ENCARNACION CLUBS GO-AHEAD HOMER IN WIN

Troy Johnston blasted a solo home run, but it was not enough as the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Norfolk Tides 3-1 Thursday afternoon at Harbor Park. The Tides took the early lead in the first and never looked back, plating two runs. Jacksonville's first hit of the game didn't come until the fourth when Johnston smacked his eighth homer of the season, cutting the deficit to a one-run game.

"OFFENSE SLOWLY WAKING..."

Jacksonville tallied just 11 total runs, including no more than three runs in each contest, over the entire series with Charlotte last week. The Jumbo Shrimp were just 29-for-155 (.187/.274/.258/.532) with only one home run in the series. However, in three games against Norfolk this week, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .248/.339/.438/.777. After clubbing three big flys on en route to a 9-4 win on Tuesday. Jacksonville followed with a 10-inning win. 9-7 on a two-run blast from Jerar Encarnacion. In the first three games, the Jumbo Shrimp have outscored Norfolk, 19-14, posting a 4.67 ERA in 27.0 IP. The walk numbers have jumped for the pitching staff with 16 (5.3 BB/9) free passes in the first three contests against 18 (6.0 K/9) punchouts.

'PEN PALS

Over the last three-plus weeks, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 26 games the club has played since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 31 runs, 25 earned, on 75 hits (7.6 H/9) in 88.1 innings for a 2.54 ERA. During this stretch, Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 108 batters (11.0 K/9) against 54 walks (5.5 BB/9). The bullpen's 24 consecutive innings without yielding an earned run ended Tuesday night.

MEN OF STEAL

While Jacksonville ranks just 11th in the 20-team International League in stolen bases with 116, the club has been exceptional in their efficiency at swiping bags. The Jumbo Shrimp have been successful on stealing a base at 82.3 percent of their attempts, a figure that ranks fourth in Triple-A. Over their last 20 games dating back to August 14, Jacksonville base runners have been successful on 17 of 21 stolen base attempts (81 percent).

THE AMAZING RACE

Somewhat remarkably, the top nine teams in the International League are separated by just 5.0 games entering play on Friday. Jacksonville checks in just 3.0 games out of first place, but the logjam means the Jumbo Shrimp are still only tied for fifth. Thus, with just 15 games remaining in the regular season, in order to win the IL's second-half championship and earn a playoff berth, Jacksonville would have to make up that 3.0-game deficit while also leapfrogging four other teams. If first-place Durham and Lehigh Valley even finish the season 8-7, because the club holds the tiebreaker over Jacksonville by virtue of head-to-head record, the Jumbo Shrimp would need to finish 12-3 (.800) while also hoping the five other teams ahead of them do not record a better record down the stretch

TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season, Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 37 games with the Jumbo Shrimp this year, Johnston is 51-for-144 (.354/.423/.604/1.027) with 10 doubles, one triple, eight home runs and 31 RBIs. Johnston has reached base at least once in each of his first 31 games. an on-base streak that marked the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since at least 2010. Including his time with Double-A Pensacola, Johnston has driven in 114 runs in 120 games this season, which ranks first in MiLB.

JERARSSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion endured a terrible slump in the middle of the year. In 46 games from May 16-July 14, the Bayaguana. D.R., native went just 23-for-163 (.141/.258/.380/.638) at the plate with just one double, one triple, 12 home runs, 19 RBIs and 24 walks (12.6 BB%). Encarnacion struck out a remarkable 80 times, a rate of 42.1 percent over his 190 plate appearances. In his last 30 games, however, the 26-year-old is 27-for-97 (.278/.398/.505/.903) with four doubles, six home runs, 20 RBIs and 20 walks (16.9 BB percent).

SHRIMP BITES


