TODAY'S GAME: Having won five-straight games, the Space Cowboys have an opportunity to sweep the Salt Lake Bees as they finish a six-game series on Sunday... Sugar Land is 9-2 during its season-long two-week homestand that closes out on Sunday, and the Space Cowboys have won eight-straight home games against Salt Lake dating back to August 15, 2025.

ABOUT SATURDAY NIGHT: Sugar Land jumped out to a 1-0 lead in the second on an RBI groundout from Braden Shewmake, but Salt Lake took the lead in the third on a grand slam from Niko Kavadas... Despite allowing the grand slam, RHP Jackson Nezu struck out nine over 4.1 innings and the Space Cowboys stormed back to score four runs of their own in the bottom of the fourth, which included a two-RBI triple from Cavan Biggio, an RBI double from Joey Loperfido and a go-ahead RBI single from Shay Whitcomb... CJ Alexander doubled in two more runs in the seventh to open a 7-4 advantage, but Salt Lake struck for three in the top of the ninth to tie the game, including a two-out homer from Gustavo Campero... In the bottom of the ninth, Loperfido led off with a hustle double and Raynel Delgado doubled to the left-field gap, scoring Loperfido to give Sugar Land an 8-7 walk-off win.

ROSTER MOVES: 7/31 - INF Braden Shewmake signed to a minor league contract, assigned to Sugar Land... INF Edwin Díaz released by Houston... 7/30 - RHP Jason Alexander reinstated from the IL... INF CJ Alexander reinstated from the IL... RHP JP France released by Houston... INF Tommy Sacco Jr. released by Houston.

HOW THE TEAM WAS BUILT: The Space Cowboys roster is comprised of 7 players drafted by Houston, 10 players signed as free agents, 2 international free agents, 2 non-drafted free agents, 4 players acquired in trades, 1 player claimed off waivers, 1 player selected in the Major League Phase of the Rule 5 draft and 2 player selected in the Minor League Phase of the Rule 5 draft.

PROSPECTING: Per MLB Pipeline, the Space Cowboys roster features four RHP Ethan Pecko (#6), RHP Miguel Ullola (#11), RHP Jackson Nezu (#13) and RHP Alimber Santa (#14)

SHAY ALL DAY: Shay Whitcomb extended his on-base streak to 14 games on Saturday night, going 3-for-5 with an RBI and a run scored... He also has an active five-game hitting streak and has recorded an RBI in five-straight games... Against Salt Lake this week, Whitcomb is 9-for-21 (.429/.455) with a triple, two home runs, 10 RBI, five runs scored and two stolen bases, as in tied for second in the PCL in RBI this week... Whitcomb started his week by belting the fourth grand slam of his Space Cowboys career on Tuesday to set a new franchise record... Since the All-Star break, Whitcomb has hit safely in 13 of 14 games while reaching base in all 14, batting .400 (22-for-55) with three doubles, a triple, two home runs, 15 RBI, nine runs and three stolen bases.

In the fourth inning on Friday night, Whitcomb collected a single to right field, giving him 381 hits in his career with Sugar Land, the most in a career in Space Cowboys' history (previous - Pedro León, 380)... He is also the franchise leader in total bases (699), home runs (82) and RBI (271).

WALK-OFF HISTORY: Raynel Delgado's ninth-inning walk-off double on Saturday night was 11th walk-off victory of the season for Sugar Land and their second consecutive night with a walk-off victory... Their 11 walk offs are tied for the most walk-off wins in Minor League Baseball in 2026 (1st; Wilmington, 11)... The 11 walk-off victories are the most in a single season in Space Cowboys history, surpassing the 10 Sugar Land collected in 2024... It was also the fourth walk off of the Space Cowboys current 12-game homestand and the third time this season the Space Cowboys have recorded at least back-to-back walk-off wins.

MONTH FOR THE RECORD BOOKS: With their win on Friday night the Space Cowboys finished July 18-6, tied with Bowling Green for the most wins in the month of July in Minor League Baseball... Sugar Land also tied a franchise record for most wins in a single month in franchise history with 18, after Sugar Land went 18-8 in May, 2025 and June, 2024 and 18-7 in April, 2024... Six losses in July are also tied for the fewest losses in a month in franchise history after Sugar Land went 16-6 in May, 2021.

