Last Night: Lugnuts 8, Kernels 0. In the fourth no-hitter in franchise history, Jake Garland (5 innings), Grant Judkins (2 2/3 innings) and Colton Johnson (1 1/3 innings) silenced a Kernels team that had piled up 33 base hits in the first two games of the series, finishing things off with a Johnson strikeout of Cedar Rapids standout Rubel Cespedes. Danny Bautista, Jr. drilled a two-run homer and a two-run double and Cameron Masterman knocked a two-run homer to supply the offense.

Jordan Rules: Tonight, presented by Jackson National, the first 1,000 fans are receiving bobbleheads of Jordan Diaz, who was 20 years old when he homered in his first at-bat for the Lugnuts on Opening Day in 2021, the Nuts' first game affiliated with the Oakland Athletics. Diaz batted .288/.337/.483 with 24 doubles and 13 homers for the Lugnuts in 2021, moving up the A's ladder to make his MLB debut on September 18, 2022. He is currently in Triple-A Las Vegas, where he supplied a game-winning RBI single in the bottom of the ninth last night to drive in 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda and beat Salt Lake, 3-2.

Prospecting: Lansing has five MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 10), first baseman Will Simpson (No. 25), southpaw Will Johnston (No. 28) and outfielder Brayan Buelvas (No. 30).

Welcome to the Show: Southpaw Brady Basso, who pitched for the Nuts in 2021, underwent Tommy John, and returned successfully last season, became the third former Lansing player this season to reach the Majors on May 31 (joining Max Schuemann and Brett Harris). Brady is the 187th Major League Lugnut in franchise history.

Double Time: The Lugnuts received a pair of two-run doubles last night, supplied by Danny Bautista, Jr. and Luke Mann, and have now overtaken Cedar Rapids for the most doubles in the Midwest League, 108-107.

History: Last night's no-hitter was the first no-no in Lansing since April 21, 2003, a 15-0 rout of the Dayton Dragons in which Donnie Hood hit for the cycle.

A'round the A's:

At the MLB level... 2022 Nuts slugger Tyler Soderstrom mashed his third homer in the last four games for the Oakland Athletics, but the A's lost to the Twins, 6-2.

* In Triple-A... 2022-2023 Nut Grant Holman tossed 2 1/3 perfect innings, striking out three, giving him 24 1/3 scoreless innings between Double-A and Triple-A this year. No other pitcher in Minor League Baseball with over 16 innings pitched has yet to allow a run. Holman has allowed only 14 hits and 10 walks while striking out 29 batters.

History vs. Cedar Rapids

The Nuts are 75-89 all-time vs. the Kernels, 45-39 in Lansing and 30-50 in Iowa. The Lugnuts have not won a series against Cedar Rapids since 2012.

The Kernels are the defending Midwest League champions, defeating the Great Lakes Loons in the championship series last season.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2014: 30-year-old knuckleballer Frank Viola III tossed 6 2/3 scoreless innings, scattering eight hits and two walks and striking out one in a 3-0 win at Great Lakes.

2019: In the bottom of the eighth inning, the Lugnuts rallied for two runs on a DJ Neal RBI double and a Gabriel Moreno sacrifice fly to beat Bowling Green, 3-2. The Lugnuts' win, as it turned out, denied the third-place Hot Rods from making the playoffs in the first half. Bowling Green then clinched a second-half playoff berth, denying the Lugnuts from making the post-season. The winning pitcher was 19-year-old lefty Naswell Paulino, who pitched a scoreless eighth in his only appearance of the year with the Lugnuts.

In a Nutshell: After not pitching in 2023, dominated in Stockton to open the season, earning promotion to Lansing May 29 and making his Lugnuts debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on June 2, becoming the 942nd all-time Lugnut and the 13th different starting pitcher this season... name is pronounced "Chen Jong-Ow Jwahng"... works with interpreter Yen Po "Rambo" Wang... nicknamed "Z."

First Start: Struggled in the first inning vs. Peoria, allowing three runs on two walks and three hits, including a two-out, two-run triple by Michael Curialle... set down the final ten batters faced, with five strikeouts, in a 5-3 Lugnuts seven-inning victory.

Second Appearance: Tossed three scoreless innings in relief at Dayton, June 8... allowed a one-out double to Sal Stewart in the 6th... gave up one-out single to Logan Tanner in the 7th... allowed one-out infield single to Hector Rodriguez in the 8th... struck out Cam Collier twice amid four strikeouts total.

Hometown Heroes: Giants pitcher Kai-Wei Teng is the only 2024 Major Leaguer from Taiwan, though Teng is currently with the Sacramento River Cats... there have been 17 Major Leaguers all-time from Taiwan, the first being Chin-Feng Chen of the Dodgers, who played from 2002-2005... the Yankees' Chien-Ming Wang (2005-09, 2011-13, 2016) has the most career wins (68), the Orioles/Marlins' Wei-Yin Chen (2012-19) has the most career innings pitched (1,064 2/3), and Cleveland's Yu Chang (2019-23)has the most offensive records, from games played (235) to runs (72) to hits (121) to homers (20).

Record-Setters: In Lugnuts franchise history, the first Taiwanese players were Po-Hsuan Keng, who pitched primarily out of the bullpen for the Nuts from 2005-2007, and Chi-Hung Chen, who a starting pitcher in 2005-06 and 2008... last year, Brock Whittlesey broke Keng's franchise record of most career appearances... Whittlesey pitched in 103 games from 2021-23, while Keng appeared in 94... Cheng owns the Lugnuts' franchise record for most career innings pitched (374), with Keng ranking second (202); Cheng also ranks first in games started (67), career wins (23), losses (20), starts (67), strikeouts (367), runs (188), hits (360), and walks (189).

Path to Lansing: Pitched at National Taiwan Sport University, signing with the Athletics in November 2021 for approx. \$500,000... debuted in 2022 with Stockton, making eight starts from April 12 - June 1, 2022... did not pitch again until April 10, 2024, a hiatus of 679 days between professional appearances... excelled with Stockton this season, never allowing more than one run in an appearance... of nine total appearances with the Ports, did not walk a batter in seven of them.

In a Nutshell: Pitched in 2023 with the Nuts, returning to the Midwest League this season... spent the offseason training in Alabama with Tyler Baum... pened the season as part of a tandem with Opening Day starter James González... González was promoted on May 8, so Myers made the next four starts without a piggybacker... joined a tandem with Chen Zhang-Ao Zhuang beginning June 2... notable splits:

- Home: 3.10 ERA, 29 IP, 1.14 WHIP, .236 avg. | Road: 4.66, 19 1/3, 1.34 WHIP, .269 avg.
- Starter: 4.06 ERA, 37 2/3 IP, 1.27 WHIP, .260 avg | Relief: 2.53, 10 2/3, 1.03 WHIP, .211.
- vs. left: .268/.321/.299, 1 HR, 8 BB, 18 K | vs. right: .231/.286/.330, 2 HR, 4 BB, 26 K

Respect: Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Monkey Ball...* he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016 and spent 2022 with the Cincinnati Reds.
