SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

FREDDY'S FANTASTIC RUN: Entering today, INF Freddy Zamora has tallied a hit in each of his last four games, going 7-12 (.583) with two doubles and a home run over that span... Over 16 games in June, Zamora is hitting .321, the secondhighest average out of all qualified players on the Shuckers roster... He also has a .429 on-base percentage and an .882 OPS in the month.

DON'T PASS GO, DON'T COLLECT \$200: C Jeferson Quero enters today with a 38% caught stealing rate, the best out of all qualified catchers in the Southern League, and the third-best mark in Minor League Baseball... In June, Quero has thrown out 12 of 27 baserunners, a 44% clip... As a team, the Shuckers have allowed 56 stolen bases, the third-lowest total in Double-A, and the lowest in the Southern League.

JOINING THE CLUB: With seven strikeouts on Wednesday, RHP Carlos Rodriguez became the second Southern League pitcher to reach 90 strikeouts this year, joining Chattanooga Lookouts RHP Connor Phillips... Rodriguez enters today with the most strikeouts in the Brewers' system, the lowest opponent's average (.189), the second-lowest ERA (3.09) and the fifth-most innings pitched (67.0).

RUNNING PAST 40: INF Tyler Black became the second player in Shuckers' franchise history (since 2015) to tally 40 stolen bases in a season, doing so on Sunday... Black enters today 13 away from breaking OF Johnny Davis' record of 52, set during the 2017 season in 133 games... He ente today with the most out of any player in Double-A, and the fifth-most in Minor League Baseball... Black's 16 stolen bases in June are the fourth-most out of any player in M

THE FUTURE IS NOW: On Monday night, C Jeferson Quero and INF Jackson Chourio were both selected to the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, set to be held in Seattle, Washington on Saturday, July 8... The pair are the ninth and 10th Shuckers players selected for the event... The pair also continues a streak that's seen a Shuckers player selected in every year of the franchise's history (since 2018).

IN A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: With a two-run home run and a stolen base on Friday night, OF Jackson Chourio became the third teenager since 2005 to reach 20 stolen bases and 10 home runs in a single-season in the high minors and the first since OF Ronald Acuna Jr. did so in 2017... OF Delmon Young with the Montgomery Biscuits is the only other player to achieve the feat since 2005, doing so during the '05 season.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP JUSTIN JARVIS (6-4, 3.30): After striking out nine over six innings last time out, RHP Justin Jarvis is set to make his 14th start of the year... Today marks his third start against the M-Braves in 2023... In two starts, he has struck out 13, walked one and allowed three runs over 12.0 innings.
