INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Led by two home runs off the bat of Henry Davis, the Indianapolis Indians combined for a season-high six home runs en route to a 10-8 victory over the lowa Cubs on Thursday evening in the third game of the series at Principal Park. Trailing by three following an Alexander Canario three-run homer in the first inning, Matt Gorski responded in the top of the second with a two-run blast of his own. Andrés Alvarez then tied the game later in the inning with his second Triple-A home run. Indianapolis broke through again with a four-run third inning, highlighted by solo homers off the bats of Davis and Malcom Nuñez. The Indians then padded their lead with Davis' second solo homer of the night in the fourth inning. In the bottom half of the frame, lowa picked up a run on an RBI groundout courtesy of Darius Hill. With Indy leading 9-4, the I-Cubs chipped away with four solo home runs courtesy of Miles Mastrobuoni, Pete Crow-Armstrong, Ali Sánchez and Canario's second homer of the night in the final four innings. Indianapolis added its sixth home run on Gilberto Celestino's first round-tripper of the season in the ninth inning.

ABOUT THE HOME RUNS, PART III: Following last night's season-high six-homer game, the Indians are leading all 30 Triple-A teams with 16 homers over their past six games dating back to last Saturday, May 18, vs. Toledo. Last night marked the first time Indianapolis has hit six home runs in a game since Aug. 6, 2021, at lowa. It was also just the sixth time since 2005 that the Indians hit six-plus homers in a single contest. Henry Davis and Matt Gorski have led the charge for the Indians, each hitting five home runs in their last five games dating back to Saturday.

HANK'S TWO TANKS: Henry Davis led the Indians offense with three hits and his second two-homer performance in his last five games last night at Principal Park. It was his fifth career multi-homer performance and followed May 18 vs. Toledo as his second of the season. Davis has hit safely in seven of his last eight games with a .419 batting average (13-for-31), 11 runs, four doubles, six home runs, 12 RBI, 1.129 slugging percentage and 1.643 OPS. That stretch has also included a current five-game streak with at least one extra-base hit. After going 3-for-19 in his first six games, he has now raised his batting average to .320 (16-for-50) in 14 games with Indy. Davis has now reached base safely in 13 of his 14 games with Indianapolis since May 7 and is tied with Malcom Nuñez for the second-most home runs (6) among team leaders (trailing Matt Gorski's 7).

GORSKI GOES YARD (AGAIN): Matt Gorski continued his torrid stretch in Triple-A yesterday, launching a two-run home run for his fifth consecutive game with at least one extra-base hit and multiple RBI. The home run was his fifth in his past five games with Indianapolis since Saturday, a stretch which including a two-homer, five-RBI performance in the series-opener on Tuesday at Principal Park. To pair with his stretch of home runs, he roped a triple on Wednesday and now leads the International League with a career-high five three-baggers this season. Since finishing a single shy of the cycle on Saturday vs. Toledo, he is 10-for-21 with eight extra-base hits and 17 RBI, good for a 1.429 slugging percentage and 1.929 OPS

OUTTA HERE FOR ALVY: Andrés Alvarez has joined the hot Indians offense this week at lowa, hitting safely in all three games while going 2-for-3 with a home run and two RBI last night. In his past three games, he is 5-for-13 with two extra-base hits, three RBI and two walks. His first home run of the season came on May 1 after beginning the campaign on the 7-day injured list. In 2023, Alvarez hit eight home runs in 96 games with Double-A Altoona after hitting 20 in 110 games at the same level in 2022.

MALCOM MASHES: Malcom Nuñez joined in on the home run party last night, launching a solo shot for his sixth homer of the year while going 2-for-4. It was his second home run of the series after joining Matt Gorski and Henry Davis with a homer during Tuesday's four home run showing by the Indians offense. Three of the slugger's six homers this season have come in his last eight games since hitting another solo shot on May 16 (2) vs. Toledo.

GILBERTO GETTING HOT: Gilberto Celestino went yard to give the Indians an insurance run in the top of the ninth inning yesterday, his first homer since Sept. 7, 2023, with St. Paul at Louisville. He launched four home runs in 55 games with St. Paul last season. Celestino has been hot as of late, reaching base safely in each of his last 10 games while working a current five-game hitting streak since May 19 (1) vs. Toledo. In 15 May games, he owns a .304 batting average (17-for-56), nine runs, three extra-base hits, five RBI and three stolen bases.

RAKE LAMB: Jake Lamb doubled last night to extend his current on-base streak to 24 games since April 18. During his on-base streak – which bests Nick Gonzales' 21-game streak as the longest by an Indians batter this season and is tied for the third-longest in the International League this season – he is hitting .348 (31-for-89) with 16 runs, 11 doubles, one home run, 17 RBI, .426 on-base percentage and .932 OPS. On Wednesday, he recorded his first four-hit game since June 21, 2023, with Triple-A Salt Lake vs. Sugar Land. He has now reached base safely in 34 of 35 games this season with a .344 batting average (44-for-128), 20 runs, 12 doubles, three homers, 23 RBI and 21 walks.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue their six-game series against the I-Cubs — their first of three this season — tonight at 8:08 PM ET at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa. The Indians went 10-14 against Iowa last season, logging a 3-9 record in two series on the road. Continuing the series for Indianapolis tonight is RHP Daulton Jefferies (0-0, 9.00), who has never faced lowa and has made just one start in the International League this season. lowa has yet to name a

THIS DATE IN 1974: Tom Carroll tossed the seventh no-hitter in franchise history on a Friday at Omaha. Both starters went the distance, with Carroll improving to 3-2 on the season after issuing just two walks and striking out five. For Omaha, Dennis Leonard allowed two runs — both driven in by Ed Armbrister — on eight hits and four walks with six strikeouts.
