YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 8-5. Turner Hill gave the Flying Squirrels a 1-0 lead in the top of the first with an RBI single. In the second, Justin Wishkoski was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded to open a 2-0 lead. J.T. Arruda closed the score to 2-1 with an RBI double in the second, snapping nine-inning scoreless streak for Richmond starter Nick Morreale. It was his only run allowed in the game. In the bottom of the fourth, Andrew Pinckney tied the game with an RBI single. The Flying Squirrels pulled ahead, 5-2, with an RBI single by Wishkoski and a two-run single by Ismael Munguia in the sixth inning. Yohandy Morales tied the score, 5-5, with a three-run homer in the bottom of the sixth. In the eighth, C.J. Stubbs worked a bases-loaded walk and Phillip Glasser picked up an RBI single, his first Double-A hit, to open an 8-5 lead for the Senators.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Harrisburg Senators in the fourth of a six-game series. In both previous six-game series between the two teams, they each won three games. The Flying Squirrels went 3-3 in Harrisburg from April 16-21. The Flying Squirrels won the first three games of a series at The Diamond from July 9-14 before the Senators took the final three games. This is the final series between the two teams this year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 6-5 in their last 11 games since August 3, winning four straight prior to falling Friday night and in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader. Prior to that winning streak, they went 4-12 in their previous 16 games from July 13-August 2.

THE SENATORS are in last place in the Southwest Division second-half standings. In the first half, they finished in second place, one game behind Erie. Harrisburg's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including INF Yohandy Morales (No. 6), RHP Andry Lara (No. 15), OF Daylen Lile (No. 18), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 23) and RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 25). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes XX Harrisburg players, including INF Yohandy Morales (No. 9), OF Daylen Lile (No. 12), RHP Andry Lara (No. 17), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 19), INF Kevin Made (No. 25 - on IL), RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 26) of OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his league-leading 23rd start of the season and the fifth of his career against the Senators. Last time out, he allowed a career-high 10 runs (nine earned) in two innings on Saturday against the Yard Goats. Over his six July starts, Bertrand went 3-2 with a 2.25 ERA (9 ER/36.0 IP), but he is 0-1 with a 19.89 ERA (14 ER/6.1 IP) in his two August starts. This season, he leads the Eastern League and ranks tied for third in double plays induced (15). He is tied for second in the league in innings pitched. This year, he has made eight scoreless starts, all at least five innings, which is the most in the Eastern League. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Right-hander Rodney Theophile makes his ninth Double-A start and his second against the Flying Squirrels. In his last outing, he threw three innings and allowed two runs on Saturday at Bowie, striking out five. He faced the Flying Squirrels on July 13 at The Diamond and pitched six scoreless innings. He began the season with High-A Wilmington and went 3-4 with a 4.44 ERA in 11 starts before being promoted to Double-A on June 25.

TURN IT UP TO 11: On Wednesday, **Dylan Cumming** set a new career high with 11 strikeouts over his 4.1 innings. He became the first Richmond pitcher to strike out 11 in a game since 2022. He became the 12th pitcher in Flying Squirrels franchise history to record at least 11 strikeouts in a game, a list that also includes **Matt Frisbee** (franchise-record 13 in 2022), **Eric Surkamp, Mike Kickham, Justin Fitzgerald, Chris Heston, Clayton Blackburn, Tyler Beede, Conner Menez, Kai-Wei Teng, Bryan Brickhouse** and **Kyle Harrison.** For the 2024 season, Cumming's 11.88 K/9 is the fourth-highest in the minors among pitchers who have thrown at least 90 innings.

GRAND LARCENY: On Tuesday night, the Flying Squirrels stole five bases in the first two innings of the series opener against the Senators. **Victor Bericoto** stole while **Diego Velasquez, Vaun Brown** and **Carter Howell** each picked up one. The five steals tied a season high for the Flying Squirrels, even with their August 4 game at Altoona. It was also tied for the fourth-most steals in a game in franchise history. The only games for the Flying Squirrels with more stolen bases were an eight-steal game over 13 innings on May 9, 2014 against the SeaWolves and two six-steal games, August 27, 2011 in 10 innings at Akron and June 5, 2014 against the Thunder. Tuesday was the sixth instance of the team stealing five bases in a game. Prior to the two five-steal games by Richmond this season, the team's last five-steal game was in 2019.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 75 double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League with Altoona. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 15 double plays this year, which is the most in the league, ahead of three pitchers tied for second with 11. It is also tied for the third-most in the minors. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. On July 10 against the Senators, **Seth Lonsway** induced three double plays, which is tied for the most by one pitcher in a game in the league this year. Bertrand matched that with three double plays behind him on July 19 against the RubberDucks.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 50 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .303 (60-for-198) with four homers, 10 doubles, nine walks and 29 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on Friday night off the scoreboard in left-center. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 18-of-42 games dating back to June 15.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked ninth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,593), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 11) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features two Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 17) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 21).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023) and Grant McCray (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: The have been 59 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which is one shy of the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 30 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 30 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.
