**SEA DOGS SINK SENATORS** The Portland Sea Dogs took second straight with 6-3 win over the Harrisburg Senators on Friday night. Mikey Romero roped his second homer of the series while Elih Marrero launched his fourth of the season in a three-hit night. Tyler McDonough went 3-4 with an RBI. Harrisburg scored two runs early after an RBI single from Yohandy Morales in the first along with an RBI single from Israel Pineda in the bottom of the second. A solo blast to right field from Marrero in the top of the third inning cut the Harrisburg lead in half. In the top of the fourth inning, Portland scored two more runs on RBI singles from Tyler McDonough and Corey Rosier to take a 3-2 lead. In the top of the fifth inning, Romero launched a homer to right field to mark his second of the series and double a 4-2 lead. Jeremy De La Rosa homered in the bottom of the sixth to chip in but Portland went on to score two more runs on three doubles in the top of the eighth to once again double the lead and complete the scoring, 3-2

**BINELAS CONTINUES TO REACH BASE** Alex Binelas extended his on base streak to 17 games last night. Across those 17 games, he is hitting .328 with one triple, three homers, 14 RBI, 10 walks, and two stolen bases. He is 10-10 in stolen base attempts this season. It is the fourth longest active on base streak amongst Eastern League hitters.

**KWIATKOWSKI CONTINUES TO DOMINATE** RHP Robert Kwiatkowski earned his 11th winning decision with 3.0 shutout innings last night in relief. His 11 winning decisions ranks second most in the Eastern League just behind Robinson Pina who is now in Triple-A for the Lehigh Valley IronPigs. In the month of August alone, he owns a 3-0 record with a 1.29 ERA across six outings and 14.0 combined innings. He has struckout 17 across those innings while holding opponents to a .180 average against him.

**ROMERO STAYS RED HOT** Mikey Romero rocketed his second homer with the Sea Dogs last night after a solo blast in the fifth inning. In his first four games at the level, Romero has notched a .316 average with one double, two homers, and four RBI. He has recorded a hit in every game so far while also notching a three-hit night on August 29th, his first multi-hit game at the level.

**WHERE DO WE STAND** With another win last night, the Portland Sea Dogs remain in first place of the Northeast Division, 2.5 games ahead of the Somerset Patriots. The Hartford Yard Goats rank third, 5.0 games out with the Binghamton Rumble ponies 7.0 games out in fourth. The Reading Fightin Phils and the New Hampshire Fisher Cats rank 13.5 and 16.5 games out respectively. As of last night, the Fisher Cats have been eliminated from playoff contention.

**SEA DOGS RANK AMONG THE BEST IN DOUBLE-A** Portland hitters rank first and second in a multitude of offensive categories. They lead the Double-A level in doubles (260), RBI (609), SLG (.420), OPS (.765) and are second in average (.260) and hits (1,068). On the mound, the pitching staff ranks second in saves (36), and fourth in strikeouts (1,188).

**THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY** August 31, 2017 – The Sea Dogs won their final road game of the season, 9-3 at Hartford...Jeremy Barfield hit two homers and Michael Chavis added a three-run double...Dedgar Jimenez worked 5.1 innings on four hits and one run to improve his record to 5-0.

**PITCHING PREVIEW** LHP Connelly Early will have the start today in game five of the series in what will be his sixth start with the Sea Dogs. Early owns a 1-1 record and a 4.84 ERA coming into today. He last pitched on August 25th against Somerset where he tossed 4.2 innings allowing three runs on four hits while walking two and striking out a Double-A best nine batters. Early retired Major Leaguer, Anthony Rizzo twice on strikeouts and once with a groundout while also retiring Jon Berti with a pair of strikeouts. Today will be his first career start against Harrisburg.

