**SPRINGDALE, AR** – The Northwest Arkansas Naturals scored six unanswered runs late in the game, but could not come back from the Springfield Cardinals' offensive explosion, dropping the fifth straight game of the series, 13-10.

- Offensively, the Naturals tied their single-game high this week with 11 hits, scoring more runs than the previous three games combined.
- After Springfield scored four times in the top of the second, Northwest Arkansas responded with three runs in the bottom half, a two-run home run from **John Rave** and a sacrifice fly from **Brhet Bewley**.
- First baseman **Robbie Glendinning** came a triple shy of the cycle in the loss, going 3-for-4 with his seventh home run of the season to lead off the fourth inning and two runs batted in overall.
- The Naturals responded to the Cardinals' four runs with four of their own, loading the bases on singles from **Sebastian Rivero**, **Ryan Grotjohn** and **Nick Loftin**. **Tucker Bradley** singled in Rivero and Grotjohn, Loftin scored on a wild pitch and Bradley scored on an RBI single from Glendinning.
- In the eighth, the Naturals inched to runs closer, as Seuly Matias led off the inning with a single and Rivero drilled a two-run shot to left field, the final two runs of the night.
- While starter **Noah Murdock** struggled, allowing five runs over 2.1 innings, the first arm out of the bullpen, **Zack Phillips**, was a bright spot. Phillips threw 2.2 scoreless innings, facing eight batters and recording eight outs, with only one walk on his line.
- Andres Sotillet** entered the game in the eighth and offered 2.0 scoreless innings as well, giving the Naturals a chance to complete the comeback.

### THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

#### The Naturals are 5-4 all-time when playing on June 26

On June 26, 2016, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Tulsa Drillers, 8-3 at ONEOK Field, with a consistent offensive performance and strong relief effort. Four bullpen arms: **Tim Hill**, **Matt Alvarez**, **Yender Caramo** and **Mark Peterson** combined to hold the Drillers scoreless over the final 5.2 innings of the game, with just one hit and no walks, while striking out six. All nine Naturals in the starting lineup had a hit, including three-hit days for third baseman **Jack López** and left fielder **Ryan O'Hearn**, with O'Hearn becoming just the sixth player in franchise history to double three times.

**FOLLOW THE LEADER**

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 16 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 8 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter** and **John Rave**.

**EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 25-3, while when scoring six runs or less, just 6-33.
- The Naturals are 19-8 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 12-28.
- The Naturals are 29-10 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 2-26 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 20-10, whereas 11-26 when the opponent scores first.

**ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY**

The Naturals are 3-13 in one-run games this season, meaning 13 of their 36 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in eight losses this season (six one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 15 losses this season (including 10 of their one-run losses).

**RIGHT WHERE THEY BELONG**

The Northwest Arkansas Naturals have generally hovered around .500 for most of the season, but the loss yesterday brought the team down to a season-worst five games under .500 with a 31-46 record ... the Naturals have been at or within a game of .500 after 40 of 67 games this season (59.7%).

- The team has peaked at two games above .500, at a 15 - 13 record after the game May 10, but with a low-point of five games under .500 currently.
- After 14 of 67 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day with an even .500 record.
- After 26 of 67 games this season, the Naturals have ended the day within a game of .500, either one game over or under.

**Yo, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?**

Through 67 games, the Naturals have stolen 92 bases in 108 attempts (average 1.37 steals/game, 85.19% success rate).

- 92 steals ranks second in the Texas League, fourth in Double-A and 23rd in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's** 23 steals (in 25 attempts) ranks tied second in the Texas League and tied fourth among all Double-A hitters/basestealers.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 12 times, meaning 24 of 92 steals this year (26.1%) have come on a double-steal.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 44 of 67 games this season, including 24 games with two or more steals ... there have been three occasions where the team has stolen five bases, with perfect 5-for-5 steal efforts as a club on 5/13 vs. Wichita and 5/21 @ Arkansas.
- Naturals players have stolen two bases in a game 11 times, led by **FOUR** two-steal games from Garcia.

