THIS COULD BE IT: After another walk-off victory yesterday afternoon, the FredNats could now clinch the second half championship in the Carolina League North with two victories over the Mudcats in tonight's doubleheader, plus a Fayetteville loss. FBG's magic number is 2 against Carolina, and 3 against Fayetteville. The first game of the doubleheader tonight will be a regular game, but in the second game, the Mudcats will be the home team because it is a make-up game from the July 13 rainout at Five County Stadium. Luke Johnson makes another start in game one aiming to build on his recent success, and 2025 8th round pick Riley Maddox will make his first professional start in game two.

**ABOUT LAST GAME**: The FredNats did not score until the 8th inning in yesterday's Education Day game, but once again found a way to come back and pick up the team's MiLB-leading 12th walk-off win of the season. Randal Diaz had the first four-hit game of his professional career and also hit his first pro home run to open the scoring in the 8th inning. He then tied the game with a two-run single in the 9th, and Jacob Walsh got the winning RBI in the 10th on a sac fly plus an error. Liam Sullivan pitched five innings of one-run ball in his start.

**GOOD JOB BAZ:** Fredericksburg's MiLB-leading caught stealing total is up to 93, eight ahead of Fayetteville, who is in second place. Heading into play today, Kevin Bazzell leads MiLB with 59 caught stealings and owns the best CS% of all MiLB catchers who have played at least 400 innings this year, throwing out 38% of would-be base stealers. In addition to the phenomenal defense Bazzell has played all season, he's now enjoying his best stretch of the year with the bat too, finishing up a month of August in which he hit .333. In his last 10 games, Bazzell is hitting .352.

**WOWED BY WILLITS:** 17-year-old Eli Willits - the number one overall pick in the 2025 MLB Draft - made his professional debut last home stand and has hits in 10 of the first 12 professional games he's played. Overall, Wllits is 14-for-42 (.333) with five walks, five RBI and two stolen bases. Willits, Washington's No. 1 prospect and the 18th best in all of baseball, won't turn 18 until December. He became the youngest FredNat ever, the youngest player in the Carolina League this season, and is currently the second youngest active player in full-season Minor League Baseball. Andrew Salas of the Jupiter Hammerheads is four months younger than Willits. Willits comes from a baseball family, his father Reggie played six seasons in the Major Leagues and is currently the Associate Head Coach at the University of Oklahoma, where his older brother Jaxon is the starting shortshop.

**INSTANT IMPACT**: The other members of Washington's draft class that are also with Fredericksburg have had exceptional starts to their professional careers. Second-rounder Ethan Petry (South Carolina) has played 20 games with Fredericksburg, and is hitting .274 with a .761 OPS. He's drawn 13 walks in 20 games as well. Nick Hollifield (UAB) has been a clutch force with the bat for the FredNats. On the last home stand alone, Hollifield had five game-tying RBIs in the 6th inning or later, plus a walk-off single on Sunday against Salem. Two pitchers, Riley Maddox (Rd. 8, Ole Miss) and Tucker Biven (Rd. 13, Louisville) combined to shut down the late innings on Friday night in Lynchburg, as Biven picked up his first career professional save.

**START EARLY, HOLD ON LATE:** The FredNats are 62-62 overall this season, but are 165games over .500 (35-20) when scoring first in 2025. In the first two innings this season, Fredericksburg has been outscored 95-124 (-29). The FredNats have also been exceptional at holding on to late-game leads this year. The team is 44-2 when leading after seven innings, and 37-2 when leading after eight.

**THE STAFF:** After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to win the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

**LUKE WARM:** Lucas Emanuel Johnson...promoted to Fredericksburg for the second time this season on 7/23. The Nationals selected Johnson in the 10th round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC).

LAST TIME OUT: Johnson got his first career win in his last outing on the road against Lynchburg. The righty threw six strong innings, getting through five scoreless before surrendering one single run in the sixth. He struck out five, meaning he's struck out at least five in consecutive starts. Now, in his last two starts combined, Johnson has covered 13 quality innings. Nobody has thrown more innings in the Carolina League over their last two starts than Johnson.

**PALM BALL:** In two long stints, Johnson excelled in the Florida Complex League to begin his professional career this year. The righty made 14 appearances and two starts, posting a 1.23 ERA across 36.2 IP. He allowed only five earned runs, tallying 36 strikeouts to just 14 walks. He won the FCL's Pitcher of the Week award at the end of May.

**GOLDEN RETRIEVER:** Johnson pitched four seasons for the UMBC Retrievers, completing his career as UMBC's all-time program leader in strikeouts. He won the America East Pitcher of the Year award twice, becoming the only player in the award's 34-year history to win it outright twice. He posted a career 4.61 ERA in 288.2 IP with 279 K's. As a Junior in 2023, he had an ERA of 2.96 in just under 80 innings. His selection marked the first time a Retriever was selected in the MLB Draft since 2016.

# **BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER**

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



## JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



## MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



## LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