PITCHING CARRIES THE DAY: Sugar Land's pitching staff has helped carry the team to their 24-8 record in the second half (since 6/23)... In that span, the staff has a 3.23 ERA, the lowest ERA in Minor League Baseball (next, Harrisburg - 3.30)... They also have the lowest home ERA in Minor League Baseball in the second half (2.90, next, Harrisburg - 2.93), despite the fact that Sugar Land is tied with Hillsboro for the most home games played in the second half with 23 entering play on Sunday... Sugar Land has also given up just 98 walks in 279.0 innings in the second half, the third fewest walks in MiLB in that span.

STRIKING 'EM OUT: Space Cowboys hurlers have struck out at least 13 batters in six-consecutive games, totaling 84 strikeouts in that stretch, the most in MiLB since 7/26... It is the first time in franchise history the Space Cowboys have struck out at least 13 batters in six-straight contest (previous, 3G, 3X, last, 8/23 - 25/24) and tied for the longest streak of consecutive games with at least 13 strikeouts in MiLB this season (Inland Empire, 6G, 4/7 - 12).

SECOND HALF SUCCESS: In the second half of the season, no Minor League Baseball team has won more home games than the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, who are 19-4 at Constellation Field... Sugar Land's 24-8 record in the second half is good for a .750 winning percentage, the best in Minor League Baseball, ahead of the Hickory Crawdads of the Carolina League (.735).

RUNNING WILD: The Space Cowboys have collected 43 stolen bases in the second half in 48 total attempts, tied for the second-most in the Pacific Coast League (Sacramento - 51).

BONUS BASEBALL: The Space Cowboys played their 14th extra-inning game of the season on Friday night and their fourth of the second half, improving to 8-6 overall and 3-1 in the second half... Sugar Land's 14 extra-inning games are the third-most in Triple A this season (Memphis - 19; Norfolk - 15).

EXTRA, EXTRA!: A night after they were held to seven singles, Sugar Land connected for 14 extra-base hits on 6/17 @ ABQ (6 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR)... Their 14 extra-base hits tied the most in a single game in franchise history, which came on 5/7/23 @ ABQ (6 2B, 8 HR) in a contest Sugar Land won 24-8... Each of the Space Cowboys first nine hits on Wednesday went for extra bases.

Sugar Land's six home runs were its most in a game since 5/14/24 at Albuquerque... The Space Cowboys also recorded two triples in a game for the first time this season and their first multi-triple game since 7/22/25 at El Paso. Additionally, Sugar Land's 24 hits on Wednesday set a season high and marked the club's first 20-hit game since May 17, 2024, at Albuquerque, in which they collected 21 hits.

ONE-HIT WONDER: On 4/3, the Space Cowboys took a no-hitter into the ninth inning and came three outs shy of the first no-hitter in franchise history... However, it was the fifth one-hitter for Sugar Land in a nine-inning game and their first since April 13, 2025 vs. Albuquerque when they won 7-0. The other one-hitters were:

All Space Cowboys games can also be seen on the Bally Sports Live App for free, MiLB.TV, MLB.TV and the MiLB App. Garrett Greene returns for his fourth season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his sixth season calling games for Sugar Land.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his seventh season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his sixth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey earned his 500th professional win on June 4, 2025 over the Sacramento River Cats. He was named the Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 2024 after guiding Sugar Land to their first Pacific Coast League title. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with five seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Sean Buchanan, hitting coach Drew Saylor and development coach Wladimir Sutil. 2026 is Saylor's first in the Astros organization after he worked in the Royals organization from 2020 - 2025, mostly as a minor league hitting coordinator. He previously managed in the Pirates organization (West Virginia - 2019), Dodgers' organization (Rancho Cucamonga, 2016 - 2018) and Rockies (Tri-City, 2015). Buchanan enters his second year at the helm in Sugar Land after one season as the pitching coach with Double-A Corpus (2024) and one year with High-A Asheville (2023), along with a year in the Florida Complex League (2022). Buchanan previously coached in the collegiate ranks, working for eight seasons with stops that included Lehigh University, Albright College and DeSales University. Sutil enters his fifth season on the Space Cowboys' staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds the Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