**GAR-SEE YA ON BASE**

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in 56 of the 63 games he has played in this season, reaching base multiple times on 36 occasions, including a team-best 20 multi-hit games.

- In 297 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 111 times (75 hits + 36 walks), for a .376 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 36 times and struck out 48 times, a 0.75 K/BB rate that ranks fourth among Royals minor league hitters with at least 200 plate appearances.
- The shortstop places among the Texas League leaders in several categories, ranking tied second in steals (23), tied third in hits (75), fourth in doubles (19) and tied 10th in runs scored (46) ... he ranks among the Double-A leaders steals (tied fourth), hits (tied fifth) and doubles (tied seventh).
- Maikel's 19 doubles lead all Royals Minor League hitters ... he ranks second in the system in hits (75) steals (23), tied second in runs scored (46) and walks (36), fourth in on-base percentage (.376), tied fourth in total bases (102), fifth in batting average (.292) and tied sixth in extra-base hits (22).
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for the 15th-longest in club history and tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

**PUSHIN P(ORTER)**

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks eighth in on-base percentage (.456), fifth among all Double-A hitters in OBP ... in the Texas League, he is fourth in OBP, eighth in OPS (.972) and 10th in batting average (.307).
- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage and OPS and ranks second in batting average and third in slugging percentage (.500) behind Omaha's Vinnie Pasquantino (.577) and teammate Tyler Gentry (.521) ... his 36 walks are tied for the second-most in the system, with teammate Maikel Garcia, behind Omaha's Nick Pratto (38).
- Porter has reached base in 44 of 49 games he's played this season, with hits in 31 of 49 and 17 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
- Porter's 17-game on-base streak between May 31 and June 23 is tied with Robbie Glendinning for the longest on the team this season, a stretch where he hit .321 (17-for-53) with 15 walks and a .493 on-base percentage ... Friday was the first game this month where Porter did not get on base at least once, the last two games are the first time Porter has not gotten on base in any way back-to-back games.

**QUALITY OF STARTS**

Northwest Arkansas Naturals starting pitcher have delivered 10 quality starts this season through the first 67 games (average of one quality start every 6.7 games)... a QS requires a pitcher throws at least six innings and allows three earned runs or fewer.

- Anthony Veneziano's** last three starts have all been quality starts: June 9 @ Tulsa (7.0 IP, 0 ER), June 14 vs. Arkansas (6.0 IP, 3 ER) and June 19 vs. Arkansas (6.0 IP, 0 ER).
- While no longer with the team, **Drew Parrish** lead the Naturals with four quality starts, including the first of the season on April 26 vs. Amarillo (6.0 IP, 0 ER).
- Marcelo Martinez** delivered a quality start in his first outing of the year with the Naturals on May 4 in Springfield (6.0 IP, 0 ER), while **Ángel Zerpa** offered his first on May 29 @ Midland (6.2 IP, 3 ER).
- Most recently, **Alec Marsh** delivered a quality start in his last outing, on June 23 vs. Springfield (6.0 IP, 3 ER).
- Naturals starting pitchers have had 11 starts of 6.0 innings or more, the only one that was not a quality start was from Marsh, on May 31 vs. Corpus Christi (6.0 IP, 5 ER).

**Pitchers of the Month (1)**

\* **May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

**Players of the Week (2)**

\* **April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

\* **May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

**Pitchers of the Week (3)**

\* **May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.

\* **May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

\* **June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.

**TOOLS TEAM**

Five Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America's* 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF **Nick Loftin** is rated as having the "*Best Strike-Zone Discipline*" in the system.
- SS **Maikel Garcia** is rated as having the "*Best Infield Arm*" in the system.

- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). - Accola graduated from the University of Central Missouri in 2014 and previously held an athletic training internship with the Denver Broncos in 2013.

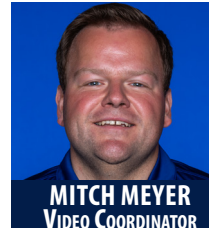
