## SOMERSET PATRIOTS NOTES

- The Somerset Patriots overpowered the Bowie Baysox by a score of 10-0 on Friday night in the fourth of a six-game series at TD Bank Ballpark.
- With 10 K, Patriots pitchers have struck out 10+ in seven of their last eight games and 58 total times this season.
- The shutout marked the Patriots second of the week and seventh of the season.
- Somerset's pitching staff has thrown to a 2.45 ERA over the first four games of the series, striking out 40 in 33 IP.
- The Patriots have now won seven of their last eight contests.
- LHP Nestor Cortes (4 IP, 0 R, 2 H, 5 K ) took the no decision, throwing 49 pitches in his second rehab start for the Patriots, returning from a Left Rotator Cuff Strain.
- LHP Ryan Anderson ( 2 IP, 0 R, 0 H, 2 K) earned his first Double-A win, hurling hitless $5^{\text {th }}$ and $6^{\text {th }}$ frames.
- Anderson is yet to allow a run in seven appearances, spanning 10.1 IP for Somerset since his promotion on 6/23.
- Anderson extended his scoreless streak to 18.2 IP over 11 appearances between Somerset and Hudson Valley dating back to $5 / 3$, allowing only 4 H with 22 K over that span.
- 3B Tyler Hardman (4-for-4, 2 HR, 6 RBI) pushed across six of Somerset's 10 runs, with an RBI single in the $3^{\text {rd }}$, sac fly in the $4^{\text {th }}$, and two homers in the $6^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ innings.
- Hardman's 26 homers this season lead Minor League Baseball.
- Against Bowie this season, Hardman has homered seven times in nine games.
- Friday marked Hardman's fifth multi-homer game of the season and sixth of his career.
- The performance marked Hardman's first four-hit game of the season and $14^{\text {th }}$ multi-hit game.
- Hardman's six RBI are a career high. He's the second Patriot with 6+ RBI in a game this season.
- RF Jeisson Rosario (3-for-3, 3 R, BB)
- The three-hit game marked Rosario's third of the season and $16^{\text {th }}$ multi-hit game.
- Over his last 20 games dating back to $6 / 24$, Rosario is slashing $.306 / .412 / .472$ with 14 R .
- SS Trey Sweeney (1-for-5, RBI, R, SB)
- The Yankees No. 5 prospect extended his hit streak to 11 games, over which he's hitting 327 with a .890 OPS, 9 R, and 11 RBI.
- Sweeney has now reached base in 18 of 21 games in the month of July.
