**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 6-1. Harrisburg took a 1-0 lead in the top of the third with a sacrifice fly by Andrew Pinckney. In the fourth, **Victor Bericoto** tied the game with an RBI double. The Senators scored five runs in the sixth to pull away, 6-1. Trey Harris gave them the lead with an RI double, Cortland Lawson added an RBI single, Cody Wilson hit a two-run double and Daylen Lile capped the frame with an RBI double. **Will Bednar** started for Richmond and threw two hitless innings. **Kyle Cody, Jose Cruz** and **Seth Corry** combined for 3.1 scoreless innings out of the Richmond bullpen. The Flying Squirrels went 1-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, in the opener of a three-game series. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond in the Flying Squirrels' first home series of the season from April 9-14. From April 30-May 5, Richmond dropped five-of-six in Akron, part of a 1-11 road trip. The RubberDucks return to Richmond for a six-game series at The Diamond from September 3-8.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** lost the final three games of last week's series against the Senators at The Diamond after winning their previous four games. They went 3-3 last week against the Baysox. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .225 and averaging 3.71 runs per game (167 runs/45 games) at home compared to a .237 batting average and 4.93 runs per game on the road (202 runs/42 games). The Flying Squirrels are 10-4 in their last 14 road games since June 12.

**THE RUBBERDUCKS** are in first place in the Southwest Division second-half standings. They opened the second half winning 13-of-15 games before dropping the final two games of last week's series at Reading. They also lead the Eastern League with 50 wins this season. Akron's pitching staff leads the Eastern League in ERA (3.22), shutouts (11), innings pitched (763.0), runs (317), earned runs (273) and is tied for first in WHIP (1.20). Akron's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including 1B/OF C.J. Kayfus (No. 10), LHP Parker Messick (No. 17), OF Petey Halpin (No. 19), SS Gabriel Rodriguez (No. 20) and 3B Dayan Frias (No. 24). Halpin is also rated as the best defensive outfielder in the organization. MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list includes four Akron players, including Halpin (No. 15), Messick (No. 21), Kayfus (No. 27) and Frias (No. 28).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his 17th start of the season and his third against Akron. Last time out, Bertrand threw six scoreless innings and allowed three hits in a win over Harrisburg last Thursday. It was his league-leading eighth scoreless start of the season, all at least five innings. He faced the RubberDucks on April 10 at The Diamond and threw five scoreless innings, striking out five. On May 3 at Canal Park, he worked another five-inning, scoreless outing, striking out six. In his career against the RubberDucks, Bertrand is 2-1 with a 4.57 ERA in five starts. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. **For more on Bertrand, see page two.**

**FOR AKRON:** Right-hander Austin Peterson makes his fourth Double-A start and his first against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Wednesday at Reading and allowed two runs over 5.2 innings at Reading. In his previous start on July 3 against the SeaWolves, his home debut for Akron, he threw seven scoreless innings and allowed one baseunner, a third-inning single by Eliezer Alfonso. Peterson began the season with High-A Lake County, going 7-2 with a 2.44 ERA in 14 starts before being promoted to Double-A on June 24. Among full-season Cleveland minor league pitchers this year, Peterson leads the organization in wins (10), innings pitched (103.2) and WHIP (0.76) and ranks second in BAA (.188), tied for second in strikeouts (107) and third in ERA (2.34). In his pro debut season last year with Low-A Lynchburg, Peterson went 6-8 with a 4.54 ERA in 24 starts. Peterson was selected in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of Connecticut, where he was a teammate of former Flying Squirrels pitcher **Reggie Crawford**.

**BLANK SPACE:** On Wednesday, the Flying Squirrels pitched their 10th shutout of the season, beating the Senators, 5-0. The 10 shutouts are tied for the second-most in the Eastern League, even with Harrisburg and trailing only 11 by Akron. Erie has nine. It is also the most shutouts in a season for the Flying Squirrels since they had 12 in 2016.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 30 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .344 (42-for-122) with three homers, eight doubles, seven walks and 16 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 20 games. In his last 40 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .325 (50-for-154) with six homers, nine doubles, 13 walks and 25 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 11-of-22 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .356 (31-for-87) in that stretch. He went hitless in the two games on Saturday's doubleheader, ending his 10-game hitting streak, which was the second-longest by a Richmond player this year, trailing his own 11-game streak earlier this season.

**TO THE MUNGUIA:** Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .317 (19-for-60) and has added four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 12 of his 14 games played, including a three-hit game and five two-hit games. Last Monday at Bowie, he hit his first Richmond homer of the year, a two-run shot. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

**SCORELESS WORK FROM SILVA:** Reliever **Eric Silva** has thrown seven consecutive appearances dating back to June 19 without allowing a run, spanning 9.2 innings. He has 13 strikeouts in that time frame. That span has lowered his season ERA from 6.41 to 4.71. Since throwing an immaculate inning on June 9 against the Curve, Silva has gone 3-0 with a 1.35 ERA (2 ER/13.1 IP) with 18 strikeouts and four walks. Earlier this season, Silva threw six consecutive scoreless outings from May 1-21, spanning 9.2 innings with 10 strikeouts. Over his next six outings prior to his current scoreless streak, he posted a 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) from May 26-June 14. On Thursday night against the Senators, he closed his second save of the year, striking out the side in order in the ninth.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked eighth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,725), outpacing the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 10), RHP **Trevor McDonald** (No. 18), RHP **Eric Silva** (No. 20), C **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 23) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Brown (No. 15), OF **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

**BOULEVARD TO THE BAY:** This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023) and **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.
