## NEWS & NOTES

### LAST TIME OUT: SKY CARP 2, CHIEFS 1

Blake Aita delivered 5.2 innings of one-run ball to open the game for the Chiefs, but Peoria's offense never got going and Beloit walked it off in the bottom of the 10th last night at ABC Supply Stadium...A pair of first-inning doubles produced a 1-0 Peoria lead, thanks to Jack Gurevitch and Jalin Flores...Aita struck out six through four innings, facing just one over the minimum...Beloit starter Aiden May settled in, eventually striking out five through five innings of one run ball to keep the score 1-0...With runners on the corners and two outs in the bottom of the fifth, Dillon Head tied the game with an RBI single...The Chiefs managed just one hit in five innings from Beloit's bullpen...Juan Reynoso struck out the side in the top of the 10th and Peoria stranded its placed runner on third base...After 3.1 shutout innings from Chiefs relievers, Abraham Ramirez ended it with a pinch-hit single on the first pitch of the bottom of the 10th, scoring the placed runner from 2nd...

### OFFENSE ON ICE

The Chiefs have been held under five runs in 11 of their last 13 games. Since June 9, Peoria is batting .230 and just .165 with runners in scoring position. More notably, the Chiefs are hitting only .206 since last week's series against Dayton began and are just 6-50 (.120) with RISP, with no home runs, 22 strikeouts, and four walks in those scenarios. Peoria went 1-11 with runners in scoring position last night.

### JUNE GLOOM

The Chiefs opened the month of June 8-2, including a six-game sweep of the Sky Carp June 2-7. Since then, Peoria has lost seven of eight games to fall to 9-9 this month. Across the last eight games, the Chiefs have been outscored 54-21.

### TURNAROUND ON THE MOUND

After surrendering 36 runs in the first four games of the series with Dayton, Chiefs pitching has allowed just two runs in the last two games. Starting pitching has led the way, as **Jacob Odle** (6 IP, 0 R) and **Blake Aita** (5.2 IP, 1 R) have combined for 11.2 innings of one run ball in those two contests. Peoria's bullpen has allowed no earned runs on three hits in 6.1 innings in the last two games.

### DIGGING THE LONGBALL

- Peoria's 106 home runs lead the Midwest League and rank second in High-A (Greensboro, 126). The Chiefs are tied for 6th in MiLB in home runs with the Cardinals' AAA affiliate, Memphis.

- **Jalin Flores'** three-run home run on June 14 at South Bend was the Chiefs' 100th home run of the season, marking the first time the team has reached 100 since they hit 111 in 120 games in the shortened 2021 season. Since 2005, the Chiefs have had just five 100 home run seasons.

- The Chiefs are on pace to break the franchise record for home runs of 122, set in 2002 (when **Yadier Molina** hit 7).

### EXTRA, EXTRA!

Peoria's 249 extra base hits lead High-A and are 11th in Minor League Baseball. At their current pace, the Chiefs are on track to surpass the High-A era Midwest League record of 419 extra base hits, set by the Great Lakes Loons in 2021. Of Peoria's 249 XBH this season, 106 have been home runs, meaning 43 percent of the club's extra base hits have left the ballpark.

### TRENDING CHIEFS

- In 16 games in June, **Jalin Flores** is batting .313 (20-64) with 4 HRs, 13 RBIs and a .989 OPS.

- Since June 3, **Cade McGee** has connected for 6 home runs. However, McGee has just 9 total hits this month (9-54, .167)

- In his last 5 games, **Josh Kross** is 1-15. Across the prior five games, Kross was 9-22.

- Across his last 10 games, **Sammy Hernandez** is 15-30 (.500), with 7 of those hits going for extra bases. The backstop has posted a 1.576 OPS with 11 walks and just 5 strikeouts in those 10 games.

### FIRST HALF IN REVIEW

- With two losses to finish the half on Thursday, the Chiefs finished .500 or worse in the first half for the seventh straight season at 32-34. Peoria had lost 39 games in the first half in each of the last two seasons.

- Peoria finished the half with an .841 OPS and 102 home runs - both the highest marks on record (2005) for the Chiefs through the first 66 games of the season. The Chiefs' .268 average was 5th best.

- The Chiefs' 6.02 ERA is the highest on record for the club through 66 games. However, their 638 strikeouts are the second-most.

### SCOUTING REPORT

Works with five pitch mix: FB (94-96), Slider (gyro - threw more than FB in '25), Cutter, Sweeper, Changeup (85-87), Curveball (New)

**Baseball America - Cardinals No. 8 prospect:** "Fajardo has a repeatable, athletic delivery without a lot of deception, but he throws strikes and avoids barrels by using different shapes to get to different areas of the strike zone.... Fajardo's control allows him to spread the zone. For now, he lacks an above-average offering, but he's young enough to believe he could develop one."

