The Baysox dropped their second-straight game by a 7-3 final to Binghamton on Saturday night. **Jud Fabian** tallied three hits on the evening, while **TT Bowens** and **Silas Ardoin** each had RBI knocks late. Starter **Kyle Brnovich** went just one-third of an inning, as the Rumble Ponies tallied five runs in the top of the first inning. The Binghamton bats blasted three home runs on Saturday evening in the Bowie defeat.

BASALLO BITS

During his team-high 16-game on-base streak, C/1B **Samuel Basallo** is hitting .367 with a 1.108 OPS - both the fourth-best totals in the Eastern League during that span. Basallo's five home runs during that stretch are second-most in the league. The 19-year-old is the youngest player in the Eastern League this season. He currently has the fourth-most hits (58) and home runs (10) of all qualified players.

TEENAGE DREAM

With his two-run shot Friday night, **Samuel Basallo** became just the ninth teenager to reach 10 home runs in a season at the Double-A level since the year 2005. Basallo is the first teen in the Eastern League to reach the mark since Vladimir Guerrero Jr did so with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats in 2018. Basallo's 55 games to reach 10 Double-A home runs makes him the third-fastest teenager to do so since 2005. Only Guerrero (44 GP in 2018) and Giancarlo Stanton (41 GP in 2009) reached 10 HR in fewer games.

8-5 ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 40 of 46 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.366) and leads the team in walks (29), the sixth-most in the Eastern League.

TERRY TWO BAGS

Baysox RF/1B **TT Bowens** hit his team-leading 15th double of the season on Saturday night - tying him for the third-most in the Eastern League this season. Bowens has been a clutch bat for Bowie, leading the team with 34 RBI and hitting .316 with runners in scoring position - second-best on the team to **Collin Burns** (.324)

9-23 28-27 **BUILT BY THE BULLPEN**

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (269.1) and strikeouts (315). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.19 WHIP, which is good for fourth-lowest in Double-A.

SETH IS SHOVIN'

RHP **Seth Johnson** has been on a roll for the Baysox in his last handful of starts. The O's No. 10 prospect tossed five, one-hit, shutout innings against Binghamton on Tuesday and has allowed just two earned runs accross his last four starts (17 IP), good for a 1.06 ERA during that span. Johnson's eight strikeouts on Tuesday were his most at the Double-A level and the most at any level since he struck out a career-high 11 on May 20, 2022 - his last start before his Tommy John Surgery. Johnson has struck out 19 to just five walks during his last four starts.

SADDLING UP THE PONIES

Entering this week, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies are third in the Northeast Division at 26-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Mets most recently split their six game series against Harrisburg at home. The last time Bowie and Binghamton met was from May 14 - May 19 and Bowie won four of six at Mirabito Stadium. Seven of the Mets' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF/1B Ryan Clifford (No. 4), C Kevin Parada (No. 9), RHP Brandon Sproat (No. 13), OF Alex Ramirez (No. 16), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 18), RHP Nolan McLean (No. 19), RHP Joander Suarez (No. 28).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Nolan McLean starts the series finale on the mound for Binghamton. The Mets' No. 19 prospect, per MLB Pipeline, allowed four runs in five innings to Bowie, includng a home run by **John Rhodes,** in a losing decision on Tuesday, despite striking out a Double-A career-high eight. This is the fourth Double-A start for McLean, a twoway player from Oklahoma State who was a third-round choice of the Mets in 2023 after not signing with the O's, after they drafted him in the third-round the year prior.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



ROBERTO **MERCADO**

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career. Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.
