A Stockton due to injury on June 6 after only six appearances, five starts... returned from Tommy John surgery on August 12, 2022, and made two appearances in the Arizona Complex League before returning to Stockton on August 26, 2022... finished the year with three appearances for the Ports.

**Bagels in April:** Opened 2023 as the Ports' No. 4 starter, firing four scoreless innings at Fresno on April 11... that was the start of three consecutive scoreless outings to begin the year, finishing April with 13 2/3 scoreless innings... didn't allow first run until May 3 vs. Fresno, entering in relief in the fifth inning and allowing two runs in the fifth and two more in the seventh in a 5-4 Ports win... in total with Stockton, posted a 2.42 ERA with a .132 average against in five road starts (22 1/3 IP) compared to 4.24 ERA, .200 avg. in four home appearances (17 IP)... lefties hit .111/.243/.175 compared to righties' .205/.279/.308... base stealers went 2-for-2.

**Personal:** Brady's last name is pronounced "bass-o," with 'bass' like the fish rather than the instrument... got married during the 2020-2021 offseason after spending 2020 hiatus planning his wedding in addition to preparing for the 2021 season... made seven appearances for the Lugnuts in 2021 before suffering ACL tear... 687 days between MiLB appearances, June 15, 2021, and May 3, 2023, in returning from Tommy John.

**Raising Expectations:** An MLB.com article from Athletics MiLB camp by Jonathan Mayo on April 28, 2021, carried a bit of surprising news on a couple of breakout pitchers, specifically, as Mayo wrote, "Brady Basso's role is changing. A lefty who signed for just \$75,000 as a 16th-round pick in the 2019 Draft out of Oklahoma State, Basso pitched almost exclusively in relief in college and threw well in that role in the Rookie-level Arizona League in 2019. Now that he's up to 95-96 mph with his fastball to go along with a curve that flashes plus and a work-in-progress changeup, he's going to get the chance to start." Melissa Lockard, writing for The Athletic on May 2, 2021, included Basso in her Lugnuts preview, writing, "Left-hander Brady Basso (2019, 16th round) opened a lot of eyes this spring with his fastball sitting at 95-97 mph."