**MLB Pipeline - Cardinals No. 11 prospect:** "For now because the fastballs don't really pop, Fajardo has leaned heavily on his mid-80s slider. He's able to wear out the low, glove-side area with that breaking ball, and it could be a future plus pitch. Fajardo also delivers plenty of whiffs with his 85-87 mph changeup with fading action, and he appropriately ran equal splits in '25 because of it.... There is an argument to be made for him as the headline of the return in the Contreras trade considering his ceiling as a potential No. 4 starter."

### SEASON NOTES

**LAST TIME OUT:** Recorded consecutive losses for the second time this season in an 8-2 loss last Tuesday against Dayton...Allowed a solo home run in the second inning...Gave up just one other hit in five innings...

**MONTHLY SWING:** Posted a 1.69 ERA in April and allowed one earned run or fewer in all four starts, including a scoreless outing...May featured a 4.64 ERA as he surrendered 11 earned runs and five home runs across five starts...

**APRIL AWARD:** Named Cardinals MiLB Pitcher of the Month for April after posting a 1.69 ERA in 16 innings... Ranked 3rd in organizational ERA...

**AU REVOIR, GOPHER BALL:** Allowed first home run in since 8/5/24 vs DSL Tigers 2 (21 appearances) on 4/12 vs South Bend (Matt Halbach)... Was one of four MiLB pitchers to throw at least 70 innings without allowing a HR in 2025...

### ABOUT YHOIKER

**WHAT THEY'RE SAYING:** Cardinals President of Baseball Operations Chaim Bloom: "We saw an opportunity to improve the movement profile on the fastball. You want to make sure that he's throwing it and he knows how to use it. What that ultimately ends up being at the highest level, should he get there, is still TBD...You want to make sure you're developing all the weapons."

**TRAVELIN' MAN:** Has been traded in each of the last two Decembers... Originally signed by the White Sox as an international free agent in February 2024... Was promptly traded to Red Sox for LHP Cam Booser in December 2024... Sent to Cardinals from Red Sox in Willson Contreras on December 22, along with fellow Chief Blake Aita...

**WHAT'S IN THE NAME:** Is only player with the first name "Yhoiker" on record in affiliated professional baseball....

## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO ESPINOZA

### MANAGER

Roberto Espinoza, 37, returns to Peoria for his second season guiding the Chiefs and his 13th season coaching with the Cardinals organization. He is the lone returner from the team's 2025 coaching staff. Espinoza's career in baseball began as a catcher, as the Cardinals signed the Palo Aragua, Venezuela as an international free agent in 2006. Espinoza played five Minor League seasons, including parts of three seasons with the Quad Cities River Bandits. Espinoza began his coaching career in 2013 as the hitting coach for the Appalachian League's Johnson City Cardinals. The former backstop is no stranger to the big leagues, having served as a bullpen catcher for St. Louis in 2014 and as a coach during the stretch run of the 2020 season. Espinoza managed Johnson City from 2017 through 2019, winning the Appy League Championship in his final season. He spent the next four seasons (2021-24) managing the FCL Cardinals. He collected his 200th managerial victory on May 18, 2025 with Peoria's 7-1 win over Cedar Rapids.

### MIKE HABAS

### HITTING COACH

Mike Habas (HAH-biss), an experienced MiLB hitting coach, will spend his first season in the Cardinals organization with the Peoria Chiefs. Habas joins the Cardinals after spending the last two seasons with the Fredericksburg Nationals, helping guide the FredNats to the 2024 Carolina League title. The Chicago native began coaching in the professional ranks with the Gary SouthShore RailCats (2017-18) before spending four seasons with the Brewers (2019-2023). Habas played college baseball at South Suburban College, Moraine Valley College and North Greenville University.

### MICHAEL OH

### PITCHING COACH

Michael Oh, 28, joins the Chiefs for his second season in the Cardinals organization. The Northbrook, Illinois native began his time coaching in the pro ranks with the Palm Beach Cardinals last season, guiding a number of future Chiefs hurlers. Stauss, 26, was signed by the Cardinals as an undrafted free agent in 2021 after four seasons at Southeast Missouri State. The catcher played 26 games with the Chiefs across two seasons, including a two-home run game on June 28, 2022 at Quad Cities. Stauss played at all four full-season levels of the Cardinals system and appeared in 138 games before transitioning to coaching prior to the end of 2025.

Kily Gilbert is the Chiefs certified athletic trainer after she joined the Cardinals system in November after a previous stint with the Houston Astros. Gilbert originates from southern Oregon and attended Oregon State for her undergraduate and master's studies. She was a former intern for the San Francisco 49ers.