LAST OUTING: Started on 7/26 (Sunday) vs. Nashville... Allowed his only two runs of the night in the third inning on a lead-off double, an RBI triple and a two-out single... Finished his night by retiring the final nine hitters in a row... Struck out 7 over 5.2 innings, his season-high in strikeouts with the Space Cowboys and the most he's recorded in a game since he struck out six on 4/24 vs. ABQ... Received the loss in an 8-1 Space Cowboys defeat.

VS SALT LAKE: Is scheduled to make his second appearance and first start against the Bees... Pitched in relief of Luis Garcia on Major League rehab on 8/13 at Constellation Field, going 3.2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 5 K... Both runners that scored against his ledger were inherited runners that came in to score... Received a hold in a 4-3 Space Cowboys defeat.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Named the PCL Pitcher of the Month in June in which he went 3-1 with a 2.48 ERA in 29.0 innings, allowing eight runs with six walks and 20 strikeouts... Tied for the PCL lead in innings pitched for the month and led all qualified pitchers in ERA, WHIP (0.93) and BAA (.206).

SCORELESS STREAK: Had an 11.0 inning scoreless streak from 6/4 - 6/18.

CAREER BEST: Turned in the longest outing of his career on 6/11 vs. Sacramento, throwing 7.0 shutout innings while allowing only 2 hits and 3 walks with 4 strikeouts... Only runner reached scoring position in the 3rd on a walk and a single but responded by retiring the next 8 in a row... Struck out two in a 1-2-3 7th to finish off his night... Had not pitched more than 6.0 innings in an appearance in his professional career... Received the win in a 2-0 Sugar Land victory.

BACK FROM THE IL: Reinstated from the IL on 4/24 and made his first start of the year for the Space Cowboys that night... Went 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 6 K on 51 pitches, 32 strikes.

OUT ON REHAB: Made three appearances on rehab with the Fayetteville Woodpeckers... In 8.0 IP, allowed 6 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 15 K... Last appeared on 4/17 (Fri) @ AUG, going 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 8 K on 52 pitches, 33 strikes.

PROSPECT RANKINGS: Rated as the #6 prospect and #2 pitching prospect in the Astros organization by MLB Pipeline.

2025: Split year between Double-A Corpus and Triple-A Sugar Land... With Corpus, in 11G, 10 GS went 2-6 with a 4.40 ERA and a .239 opposing batting average and a 1.21 WHIP.... With Sugar Land, went (1-4, 3.09 ERA), 8 G, 7 GS, 35.0 IP, 34 H, 15 R, 12 ER, 12 BB, 48 K, .248 BAA... Began the season on 7-Day IL...Made one rehab appearance with the FCL-Astros on 5/20 before making Double-A season debut on 6/1 @ MID... Named Astros Upper-Level Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July with Double-A Corpus after going 2-2 with a 1.75 ERA in six appearances and five starts...Recorded a 0.97 WHIP and a .209 opposing batting average in July... Promoted to Triple-A Sugar Land for first time in career on 8/4 and finished the year with the Space Cowboys.

2024: Named Houston Astros' Minor League Pitcher of the Year... Across three levels, went (4-6, 3.47 ERA), 26 G, 15 GS, 96.0 IP, 79 H, 43 R, 37 ER, 37 BB, 125 K, .219 BAA... Named Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for May with a 0.86 ERA across five appearances and 21.0 innings while striking out 25 batters.

COLLEGE & HIGH SCHOOL: Was the Saturday starter for Towson in 2023...Went 2-2 with a 3.21 ERA and 48 strikeouts across 42.0 innings... Transferred to Towson in 2022 after redshirting freshman year at La Salle University due undergoing Tommy John Surgery... Was forced to transfer after La Salle discontinued their baseball program.
