LAST TIME OUT: Hess dominated the Wilmington Blue Rocks last Thursday night at Frawley Stadium, taking a no-hitter into the seventh inning and finishing with a career-high 6.2 innings pitched while allowing one unearned run on one hit, one walk and nine strikeouts. After Johnathan Thomas led off the bottom of the first by reaching on a catcher's interference, Hess retired the next 17 straight batters before a walk to Thomas in the sixth. The lone hit allowed was a comebacker that glanced off his leg for an infield single from Caleb Lomavita.

- •Struck out nine batters in his professional debut on 4/9 @ Brooklyn: 4.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 9 K on 70 pitches.
- •Took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on 5/7 @ Wilmington: 6.2 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 9 K on 88 pitches. Lone hit allowed was an infield single by Caleb Lomavita in the seventh that deflected off Hess' leg.

RECORD SETTER: While at Alabama, Hess set the program's all-time record with 13.34 K/9, while striking out 34.6% of batters he

FIRST TIME, LONG TIME: When Hess was drafted by the Yankees in the 1st round of the 2024 MLB Draft. he became the first pitcher taken by the Yankees with their first pick since they took Clarke Schmidt 16th overall in the 2017 MLB Draft. In between, the Yankees selected position players Anthony Seigler (2018), Anthony Volpe (2019), Austin Wells (2020), Trey Sweeney (2021), Spencer Jones (2022), and George Lombard (2023) with thier first picks in six consecutive drafts. It was the longest run of position players selected by the Yankees with their first pick in the history of the Yankees. Hess is just the second four-year college pitcher drafted by the Yankees with their first pick since the team selected Andrew Brackman 30th overall in the 2007 MLB Draft, and the fourth since the Yankees drafted **Dave Walling** 27th overall in 1999 (also **Ian Kennedy**, 21st overall in 2006)

WE WANT 'BAMA: Hess became only the fifth player from the University of Alabama to be drafted in the first round of the First-Year Player Draft when he was selected 26th overall by the Yankees in 2024. He joined first baseman Joe Vitiello (seventh overall in 1991 by the Kansas City Royals), catcher Jeremy Brown (35th overall in 2002 by the Oakland Athletics), LHP Taylor Tankersley (27th overall in 2004 by the Florida Marlins) and RHP Tommy Hunter (54th overall in 2007 by the Texas Rangers). The Athletics' drafting of Brown was chronicled in the best-selling book Moneyball by Michael Lewis, but was omitted from the Hollywood film of the same name. Arguably the most-successful Crimson Tide alumni to play Major League Baseball was Hall of Fame Joe Sewell, who played for Cleveland (1920-30) and the Yankees (1931-33), batting .312 lifetime and being regarded as the hardest player to strike out in MLB history, fanning just 114 times in 8333 career plate appearances (1.4 K%).

- Was ranked as the #38 overall prospect by Baseball America and #44 by MLB Pipeline in the 2024 draft class.

SECOND STARTING PITCHER

CARLOS LAGRANGE • RHP • 6'6" • 230 LBS • 21

LAST TIME OUT: Lagrange mowed through the Wilmington Blue Rocks lineup last Wednesday night at Frawley Stadium, allowing a leadoff double in the bottom of the first to Marcus Brown, and then setting down the next 17 batters he faced. In the outing, the right-hander struck out nine and walked one while allowing one unearned run on two hits while throwing a career-high 97 pitches. The Renegades offense cruised to a 12-1 win, allowing Lagrange to pick up his third win of the season.

LIMITED DUTIES: Lagrange's 2024 season was hampered by lower back inflammation which limited him to only 21.0 innings during the regular season. Owing to that, the hard-throwing right-hander enters his fourth professional season in 2025 with fewer than 100.0 professional innings pitched.

TOUCHING TRIPLE DIGITS: Lagrange has always been a hard thrower, and in the 2025 Yankees Spring Breakout Game against Orioles prospects, Lagrange got the start for the Yankees squad, throwing four innings and allowing two runs (one earned), two hits, two strikeouts and no walks. One of the most eye-opening moments was his pitches being clocked at 100 mph.

FALL STAR: Following the 2024 season, Lagrange pitched for the Salt River Rafters of the prestigious Arizona Fall League to solid results. In five games (four starts), Lagrange posted a 2.08 ERA (2 ER/8.2 IP), and struck out 10 batters. However, he also issued 15 walks to 43 total batters faced, a shocking 34.8% walk rate.

BREAKING BALL ADJUSTMENTS: Like many pitchers in the Yankees system, Lagrange features two distinct sliders. He throws a sweeper (82-85), and a harder, shorter slider in the upper 80s. He previously threw a curveball, which he has mostly scrapped as a pitch, although reportedly he was throwing the curve some in the Arizona Fall League.