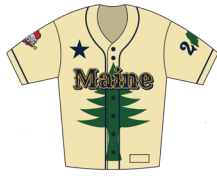

## Sea Dogs Coaching Staff

### **CHAD EPPERSON - MANAGER**

Epperson returns for his third season as Portland's manager. In 2023, he led the Sea Dogs to an overall record of 73-63 (.537). In 2022, Epperson led the Sea Dogs to a Double-A best 45-24 (.652) record in the second half, securing Portland's first post-season berth since 2014. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Prior to that, he spent his first eight seasons with the Red Sox as a manager or coach at the minor league level. A manager from 2004-09, he led his club to the playoffs in four straight campaigns beginning in 2006, including Single-A Salem in 2009. A back-to-back California League Manager of the Year with Lancaster from 2007-08, he also managed Wilmington to the playoffs in 2006. The Kentucky native managed Capital City in 2005 and Augusta in 2004 after spending two seasons (2002-03) as Sarasota's hitting coach. He also managed Cook County of the independent Frontier League in 2001. Epperson played nine years in the minor leagues in the Mets (1992-95), Red Sox (1997-99), and Orioles (2000) systems before his coaching career.

### **CHRIS HESS - HITTING COACH**

Chris returns to Portland after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. During his time with the Drive, they ranked first in batting average (.259), hits (1,133), doubles (249), second in triples (36) and third in RBI (618) in the South Atlantic League. The Drive were also crowned South Atlantic League champions for the 2023 season. This year will mark Hess' fourth year in the Red Sox organization. Previously, he was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island, his alma mater, after three seasons playing in the New York Yankees organization (2017-19). Hess replaces former Hitting Coach Doug Clark who was promoted to be the Hitting Coach for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox.

### **SEAN ISAAC - PITCHING COACH**

Isaac enters his second season as a coach in the Red Sox organization. He led the Sea Dogs to a 4.10 ERA and 30 saves in 2023. His pitching staff finished the year with 1,308 strikeouts, fifth most in the Eastern League. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara. He spent three seasons (2016-2018) as a minor league pitcher in the Angels organization reaching the Triple-A level in 2017 and 2018. In 78 career games, he notched a 9-4 record with a 4.34 ERA. On May 2, 2018, he pitched the final inning of a combined no-hitter for Inland Empire.

### **MICKEY JIANG - COACH**

The 2024 season will be Jiang's 18th with the Red Sox where he has held several different roles, including work as a consultant with International Scouting (2007-2012). He has been coaching in the Red Sox minor league system since 2009. He previously served as a coach in Portland from 2016-2017 and 2023. He served as a coach with Single-A Greenville in 2022 and with Fort Myers in 2012 and 2018-2021. A native of Taiwan, Jiang received his B.A. in International Trade from Tung-Hai University.

### **KYLE SASALA- COACH**

Kyle joins Portland's staff after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record. The Wolverines also won 28 games in both 2021 and 2022. In 2019, Sasala assisted head coach Matt Royer in leading the Wolverines to a then-program record 28 victories. He served as the team's interim head coach during the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, guiding Grove City to a runner-up finish. Portland's former coach in 2023, Pablo Cabrera, was promoted to Complex Defensive Coach based out of Fort Myers with the Red Sox.

### **JUSTIN FROMETA - DEVELOPMENT COACH**

Justin begins his second season as the Sea Dogs Development Coach and fourth in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as a Baseball Operations Associate and Player Development Associate for the Red Sox. He is a 2020 graduate of Tufts University.

### **BOBBY STACHURA - ATHLETIC TRAINER**

Stachura returns to Portland for his second season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013. He received his M.S. from the University of Rhode Island's Department of Kinesiology in 2015.

### **DONNY GRESS- STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH**

After spending the last two seasons with the Greenville Drive, Donny Gress joins the Sea Dogs for the first time. Previously, Gress spent four years at the University of Kentucky, first as a graduate assistant (2018-2020), before becoming a coaching assistant with the Wildcats' Olympic Strength and Conditioning staff. Joe Hudson has been promoted to Worcester's Strength and Conditioning Coach after previously working with Portland in the same role in 2023.

