History vs. Quad Cities

The Lugnuts are 83-88 all-time vs. the River Bandits, 45-37 at home and 38-51 in Davenport.

The Nuts have played at Quad Cities for four straight seasons, 2023-2026, but the River Bandits have traveled to Michigan's state capital only once in the last five years: 2023, when the Lugnuts won four of six.

The Lugnuts have won each of the first four games, clinching a series victory, and enter today on a six-game winning streak.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 12, River Bandits 9. The Lugnuts scored at least 12 runs for the third straight game, outslugging the Bandits to win on the first LAFCU Fireworks night of the year. After getting blanked in the first two innings, the Nuts scored in each of their next six at-bats, aided by 14 walks handed out by four River Bandits pitchers. Dylan Fien delivered an RBI triple and a two-run double in the win.

LUG-NOTES

A Milestone Night: Thursday night was the 2,000th all-time win in Lansing Lugnuts history... which made last night win no. 2,001.

Deep Sixing the Opposition: The Nuts' current six-game winning streak marks their longest such streak since a seven-game winning streak from April 13-19, 2025, against Great Lakes and Wisconsin.

Hail and Farewell: Lansing starter **Kyle Robinson** was traded to the Pittsburgh Pirates shortly before his scheduled start last night, with the Athletics receiving Triple-A infielder **Alika Williams**.

Welcome Aboard: Reliever **Jay Dill** joins the Lugnuts from Class-A Stockton today; when he appears in a game, he'll become the 999th player in Lugnuts team history.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster boasts four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 26 (**Nate Nankil**).

Taylor-Made Success: Outfielder **Devin Taylor** leads the Midwest League in base hits (43) and runs batted in (31) while ranking 5th in walks (33), 7th in OBP (.447), 7th in batting average (.321) and 9th in total bases (64). Since April 10, Taylor is batting .360/.476/.544 in 32 games, with more walks (28) than strikeouts (27).

Got Their Number: Speaking of **Devin Taylor**, the Indiana Hoosier is batting .417/.523/.611 this year against Quad Cities, reaching base 23 times (15 hits, 8 walks) in 10 games.

History: The Nuts tied a single franchise record with 14 walks in yesterday's win, and have coaxed 37 walks in four games total against Quad Cities, posting a team OBP of .449 for the week. (The only team that has topped the Nuts' 46 runs on 39 hits and 37 walks in four games: South Bend, which has scored 50 runs on 51 hits and 38 walks in four games against Wisconsin.)

Green Power: **Rodney Green, Jr.**'s 490-foot home run on Tuesday night was the longest tracked home run of the 2026 season, Major League or Minor League; it was also Green's first home run since he blasted a pair on Opening Day against Dayton on April 2.

Bolting to the Show: 2024 Lugnuts outfielder **Henry Bolte** put together a remarkable 12-for-12 streak from May 7-9 for Triple-A Las Vegas en route to a Major League callup to the Athletics. The streak was part of a ridiculous hot stretch for Bolte: 25-for-42, five doubles, one triple, five homers, .595/.622/1.119 in the month of May. The 22-year-old Bolte debuted May 13 for the A's with singles in each of his first two at-bats against the Cardinals, becoming the 203rd all-time Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues and the third this season.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

MAY 16 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2008: The Lugnuts split a doubleheader at West Michigan, losing Game 1, 6-3, before winning Game 2, 5-0, behind a three-hit CG from Randy Boone, who walked one and struck out seven.

2019: The Lugnuts lost their ninth straight road game, tying a franchise record, in a 9-0 rain-shortened loss to Fort Wayne. 19-year-old TinCaps starter Joey Cantillo faced the minimum in six innings, striking out six, and allowing one runner: a Rafael Lantigua second-inning single that was wiped out one pitch later by a caught stealing. Infielder Nick Podkul went 0-for-2, ending his Midwest League best 24-game on-base streak. The game was halted two pitches into the seventh inning by rain.
