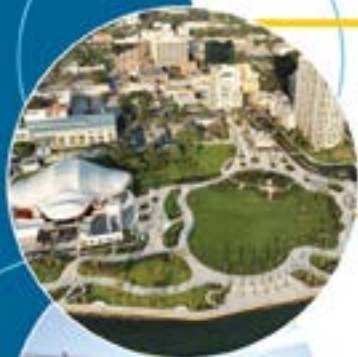

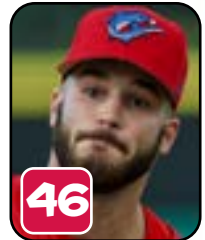

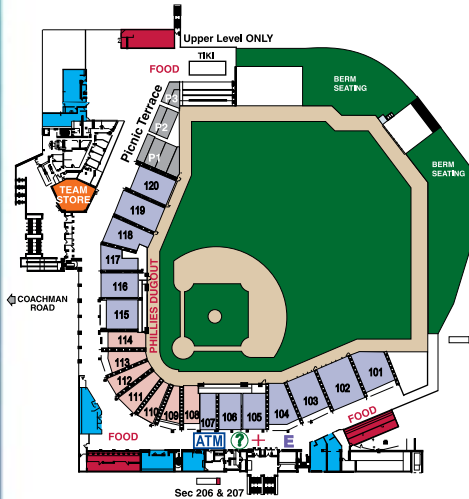

## BAYCARE BALLPARK INFORMATION



### ANNOUNCEMENTS

PA and video board announcements can be arranged for a nominal fee by visiting Guest Services behind Section 106 before the end of the second inning.

### ATM

The ATM is located on the first base side of the concourse behind section 105.

### BAGS & BACKPACKS

Bags can be no larger than 16"x16"x8" and will be subject to inspection upon entry in accordance with Major League Baseball security regulations. Guests may discard or return the prohibited items to their vehicle.

### BATS

Full-size baseball bats are prohibited from entry by guests to the ballpark.

### BERM SEATING

Berm seating is limited and ticketed. Blankets are permitted to be brought into the park for berm seating. Chairs, folding chairs, camp chairs, and the like, are not permitted to be brought into the park.

### CHILD TICKETS

Children 13 and younger qualify for the child's ticket price. For children 4 and younger, please see the BayCare Box Office or a ballpark gate attendant for a complimentary ticket.

### CUSTOMER SERVICE & ADVANCE TICKETS

The Customer Service/Advance Tickets window is located on the first base side of the main concourse behind Section 106. Guests can report problems, check for lost and found items and claim prizes at this location. Tickets for future games may also be purchased here.

### FIRST AID

The First Aid office is located on the first base side of the main concourse behind section 106. Guests can either report to this office or contact an usher if in need of medical assistance.

### FOOD AND DRINK POLICY

No food, bottles, coolers or cans may be brought into the ballpark. The Threshers reserve the right to search any medical or diaper bags entering the ballpark.

### FOUL BALLS

Any foul ball hit into the stands may be kept. Guests are not permitted on the field or to reach into the playing area. Foul balls may be dangerous, so please be alert at all times and aware of the potential hazards.

### GATES OPEN

Ballpark gates will open one hour prior to scheduled game time.

### HANDICAPPED SEATING

Disabled seating is available all throughout the ballpark. Limited wheelchair seating is available through the ticket office in person or on the telephone. One companion seat is available for purchase with each wheelchair space. An elevator is available for disabled use on the first base side of the stadium (South Parking Lot). Drop-off is available on the West Side of the ballpark (no elevator access here). Please contact an usher for assistance entering and exiting the ballpark.

### KIDS ZONE

The left-field concourse features a playground and Kids Zone for our younger guests.

### LOST AND FOUND

Located at Customer Service behind Section 106.

### SENIOR TICKETS

Seniors 55+ may purchase discounted tickets.

### SMOKING

Smoking is prohibited in most areas of the ballpark. Special smoking sections are marked. Smoking is permitted only at the Tiki Pavilion in left field. For resources to help quit smoking, call 1-877-U-CAN-NOW (1-877-822-6669).

### TEAM STORE

The Threshers Team Store, Diamond Outfitters, is located next to the ballpark's west entry, and features hats, apparel and collectibles to satisfy Threshers fans of all ages. Merchandise available 24 hours a day on-line at ThreshersBaseball.com.

### TIKI PAVILION

The Frenchy's Tiki Pavilion is located beyond the left field wall. It features a variety of mixed drinks, beer and wine for guests 21 and over. Seats in this section are first-come, first-serve during Threshers season.

### WEAPONS

Firearms, weapons, knives, tasers and other dangerous or hazardous devices or substances (collectively "weapons") are prohibited at BayCare Ballpark, unless carried by an on-duty police officer or otherwise expressly approved by The Threshers. Anyone bringing such a weapon to the premises must return it to their vehicle immediately.

