**TODAY** marks game #104 of the 2023 season, the fourth game of a six-game roadtrip, and the fourth game of a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 17 times during the 2022 regular season, with the Whitecaps winning the series 9-8, and will play 24 times in 2023. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 29th season in pro baseball, while Great Lakes is in their 16th year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers.

**UP NEXT:** The 'Caps return to LMCU Ballpark for a six-game series against the South Bend Cubs from August 15-August 20 before embarking on a 12-game roadtrip -- their longest of the season before concluding the 2023 regular season in West Michigan against the Loons at LMCU Ballpark.

### STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

**LAST TIME OUT:** The West Michigan Whitecaps saw dominant pitching and a huge swing from Tigers top-10 prospect Hao-Yu Lee propel them to a 6-2 victory over the Great Lakes Loons in front of 3,920 fans Thursday night at Dow Diamond. Lee - the Detroit Tigers #6 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline - delivered a three-run homer in the third inning, his first as a West Michigan Whitecap. Meanwhile, Whitecaps starter Troy Melton allowed just two runs through six innings with four strikeouts as West Michigan held Great Lakes to a 2-for-7 mark with runners in scoring position in the victory. West Michigan grabbed the lead by plating five runs in the third inning - featuring the three-run homer from Hao-Yu Lee - taking the commanding 5-0 lead. Great Lakes responded in the bottom of the third as Jake Vogel added an RBI double before crossing the plate on an RBI single from Taylor Young, cutting the 'Caps lead to 5-2. Meanwhile, the Whitecaps loaded the bases in the fourth and fifth but only added one insurance run, as Austin Murr added an RBI - extending the advantage to 6-2. West Michigan pitchers retired 16 of the last 17 batters they faced as Great Lakes failed to rally. Whitecaps relievers Angel Reyes and Trevin Michael combined for three scoreless frames with three strikeouts to slam the door on the 6-2 victory. The Whitecaps improve to 53-50 overall and 21-17 in the second half, while the Loons fall to 64-40 overall and 19-20 in the second half. Melton (3-1) picks up his third win of the season while Loons starter Hyun-il Choi (2-3) suffers his third loss, allowing five runs through 2.2 innings pitched. The Whitecaps now sit just a half-game behind the Fort Wayne TinCaps for first place in the Midwest League East Division. The Whitecaps have won nine of their last ten contests and are 7-1 in August.

**TROP-ICAL DISASTER:** The Baltimore Orioles are 6-3 against the Tampa Bay Rays this season and 4-2 at Tropicana Field after their 5-3 win on July 23, despite hitting .192 with a .254 on-base percentage in those contests, scoring 3.3 runs per game. Since the Rays joined Major League Baseball in 1998, Baltimore holds a record of 213-234, with the O's going 116-107 at Camden Yards and 98-127 at 'The Trop.'

**IMPOSING HIS WIL-KEL:** Tonight's Whitecaps starting pitcher Wilkel Hernandez has allowed just two runs over his last 21 innings pitched while posting a 25-to-2 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

**BRINGING THE PENA:** Whitecaps pitcher Carlos Pena was named Midwest Player of the Week on July 24. The lefty tossed ten innings while giving up just one run on one base hit while striking out eight batters. The 24-year-old also brought home Midwest League Pitcher of the Month for April earlier this season, and currently holds the third-lowest ERA in the Midwest League at 3.44.

**GUARDIAN ANGEL:** 'Caps pitcher Angel Reyes now leads the franchise in appearances with 131 over the course of four years with the team.

**PROSPECTS APLENTY:** The Whitecaps hold 10 of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects, and are mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

**HEALTH REPORT:** The 'Caps IL holds three players in P Aaron Haase, C Eduardo Valencia and IF Roberto Campos.

Burhenn played three seasons with the Ohio State Buckeyes, compiling a career 15-8 record with 189 punchouts through 192.2 innings, earning All-Big Ten Third Team honors his Junior season with Ohio State.

Jobe, the No. 3 Prospect in the Detroit Tigers farm system, joins West Michigan after opening the season with Low-A Lakeland due to back stiffness he suffered during the offseason. Jobe - who finished his 2022 season with the Whitecaps - was ranked a Top-50 Prospect in Major League Baseball at the time of his assignment to West Michigan last year.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Jobe enjoyed his best start with the Whitecaps this season, tossing five scoreless innings on four hits with six strikeouts en route to a 2-0 shutout victory over the Lake County Captains on August 4 at LMCU Ballpark.

**2023:** After suffering a back injury during the offseason, Jobe began his 2023 campaign with the FCL Tigers and Low-A Lakeland - where he averaged over a strikeout per inning - working a 24/3 strikeout-to-walk ratio through 18 innings pitched and allowing just two runs.

**2022:** Spent most of the season with Low-A Lakeland, compiling a 2-5 record with a 4.52 ERA and averaging over a strikeout per inning, punching out 71 batters through 61.2 innings of work. Jobe then finished 2022 with three starts for West Michigan, allowing just two earned runs through 15.2 innings with 10 strikeouts and a 1.15 ERA.

**MORE:** The 2021 Gatorade Oklahoma High School Player of the Year. Ranked MLB Pipeline's top prep pitching prospect (No. 7 overall) last year after going 9-0 with a 0.13 ERA and 122/5 K/BB ratio in 51 2/3 innings and helping Heritage Hall capture a state 4-A title. Detroit went above his pre-Draft ranking to take Jobe at No. 3 overall and gave him a \$6.9 million signing bonus, the second-highest of the 2021 Draft.

From MLB Pipeline: The slider is easily Jobe's premium pitch. The offering comes in the low 80s and sports elite spin rates above 3,000 rpm. As if that wasn't enough, the right-hander can spot the breaking pitch well, making it even tougher. He currently sits at 92-94 mph most days with the four-seam heater, and there have been occasions where he's thrown more in the mid-90s. A low-80s changeup with plenty of dropping action gives him a third quality pitch -- and one that can be used against batters on both sides of the plate -- while his upper-70s curve provides another look, even if it's only used to set up the other pitches.

Jobe's delivery is repeatable and athletic, and throwing strikes shouldn't be much of a concern on the pro side. There may be some baby steps along the way, but the building blocks are evident in what could make Jobe a future No. 2 starter in Detroit.
