### FRISCO WINS THRILLER ON FRIDAY:

The Frisco RoughRiders were edged by the San Antonio Missions, 6-4, in a back-and-forth Saturday evening game at Riders Field. Frisco (21-28) has one more game on the homestand tomorrow. San Antonio (27-23) remains one game ahead of Midland for first place in the South Division with 19 games left in the first half. Frisco's first lead of the game came early, when **Luisangel Acuña** stole second and third base in the first inning. He scored on an error to put Frisco up 1-0. San Antonio immediately took their own lead, playing three runs the next half inning. Frisco responded in like fashion, scoring two runs to tie in the second inning. **Kellen Strahm** singled and **Scott Kapers** doubled to set the table for a **Jax Biggers** sac fly and **Chris Seise**'s RBI double. With the score still 3-3 in the fourth inning, **Dustin Harris** put on a baserunning show after his leadoff double. He took third base during a dropped-third-strike sequence, then came home on a wild pitch. That put Frisco up 4-3, but the RoughRiders did not score again. **Tekoah Roby** exited with no outs in the second inning, having given up one earned run. **Theo McDowell** replaced him and did not allow an earned run in two innings. **Kyle Funkhouser** tossed a scoreless inning in his RoughRiders debut. **Danny Duffy** (0-1) allowed three earned runs in 0.2 innings for the loss, but the next three relievers -- **Justin Slaten**, **Alex Speas** and **Nick Starr** -- prevented further earned runs in their 4.1 innings. **Efrain Contreras** (2-4) went five innings with three earned runs for the win. **Nick Hernandez** entered in the ninth inning with the tying run at the plate and did not allow a base runner to get the save. **Kapers** had two doubles for Frisco. He recorded his 100th plate appearance of the year on Saturday and already has 13 extra-base hits.

### THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

With his appearance on Saturday, reliever **Alex Speas** now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.93 over 17 appearances. In 19.1 innings, he has struck out 33 to 10 walks. Opponents are hitting just .145 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last eight outings. During that span, he has struck out 18 to three walks over nine innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .111 (6-for-54) against him on the season with a .354 OPS.

### PLEASE CONNECT TO POWER:

Over the last 14 games (5-9 record), Frisco has hit just three home runs while batting .218/.325/.295/.620. The three home runs (from **Liam Hicks**, **Trevor Hauver** and **Thomas Saggese**) are the fewest in the league over the last 14. The Riders are averaging just 3.6 runs per game over the last 14 games, which is the second-fewest in the league (only in front of Northwest Arkansas, 2.9).

### AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

**Thomas Saggese** has been fantastic on Saturday, third in the Texas League with a .611 average (11-for-18) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.521 OPS on the first pitch. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .519 (14-for-27) on the initial offering.

### DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

**Dustin Harris** has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 21 bags in 45 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 48 steals, which would be far be a career high. The RoughRiders are third in fewest caught stealings in the league with just 10 while stealing 71 bases (88 percent).

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on Friday. They are the only team with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). Frisco also has a 1.261 OPS with the bags full, which is second in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.391).

### ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .292 (52-for-178)/.365/.416/.781 through the first 42 games. Over his last 38 games, he is batting .306/.385/.444/.829. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (112).

### WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 244 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .351 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is first in the league with 37 walks while **Evan Carter** is 10th in OBP (.404) in the league and third in the league with 32 walks.

### ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

### 2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

### 2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

### 2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

### 2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
