History vs. South Bend

The Lugnuts are 210-188 all-time vs. the Cubs, 100-89 at home and 110-99 in South Bend.

The two clubs met up for a six-game series in Lansing last season, with the Cubs winning four of six games.

The Lugnuts dominated South Bend for years, winning at least 10 games against their foes in 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000 and 2001, and going 18-6 vs. the South Bend Silver Hawks in 2008 (7-1 in home games).

Today: It's a Coors Light Thirsty Thursday, featuring \$3 drink specials and \$5 Seltzers, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, go for a third straight win when they play the third game in a six-game series against the South Bend Cubs – the 399th all-time meeting between Lansing and South Bend.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 4, Cubs 1. In front of a Grand Slam School Day crowd of 7,532, South Bend southpaw **Evan Aschenbeck** blanked the Luggies for six innings, but the Nuts rallied for four runs in the seventh off Aschenbeck and reliever **Kenyi Perez** to hand the Cubs a second straight loss in the series. 19-year-old Lansing starter **Steven Echavarria** tossed a career long 5 1/3 innings in a no-decision.

LUG•NOTES

League Overview: With 35 games played and 31 games remaining in the first half of the season, the Lugnuts trail West Michigan for first place in the Midwest League's East Division by three games. The winners of the East and West Division in each of the 66-game halves clinch postseason berths.

What a Crowd: Yesterday's attendance of 7,532 was not only the Lugnuts' largest crowd of the year, it was the second largest in the Midwest League thus far this season, trailing only the Dayton Dragons' 8,240 on May 10.

Stay in Contact: It took until the 40th out of the series for a South Bend pitcher to strike out a Lugnuts batter; the Cubs finished with only four strikeouts yesterday and fanning nobody in the 10-inning series opener. The Lugnuts have only 229 strikeouts through 35 games this season, an average of 6.5 per game that leads all of professional baseball. In comparison, the Major League leader, the San Diego Padres, strike out 6.8 times per game.

Prospecting: The Lugnuts currently have five of MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Athletics prospects: No. 10 (**Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**), No. 12 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 17 (**Ryan Lasko**), No. 18 (**Rodney Green, Jr.**) and No. 28 (**Nate Nankil**). The A's No. 7 prospect, **Tommy White**, is on the Nuts' 7-day Injured List.

Tiger-Tastic: Former Lugnut **Gage Jump**, promoted to Double-A Midland on Monday, enjoyed a dazzling debut for the RockHounds last night. The 2024 draft's 73rd overall pick from LSU struck out six batters in six scoreless innings, allowing five hits and one walk in 98-degree heat, part of the RockHounds' 6-0 victory over visiting San Antonio (Padres).

Home Cooking: The Lugnuts have the best home offense in all of High-A. Through 19 home games, the Nuts top the classification in batting average (.286), on-base percentage (.387), doubles (43), total bases (289) and base hits (194).

T.J. on a Tear: T.J. Schofield-Sam leads the Midwest League with a .349 batting average and is 3rd with 38 base hits. The Brampton, Ontario, native has exactly two hits in his last six consecutive games, going 12-for-26 in that span (.462 avg.) to raise his batting average 36 points from .313. He has also hit safely in eight consecutive games.

Closing in on History: The Kansas City Royals signed former Lugnut **Rich Hill** to a Minor League contract on Tuesday; if Hill reaches the Majors, he'll play for his record-tying 14th different MLB team. The 45-year-old southpaw pitched for the Lugnuts 22 years ago, going 0-1 with a 2.76 ERA in 15 appearances, 4 starts, striking out 50 batters in 29 1/3 innings. He allowed only 14 hits and zero home runs, limiting the league to a .141 average, but walked 36 batters while tossed nine wild pitches.

Thursday Night's Alright: Speaking of T.J., he's slashing .636/.667/1.182, going 7-for-11 with two doubles and two triples on Thursdays this season. Joshua Kuroda-Grauer has three doubles in three Thursday games, while Nate Nankil has reached base eight times in 16 plate appearances with three walks, a double and a home run. The Nuts are outscoring the opposition 22-11 on Thursdays this season en route to a 4-1 record. Combining Wednesdays and Thursday, Lansing is 10-1 this season.

MAY 15TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2018: The Lugnuts beat the Dragons in a walk-off for the second straight day, capturing their seventh straight win, 10-9, on Yeltsin Gudiño's RBI single off Ryan Nutof in the bottom of the tenth. It was also the Lugnuts' third straight walk-off victory over the Dragons dating back to April 27th's series finale. The Lugnuts had blown a 9-3 lead, allowing six runs in the eighth inning.

2019: 19-year-old catcher Gabriel Moreno was a smash in his Lugnuts debut, homering in his first at-bat, delivering a two-run single in the fourth inning, tripling in the eighth and finishing 3-for-5, and Rafael Lantigua drew a bases-loaded, four-pitch walk in the bottom of the ninth in a 7-6 win over West Michigan.

No-No History: Facing the Cedar Rapids Kernels on June 13, 2024, relieved Jake Garland to open the 6th inning and tossed 2 2/3 hitless innings, walking one and striking out three, as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 combined no-hitter of the Kernels... it was the 4th no-hitter in franchise history as well as the first home no-hitter since 2003.

At Pella High School: 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the 2017 Big Ten season ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)...
