SPRINGDALE, AR - Drew Parrish delivered 7.0 scoreless innings for the second straight start, tying a career-high with nine strikeouts as the Naturals shut out the Wind Surge, 7-0 Friday night at Arvest Ballpark.

- The league's reigning Pitcher of the Week, Parrish allowed just three hits without walking a batter. Between the 2nd and 6th innings, he retired 13 straight, retiring the side 1-2-3 five starts. After allowing a leadoff single in the seventh, Parish struck out the next three he faced, finishing the night at a seasonhigh 91 nitches
- Parrish battled toe-to-toe with Wichita starter Simeon Woods Richardson, as the score was locked up at 0-0 through the middle of the fifth, at the halfway point. Woods Richardson had retired eight in a row headed to the bottom of the fifth, but the Naturals quickly loaded the bases, on singles from Nate Eaton and Gavin Stupienski, then a walk from Jake Means. Tucker Bradley blasted a grand slam to right field to break the tie and put the Naturals up 4-0, his third home run of 2022 and his second grand slam of the year, the team's third.
- The Naturals hitters gave Parrish three more runs of support in the seventh, on an RBI groundout from Maikel Garcia and a two-run home run to left field off the bat of Nick Loftin, his fourth of the season.
- Garcia went 0-for-4 in the game, ending his 14-game hitting streak, just the third time this season he hasn't reached base. Loftin and Eaton each produced multi-hit efforts in the win.
- Yefri Del Rosario took over for Parrish on the mound, pitching a scoreless 1-2-3 eighth inning, then stranding the bases loaded ninth, with three strikeouts across two scoreless innings.

#### FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 11 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave, Patrick Smith and Ángel Zerpa.

#### **TOOLSY TEAM**

Five Naturals players were listed in *Baseball America*'s 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the <u>"Best Defensive Catcher"</u> in the system.
- SS **Maikel Garcia** is rated as having the <u>"Best Infield Arm"</u> in the system.
- RF **Seuly Matias** is rated as having the <u>"Best Outfield Arm"</u> in the system.
- LHP Asa Lacy is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the "Best Control" in the system.

#### WHAT YOU KNOW ABOUT PITCHING DEEP?

Last week against Springfield, Naturals starting pitchers combined to throw 27.2 innings (out of 52.0 played, or 53%), the most the rotation has collectively offered in a series this season, including three performances of 5.0 innings or more.

- As a staff, the Naturals 4.55 ERA in the month of May ranks 3rd in the Texas League, with five of 11 starts lasting 5.0 innings or longer.
- Across 11 May games, Naturals starting pitchers have a 3.53 ERA (20 ER in 51.0 IP) with 60 strikeouts (10.59 K/9) and a .199 opponents' average.
- Reigning Texas League Pitcher of the Week Drew Parrish has thrown 5.0 innings or more in each of his last SIX outings, including a tio of scoreless starts, 6.0 innings on 4/26 vs. AMA, then 7.0 innings on 5/7 @ SPR and 5/13 vs. WCH.

#### NATURALS IN THE SHOW

In last Tuesday's 7-1 win for the Kansas City Royals, 2021 Natural MJ Melendez hit seventh and served as the Royals' DH, becoming the 113th player to debut in the Majors after spending time in Northwest Arkansas, the fourth in the 2022 MLB Season.

 Bobby Witt Jr. was Naturals alum 110 to reach the Majors, debuting on April 7 ... Collin Snider was the 111th on April 9 ... Yunior Marté became the 112th Naturals alum to reach the Majors, debuting with the San Fransisco Giants on April 12.

#### **EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring five runs or less, the Naturals are just 2-14, while 14-1 when scoring six runs or more.
- The Naturals are 5-13 when recording nine hits or less, but 11-2 when recording 10 hits or more.
- The Naturals are 16-3 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but
   0-12 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 13-5, whereas 3-10 when the opponent scores first.

#### Yo, You Wanna See Some Real Speed?

Through 31 games, the Naturals have stolen <u>46 bases in 56 attempts</u> (average 1.48 steals/qame) and <u>pulled off a double steal 8 times</u>.

- 46 steals ranks third in the Texas League, tied for sixth in Double-A and tied for 22nd in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's 12 steals (in 14 attempts) ranks fourth in the Texas League and tied for eighth in all of Double-A.

#### GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Entering last night, shortstop **Maikel Garcia** had a 14-game hitting streak, but also has drawn 22 walks on the season, which is tied for fifth in the Texas League, while his 37 hits are tied for 10th in Double-A.

- The 14-game hitting streak is the longest on the Naturals this year and tied for the 15th-longest in club history ... it is also tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in the 14 games between April 27 and May 12, he's hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.
- In 143 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 59 times, for a .415 on-base percentage (37 hits + 22 walks) ... he has reached at least once in 27 of the 30 games he's appeared in this season ... two of the games he didn't reach base were back-to-back games, on April 23 & 26, as well as May 13 ... he's also reached base at least twice in 19 of 27 games where he has reached base.
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking fourth in steals (12), tied fifth in walks (22), tied sixth in hits (37) and fourth in steals (12) and tied seventh in runs scored (26).
- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.

