TODAY'S GAMES: Having won three consecutive games and secured at least a series split, Sugar Land continues their six-game series with Albuquerque... Today is game 12 in a stretch where the Space Cowboys play 13 games in 13 days... Sugar Land is 5-6 on the road trip so far.

ABOUT FRIDAY NIGHT: After Bligh Madris hit a two-run homer in the 1st, the Space Cowboys saw Albuquerque score six unanswered runs and take a 6-2 lead into the 7th... Luke Berryhill launched a two-run homer in the 7th and David Hensley followed with a solo shot, pulling Sugar Land within a run... In the 8th, Alex McKenna hit a two-out, bases-clearing triple to put the Space Cowboys ahead 8-6... The Isotopes tied the contest with a two-run botttom of the 8th, but Joe Perez brought in two runs on a throwing error in the 9th to put Sugar Land in front for good, and Joe Record locked down his 8th save in a 10-8 victory.

ROSTER MOVES: 6/9 - C César Salazar recalled by Houston... RHP Jimmy Endersby reinstated from the Development List... RHP Cesar Gomez transferred to Corpus Christi.

HOME GROWN TALENT: Sugar Land's active roster has 12 players drafted by the Astros, 4 international signings and 2 player signed as non-drafted free agents in the five-round 2020 MLB Draft.

PROSPECTING: The Space Cowboys roster boasts eight of the Astros Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. They include C Korey Lee (#5), OF Pedro León (#6), OF Justin Dirden (#7), RHP Misael Tamrez (#11), INF Joe Perez (#14), RHP Forrest Whitley (#19), OF Quincy Hamilton (#22) & RHP Shawn Dubin (#23)

SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING: Sugar Land is 3-5-0 in six-game series this year, 0-1 in seven-game series and 1-0 in three-game series... The Space Cowboys have gone 2-0-0 in their last two home series and 2-2-0 overall at Constellation Field.

**ON THE RECORD:** RHP Joe Record has made 12 straight outings without allowing an earned run, tossing a scoreless ninth to secure the his eighth save on Friday night... In the month of May, Record made 13 appearances, giving up just 2 earned runs in 13.2 innings, converting 6 of 7 saves in that span... His eight saves are the second most in the PCL this year, and Record is tied for second in the Pacific Coast League in appearances with 24.

MCKENNA MAKING THE MOST: Despite not playing in each of the first three contests, Alex McKenna came into Friday night on a five-game hitting streak... He extended it in his final at bat of the night, hitting a bases-clearing triple, his first of the year and first three-bagger since April 6 of this season while with Double-A Corpus. During his hitting streak, McKenna is hitting .347 (8-23) with a triple and 4 RBI.

LEE-DING THE WAY: After notching 10 doubles in May, Korey Lee has already collected three doubles in June, giving him 16 for the season, tied for the second most in the PCL.

WHAT A WEEK: The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high in MiLB.

GOING IN FRONT IN GRAND FASHION: On 5/13, for the second time in 8 games, the Space Cowboys hit a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning, with Rylan Bannon launching a grand slam. The grand slam capped a six-run frame and helped finish a comeback from 4-1 down to win 7-5... Justin Dirden delivered the other go-ahead grand slam on Friday, 5/5 @ ABQ, part of a 7-run frame that pushed the Space Cowboys over the top after trailing 8-2 going to the seventh.

BIRTHDAY LAUNCHING POINT: Outfielder Pedro Leon turned 25 on 5/28 and celebrated by blasting a solo home run... Since his birthday bomb, Leon has hit safely in eight of his last nine games, slashing .344/.400/.875/1.275 with 2 doubles, 5 home runs and 9 RBI... He's homered in five of his last nine games and four of his last six.

WHAT'S YOUR NAME, MAN?: In his Triple-A debut on Wednesday night, Quincy Hamilton homered in each of his first two times up, launching an opposite-field homer to left in the 2nd and a solo home run to right in the 4th... It's the second multi-home run game of his career for Hamilton, with his other coming on July 15, 2022 while with High-A Asheville ... Hamilton provided an encore on Thursday night, hitting a solo home run in the 7th inning, giving him three homers in two games... Including his final game with Double-A Corpus, Hamilton has homered in three straight games and has homered in five of his last eight contests.

WHIFFS ON WHIFFS ON WHIFFS: RHP Misael Tamarez generated an impressive 18 swings and misses on Wednesday night against Albuquerque, the most swings and misses in Triple-A on Wednesday night... The right-hander effectively used his slider, hurling 43 of them and getting 14 whiffs on 24 total swings against his slider, throwing it for strikes 68% of the time.... Jairo Solis followed on Thursday night by also generating 18 swings and misses, the second most in Triple-A on Thursday, getting 10 whiffs on his slider and 6 swing and misses on just 10 total curveballs... In their first four games, Sugar Land pitching has walked just 11 batters, the fewest in the PCL in that span, while striking out 34 hitters.

 **RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ:** On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
  Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate.... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

**GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN:** Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN:** In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT: On Tuesday, 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

**UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD:** As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as "Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

**NOW HERE'S A STOREY:** Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND: Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- **Primary Logo:** The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandanna and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- Horizon Gradient: Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient
  feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms.
  The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon
- Mission Patch: This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

**A LITTLE ABOUT US:** Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

**REST OF THE CREM**: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Started on Sunday at Round Rock... Gave up three unearned runs in the bottom of the first inning... While tying a season and career high with five walks, only gave up one hit and did not allow a run the rest of his outing... Left with a 6-3 lead before Sugar Land allowed 10 in the bottom of the fifth in a 20-9 defeat.

**NEW TO THIS:** Garcia made 126 appearances in the Minors and 72 appearances in the Major Leagues before making his first career start on 7/10/22 @ Omaha... Today is just his 22nd career start.

**IN SPRING:** Made 5 appearances for the Astros, one start... Went 1-0, 1.64 ERA... In 11.0 IP, allowed two runs on six hits with five walks and eight strikeouts... Made his only start of Spring Training on 3/15 @ Atlanta, earned the win while throwing 3.0 shutout innings.

**WELCOME TO HOUSTON:** Garcia signed with the Astros as a free agent on 2/7/23... Elected free agency from the Tigers on 11/11/22.

**DON'T I KNOW YOU?:** In 2021 with the Tigers, Garcia earned a save on April 14 at Minute Maid Park. The right-hander entered the game in the ninth inning with the bases loaded, no one out and the tying run at first. The righty allowed just one runner to score as he secured the save, the first Tigers' pitcher to inherit three base runners and earn a save in the same game since Francisco Rodriguez in April of 2017.

**ROOKIE IMPRESSIONS:** After debuting in 2019 with Detroit, Garcia spent all of 2020 with the Tigers, making 26 appearances. He recorded four saves and did allow an inherited runner to score, the first Tigers rookie to recorded more than two saves in a season since 2003. He earned his first Major League save on 9/6/20 @ Minnesota.

**MISSED TIME:** Did not pitch in the 2018 and didn't debut until May of 2019 while recovering from right elbow surgery.

**NO RUNS FOR YOU:** Pitched across four levels in 2017 and put together a 24.2 scoreless innings streak from April 29 through July 2... During that stretch, went 2-0 with 8 saves and 41 strikeouts

**ROCK YOU LIKE A HURRICANE:** Drafted in the 6th round of the 2016 draft by the Detroit Tigers out of the University of Miami. While at Miami, converted 43 saves, the most in school history and tied for the most in ACC history. In 2016, was named the NCBWA Stopper of the Year after going 2-0 with 18 saves and a 1.89 ERA in 35 appearances.