**Resides:** Santa Rosa Beach, FL... Former pitcher. Entering his fifth year in the Phillies organization and his first as a manager. Joined the Phillies player development staff midseason in 2022 as bullpen coach/assistant pitching coach for Lehigh Valley (AAA) and rehab pitching coordinator.

Had the responsibilities of minor league complex pitching coordinator added to his title for the 2024 and 2025 seasons. Originally selected by the Washington Nationals in the ninth round of the June 2010 draft out of the University of Mississippi, where he earned a bachelor's degree in liberal arts. Pitched 11 seasons, including parts of four in the majors with Washington (2014-15 & 2019-20), before ending his career with Lehigh Valley in 2022.

## SHAWN WILLIAMS BENCH COACH

**Born:** Salt Lake City, UT

**Resides:** Palm Harbor, FL... Former infielder. Debut season as Threshers bench coach. Named the Florida Complex League (R) manager in 2023, his fifth managerial stop in the Phillies system. Returned as FCL manager 2024-25.

Previously served as manager for Reading (AA, 2019-22), Clearwater (A, 2017-18) and Lakewood (A, 2015-16) after joining the Phillies player development staff in 2014 as

manager for Williamsport (A). Also spent April 2014 as a fill-in bullpen catcher for the Phillies. Served as a player/coach for Williamsport in 2013. Played four seasons (2007-10) in Tampa Bay's minor league system and also played independently in the American Association (2006), Can Am League (2010-11) and Atlantic League (2010 & 2012). His father, Jimmy Williams, managed the Toronto Blue Jays, Houston Astros and Boston Red Sox and was the Phillies bench coach for two years (2007-08).

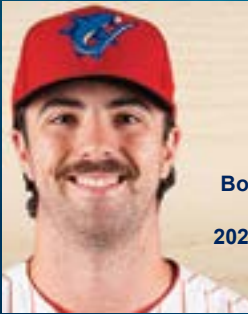

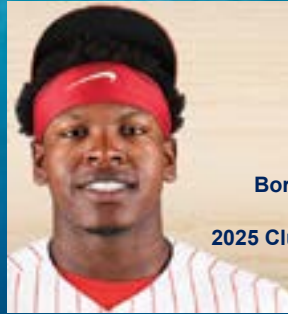

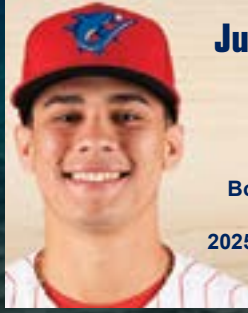

## HOW TO KEEP SCORE

### Scoring Basics...

Different fans have different methods of keeping a scorecard, and many use their own notations. But here's a simple method...

If the hitter grounds out to shortstop, for example, write in "6-3," which shows the shortstop threw him out at first base. If the hitter flies out to left field, write a "7."

If the batter gets a hit, write in the hit according to which base he reached. Each corner of the box represents a base, with the lower-right corner being first.

If he singles, put a "-" in the lower right. If he doubles, write a "-" in the upper right, and so on. For a walk, use "BB" in the lower right. As the runner advances, mark the appropriate symbol in the appropriate corner.

If a runner scores, put a circle at the bottom of the box, and inside the circle put the symbol of the play and/or the player that drove him in. For example, if the No. 5 hitter drives in two runs with a single, mark his single in the bottom right of his box and mark a circle with the number "5" in it in the boxes of the runners who score (Some people like to use uniform numbers here, so you can tell who did what, even after lineup changes).

At the end of each inning, total the hits and runs for that inning only. At the end of the game you'll be able to add the innings total to get the game score.

## Player Spotlight: Jonathan Hogart

*Despite Being Told He Couldn't, Jonathan Hogart Paved His Own Way to Turn Pro*

For aspiring professional athletes, adversity is easy to come by. There are plenty of potential hurdles, such as injuries or getting cut from a team. Many of the most successful athletes are those who stay committed to their dream regardless of any roadblocks that get in their way. Jonathan Hogart is a prime example of an athlete who faced the challenges and stayed focused on achieving his dream of becoming a professional baseball player.

For Hogart, baseball was in his family DNA. His father played college baseball and was on a softball team when Jonathan was growing up. Playing catch with his father and his teammates at those games quickly snowballed into backyard batting practice and tee ball, with Hogart's father serving as his coach and BP pitcher almost every step of the way. Even today, Hogart still loads up the truck and gets in the cage with his dad throwing him batting practice whenever he can.

“It’s therapeutic” said Hogart of taking batting practice from his dad as a child and adult. “We go hit and stuff and it just takes you all the way back...There was a song that came on during BP that reminded me of what we listened to in the truck when I was younger and it just brought back good memories.”