#### NATE IS GREAT

Utility man **Nate Eaton** has been a consistent presence in the Naturals lineup all season along, playing all over the diamond for Northwest Arkansas as well.

- Between April 23 and May 1, Eaton collected an eight-game hitting streak, going 15-for-31 (.484 average) with two homers, six runs batted in, four steals and a 1.285 OPS ... this streak ranks second on the team in 2022, behind Maikel Garcia's active 13 game streak.
- With 17 starts (149.0 innings) at third base, 5 starts (45.0 innings) in right field, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in left field and one start at shortstop (9.0 innings), the VMI product is the only Naturals player who has spent time at more than three positions in the field. He's also tied with Tucker Bradley for the team lead with 3 outfield assists.

#### It's GONNA BE MASSEY

Since the calendar flipped to May, second baseman **Michael Massey** has been one of the top hitters in the Texas League, batting at a .412 (14-for-34) average with a 1.094 OPS across eight games, while driving in 12 runs.

- After two slow weeks to start the season, Massey has turned things around, raising his batting average nearly 100 points, from .213 after April 21 to the .311 it sits at now.
- His hot streak began April 22, homering in three consecutive games, April 22 to 24 in Frisco and went from having no homers through the first 11 games of the season, to having six in his last 18, leading the team in homers.
- Massey has reached base in 24 of 229 games he's played this year, with already 10 multi-hit games, including four in May.
- Massey ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied third in runs batted in (28), tied sixth in hits (37) and 10th in total bases (63).

- Chris Widger will manage the Naturals after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by Baseball America following the 2021 season.
- 2022 marks Widger's seventh year in the Royals' organization, as he was slated to manage Advanced-A Wilmington in 2020 and led Burlington to the Appalachian League Championship Series in his first season as Manager in 2019. Prior to that, he was Wilmington's Bench Coach from 2016-18.
- Before joining the Royals organization, he managed the Independent League Camden Riversharks in 2015 and was their Pitching Coach from 2012-14.
- A third-round pick by Seattle in the 1992 Draft, Widger played in parts of 10 seasons in the Majors with the Mariners (1995-96, 2000), Expos (1997-2000), Yankees (2002), Cardinals (2003), White Sox (2005-06) and Orioles (2006), winning a World Series with Chicago in 2005.
- Widger and his wife, Whitney, reside in Pennsville, N.J., with their children: C.J., Ashlynn and Skylar.



### **BAS DERRICK LEWIS • PITCHING COACH**

- Derrick Lewis is in his third season with the Royals' organization and second as pitching coach at Northwest Arkansas.
- He spent the previous 16 seasons in the Atlanta Braves' organization, the first 14 as a Minor League pitching coach and the last two as the Pitching Coordinator.

### #6 ABRAHAM NÚÑEZ • HITTING COACH

- Abraham Núñez enters his fourth season as Northwest Arkansas' hitting coach after serving in the same capacity with High-A Wilmington (2015-2018), Class-A Lexington (2014), Rookie Advanced Burlington (2013) and the Dominican Royals (2012).

### #27 CHRISTIAN COLON - Assistant HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- · Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



### #23 MIKE JIRSCHLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.

- Began his professional career in Quad Cities (A+), pitching in 36 games out of the bullpen for the River Bandits...
  went 7-1 with four saves and a 3.58 ERA (25 ER in 70.1 IP and 121 strikeouts... named an MiLB.com Organization
  All-Star and recognized as the Royals' Pitching Prospect of the Year by MLB Pipeline.
- Among all Minor League pitchers who threw at least 70.0 innings, Klein's 15.48 K/9 ranked first, as did his 40.9% strikeout percentage ... a .171 opponents' batting average ranked ninth ... his 121 strikeouts were the most among any minor league arm with less than 15 starts ... of 225 minor league pitchers who struck out 100 or more hitters, he was one of just two that did not make a start, one of nine who made less than 10 starts.
- Despite pitching exclusively in relief, his 121 strikeouts ranked third among all Royals minor league arms, while seven wins was tied for third and 36 games pitched ranked 10th in the system ... among Royals minor leaguers who pitched at least 70.0 innings, ranked first with in K/9, K%, K-BB% (26.0%, 121 K/44 BB) and opponents' batting average.
- Ranked third in the High-A Central in strikeouts, behind teammate Anthony Veneziano and ranked tied for fifth in wins.
- Often pitched in high-leverage situations for the River Bandits, with 199 of the 296 batters he faced (67.2%) coming in the seventh, eighth or ninth innings.
- 25 of his 36 outings with Quad Cities were 2.0 innings or more, including five 3.0-inning appearances ... only threw
   1.0 inning or less six times.




