### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Rorik Maltrud** to the mound tonight, looking to win their first Friday game of the season (0-3; 4-21 since starting last season 5-0 on Fridays). Iowa will counter with RHP **Vince Velasquez**. Columbus is 8-4 (.667) versus right handers this year. Velasquez has never pitched against Columbus in his career, but was 5-4 with a 3.42ERA in 18GS with Columbus last year.

### vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 14-15 opposing the I-Cubs (29-22 in the last 51 matchups). In Columbus, the Clippers are 25-22 all time (2-0-5 in 6G series, 0-2-0 in other series). Individually, **CJ Kayfus** has 5HR and 15RBI in 18G against Iowa in his career, while **Nolan Jones** has hit 9HR with 30RBI in 29G and **Milan Tolentino** has 7HR and 16RBI in 18G.

### Not Enough

Yesterday marked the second Clipper loss when scoring at least 10 runs (1-2; rest of the IL is 24-2 when scoring 10+ with Louisville and Worcester having each lost a game, Worcester lost to 14-10 to Columbus on 4/7). Only 2G this season have seen a combined score below seven (2nd fewest, Iowa has played no such low scoring games). Columbus has 19 runs in the last 2G (20 runs in previous 6G).

### Deficit Shmeficit

The Clippers nearly completed a 5-run comeback yesterday, on the heels of Wednesday's 4-run comeback (third of the year; no other IL team has more than one such win, 10 teams don't have any). Columbus owns five wins when trailing by at least three (two teams have two wins, six teams zero wins). In all, the Clippers have trailed in 17 of 18G this year (only team without multiple no-trail games).

### Walters Rehab

**Andrew Walters** (right lat surgery) has remained with the Clippers on rehab, as **Hunter Gaddis** and **George Valera** ended their assignments Monday. Walters has pitched thrice so far, giving up a homer in two outings (2-run shot on 4/7 at Worcester and a solo bomb on 4/10 at Worcester). All-time in Columbus, two thirds of his 15ER allowed have come on 6HR (one every 31.8BF).

### Modest Streak

**Travis Bazzana** doubled twice yesterday to give him a 6G hit streak since 4/10 (11x24, 6XBH; was 2x18 with 0XBH in 4G prior). He has also drawn 4BB in the last 6G, but has been plated only 33% of the time reaching base safely in that stretch (three runs scored on 4/11 at Worcester). Bazzana has not homered since 9/7/25 (79AB) and has only 4RBI on the season (3x17 with runners in scoring position).

### Slump Town

Since homering on 4/11 at Worcester, **Nolan Jones** has gone 1x19 (10K). Even with that mini slump, he is still slashing .314/.433/.631 with 22HR and 77RBI over his last 82G in Triple-A (also scored 73). **Dayan Frias** is 3x21 (.143) in 6G since going 3x4 at Worcester on 4/8 (2x20 in 7G prior). **Dom Nunez** is 2x20 this year with only 2BB (8% of PA; had 51BB in 298PA, 17%, last season).

### Gearing Up

**Kahliil Watson** snapped a 19AB hitless streak Saturday, going 3x4 with a triple and a couple bombs (second career 2HR game, 6/18/25 with Akron), and followed up with doubles on Tuesday and Wednesday (+304 in SLG over last 4G, had 1XBH in first 12G). Unfortunately, Watson struck out yesterday (23K, t-7th most in the IL), but he does rank 6th in the IL with 15BB (only IL batter in top ten of both).

### Eye is for Ingle

**Cooper Ingle** has drawn 15BB in his first 38PA (39%) this season, following a Triple-A debut that saw 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .231 (24x104) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .441OBP and a +13 differential in the walk to strikeout department (36 to 23). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, his 36BB are 3rd in the IL (**Travis Bazzana** is 2nd, 37BB).

### Time for PFPs

The error committed by **Ryan Webb** yesterday was the second error for Columbus pitching this week, following 3E last week (pitchers had 8E last season, did not reach 5E until 127th game). Pitchers account for a third of the errors committed by the team this year (5, 2nd most in the IL; worst fielding: .722), while catchers are the next most offending position (4, all on throws during steal attempts).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

Friday, April 17

## This Date in Clipper History

4/17/2005

Two days after hitting for the cycle, **Mitch Jones** was the star of the game again for the Clippers in an 8-7, 12-inning win vs. Charlotte. Jones hit a 2-run HR in the 3rd and then a solo HR in the 5th to stake Columbus to a 7-4 lead. After a Knight rally in the 9th sent the game into extras, Jones finished the game with a solo HR in the bottom of the 12th to become the 9th Clipper to hit 3HR in a game (team record).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,413 to 1,360).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 22-22 (.500) in pitch reviews this season, with batters going 14-15 (.483) and pitchers/catchers going 8-7 (.533). They have run out of challenges in 9G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 0-1 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-34 when playing past regulation (.595, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 84G to require extra play, 67 have been resolved after one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

## Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 14th in the IL this year (.975), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 10G this season (6-4, .600), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Milan Tolentino** moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 395-415 (.488), 365-369 with Columbus (.497).