As his coach and mentor, Hogart’s dad helped instill in him a deep love of the game of baseball, which undoubtedly fueled his dream of playing baseball long term. The first time he got to play baseball helped Hogart realize that he wanted to make a career out of his new favorite game.

Not everyone in Hogart’s life thought becoming a professional athlete was a reasonable dream to have. Some of his teachers resisted Hogart’s enthusiastic claims that nothing would stop him from becoming a professional baseball player.

“I dressed up as a baseball player every day in elementary school, it was like, ‘this is what I’m going to do’,” said Hogart of his lifelong dream of becoming a pro athlete. “I had a teacher tell me that I should pick something more realistic and then I still showed up in a baseball uniform because I knew this was realistic for me, it’s what I’ve always wanted to do.”

By the time Hogart got to high school, his dream was starting to become a reality. He was beginning to play on the national circuit around age 12-13 and got tons of looks from elite universities and junior colleges across the country.

Hogart committed to Wabash Valley College, drawn to the winning pedigree of the prestigious junior college. In his two seasons

at Wabash, he earned Freshman of the Year and All-American status in the NJCAA before making the jump to a four-year university. After primarily serving as a catcher in high school, Hogart switched to the outfield when he first got on the field at Wabash. From the beginning, Hogart leaned on his more experienced teammates as he adjusted to the life of a college student athlete.

“Freshman year of college I would find the best players on the team and gravitate towards them,” said Hogart of his development process in junior college. “I would glue myself to them, go hit with them at night and pick their brains all the time because we had an older junior college team.”

One of those upperclassmen included former Thresher Freylin Minyety, and Hogart gave a lot of credit to his older teammates at Wabash for helping his development. He transferred

to Division I Louisiana Tech University after two years with a batting average of over .400 at Wabash.

Early on, the transfer seemed like a seamless switch for Hogart, as he was easily able to build chemistry with his new teammates while similarly seeking out the more veteran players for extra advice. Unfortunately, Hogart suffered an injury early in his first season in Louisiana.

“When I got hurt at Louisiana Tech, I couldn’t move my right arm. I couldn’t wash my hair with it,” said Hogart of his career-derailing injury that he suffered in his first season at Louisiana Tech. “When I was in therapy, they treated me like a stroke patient because I couldn’t lift five pounds over my head, and a week before I got hurt, I was shoulder pressing 95.” A world-class athlete was not unable to play the game he loved, and he thought that setback could turn permanent.

“I had a constant burning in my neck and my

trap,” said Hogart of discovering his career-threatening injury. “I went to work out that night just to do legs because I could not pick up the barbell to move it down the rack...and I didn’t know what to do.”

He was told he had a boxer’s injury, with a nerve in his shoulder shutting off and rendering some muscles in his right shoulder and arm useless. Hogart could not lift his arm above his head and was unable to hold a baseball bat. Now unable to play at Louisiana Tech due to his injury, Hogart was forced to change schools.

“I hit the [transfer] portal...just hoping I could play somewhere,” said Hogart of his decision to transfer out of Louisiana Tech after one injury-riddled season. “I thought my career was honestly going to be over.” With his injury, interest was more limited than it had been for Hogart out of high school, but he got back in contact with one of the coaches at Murray State. The Racers were unable to offer Hogart a scholarship out of high school, but their interest in Hogart as a player and student athlete had persisted.

“Coach Skirka showed his belief in me, showed his trust in me. He didn’t care about my injury,” said Hogart of Murray State’s manager, influencing his decision to transfer there. “He said he would take his time with me, and he was a man of his word. He didn’t rush me, he took care of me, and I’m forever grateful to him and indebted to him.” Hogart returned to his home state of Kentucky to continue his baseball career just as he was about to hang up his cleats for good.

After Hogart was cleared by the Murray State doctors and training staff, he was informed his shoulder injury was not expected to be

recurring, and he was able to return to his previous, elite level of play in Division I baseball. Furthermore, Hogart became a staple of the Racers' outfield, missing just two games in his two seasons combined at Murray State.

Hard work and determination are necessary characteristics of an elite athlete. Hogart demonstrated both qualities in spades with his resilience in returning to the game of baseball following an injury he thought could end his career. It turns out that the fear of losing his baseball career was a powerful enough motivator that helped Hogart take the next step.

"I wasn't fully healthy, but I played through it again," said Hogart of restarting his collegiate baseball career after the injury at Murray State. "My parents were there, and I just looked at them and I couldn't stop smiling. I didn't realize how much I'd miss the game until you don't have it in front of you anymore."

Hogart hit over .320 in two seasons at Murray State, serving as their leadoff hitter and primary centerfielder. He left college in the record books with Murray State's first homer in the College World Series in the 2000s and as the first player in school history to slug .700 or over in 250 or more at-bats.