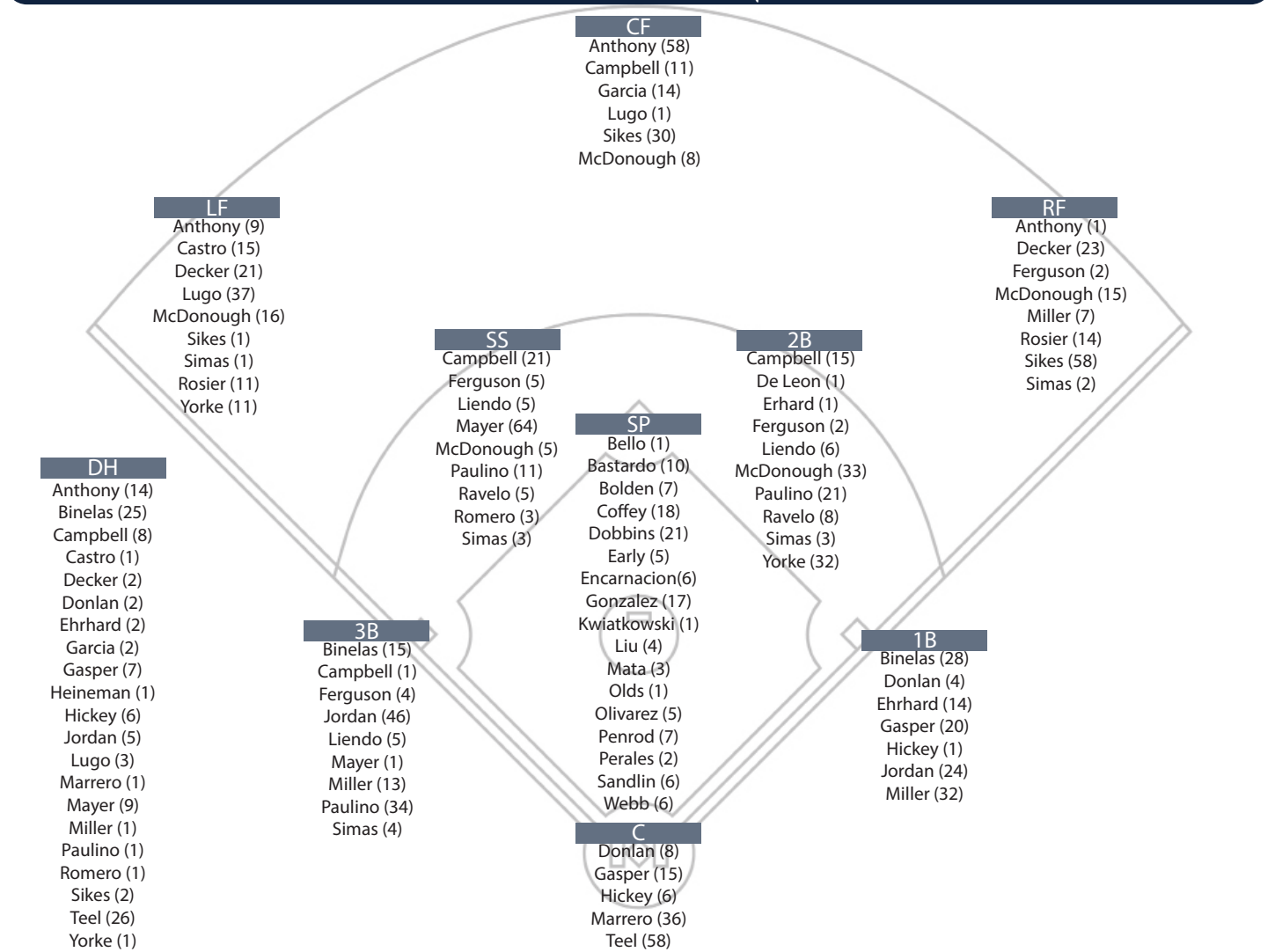
