LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox won last night 8-7 over Erie in 10 innings. The last three home wins have come on a walk-off. **Tavian Josenberger** laid down a sacrifice bunt to third base and the throw from Luis Santana went into right field, allowing the winning run to score from second. **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** went 3-for-3 with a double, triple, two RBI, two runs scored and two stolen bases in his home debut. **Reed Trimble** hit his first Double-A homer in his home debut.

START ME UP

In the month of August, the Bowie starting rotation has the second-lowest ERA in Double-A at 2.35. The rotation also owns the fourth-lowest WHIP (1.05). In last week's series at Altoona, the starters combined to throw 30.1 innings with just seven earned runs allowed (2.08 ERA).

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday after going 9-for-20 (.450) with four extra base hits, including four consecutive multi-hit games, in Altoona. Beavers' 12-game on-base streak ended last night and has now reached in 80 of 99 games played this season. The Orioles No. 8 prospect is second in the Eastern League in walks (57) and tied for third in stolen bases (27).

BASALLO BASHES

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is second in the Eastern League in total bases (172) and is second in hits (108). The No. 3 O's/ No. 11 MLB prospect leads the league this month with 22 hits in 63 at-bats (.349).

BRADFIELD TO BOWIE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** went 3-for-3 with two RBI, two runs scored, two stolen bases, and was a homer shy of the cycle in his home debut. The Orioles No. 6 prospect has four stolen bases already at Double-A and 63 total on the season, which is the second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Bradfield was drafted with the 17th overall pick by the Orioles last year out of Vanderbilt.

THE JOSEN ONE

Since being promoted to Bowie last Tuesday, IF/OF **Tavian Josenberger** has registered his first Double-A hit, RBI, stolen base and walk off in his first seven games. On Saturday, he swiped four bases, a new career-high. No Baysox player had stolen more than three bases in a single game until then. Josenberger is tied for 11th in all of Minor League Baseball with 50 stolen bases.

REED IS ROLLIN'

OF **Reed Trimble** blasted his first Double-A homer last night, which traveled 392 feet. In his first five games, Trimble is 7-for-20 (.350) with a homer, three doubles and six RBI. The 24-year-old switch hitter has also stolen a career-high 29 bases this season without being caught.

IF YOU AIN'T FIRST, YOU'RE LAST

Bowie has scored in the first inning in nine of its last 13 games. When the Baysox score first, they are 38-18 this season compared to 17-41 when they do not. The Baysox have scored the second-most first inning runs in the Eastern League (68).

SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

Entering this week, the Erie SeaWolves are second in the Southwest Division with a record of 25-19. The Double-A affiliate of the Tigers won the first half in the Southwest Division. Four of the Tigers top 30 prospects are on the SeaWolves active roster - RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 2), IF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 8), RHP Troy Melton (No. 12), and RHP Eric Silva (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Carlos Pena makes his 15th start of the season for the SeaWolves. The 25-year-old southpaw has recorded a 4.12 ERA in the second half after posting a 3.98 ERA in the first half. Pena is coming off a six inning start vs Akron in which he gave up five runs on eight hits with five strikeouts in the loss. In three August starts, Pena has an ERA of 6.91. Pena was a 2019 international free agent signing by the Tigers from Santiago, DR.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