Even Hogart's professional beginnings were a surprise to him. He didn't receive much communication from the Phillies or other MLB teams after his final game at Murray State but never lost hope that he would get to where he wanted to go.

"I was still training and preparing, but I had no idea that it was actually going to be a possibility," Hogart said of the draft process and how he felt about his potential professional career. "I remember exactly where I was when I got the call saying I was drafted, and I just broke down. Because of everything that happened over the past couple of years, especially with the shoulder, it was just like 'this is finally reality'."

The Phillies signed Hogart as a non-drafted free agent in July of 2025, and he joined the Clearwater Threshers around one week after the ink dried on his first professional contract. Hogart led all members of the Phillies 2025 draft class with three home runs in his first month as a pro last season and has turned into a regular outfielder for the Threshers at the beginning of 2026.

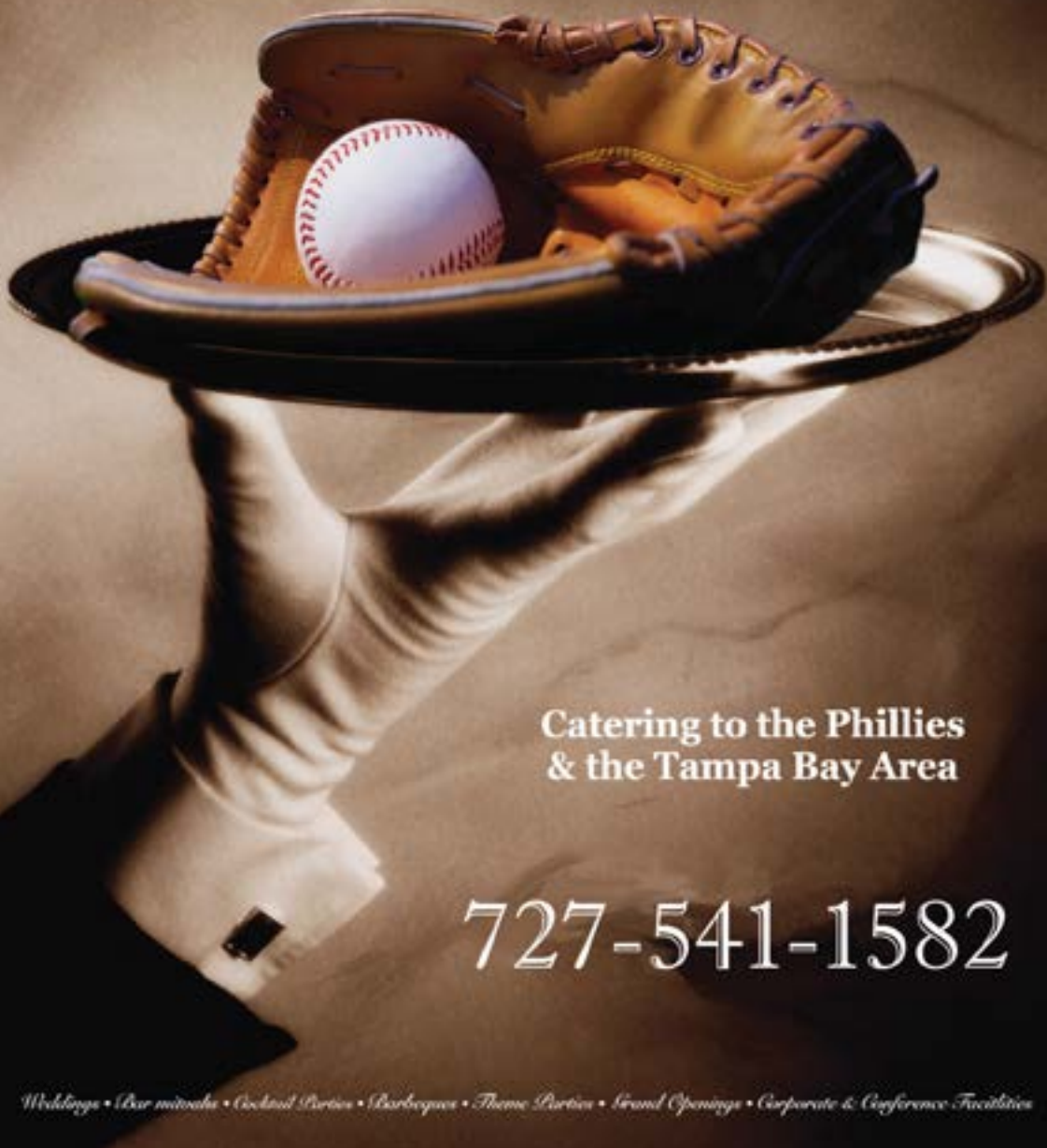
