TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a nine-game road trip out of the All-Star break with a three-game set at Somerset.

LAST TIME OUT: Thomas Harrington struck out 10 batters in 6.0 innings of one-run ball, but Somerset earned a 2-1 win.

THOMAS' ENGLISH MUFFINS: Righty Thomas Harrington is the third Curve pitcher this season to strike out at least 10 batters, doing so in back-to-back starts. Since June 16 (6 starts) Harrington has gone 2-1 with a 1.50 ERA (6 ER / 36.0 IP) and allowed a 0.83 WHIP with 41 strikeouts. Harrington has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 10-of-12 outings with Altoona this year and his 52 strikeouts since June 1 are T-3rd-most by an Eastern League pitcher.

The Curve are one of five teams in the affiliated minors and the only Double-A team to have three different pitchers (Harrington, Bubba Chandler and Braxton Ashcraft) strike out at least 11 batters in a game. The Curve are one of nine teams in the affiliated minors, one of two at Double-A (Binghamton) to have at least six 10-K games this season. The six 10-strikeout games this season are the most in a single-season in franchise history (35 total in first 24 years of the franchise).

WHO LET US GET HOT?: Since June 6, the Curve are 22-11 in their last 32 games which includes two series in which they won five-of-six.

SOME NEW FACES: Coming out of the All-Star break, the Curve added two more key pieces from High-A Greensboro in INF/C Nick Cimillo and LHP Hunter Barco. Cimillo batted .293/.419/.619/1.038 OPS with 8 2B, 17 HR and 48 RBI in 52 games with the Grasshoppers this year. His 17 HR led the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion and ranked T-2nd with teammate Shaun Ross in all of High-A. Barco went 4-1 with a 3.34 ERA in 16G/14 starts at High-A this season. In 62.0 IP, he allowed just 46 hits, 22 walks and struck out 77.

THE CHEN CHRONICLES: Righty Po-Yu Chen overcame a difficult month of April (7.93 ERA) and hit his stride as the calendar flipped to June. Chen fired a career-high 8.0 innings and struck out 9 on June 7 at Richmond to lead the Curve to a 3-1 win. Chen allowed one run or fewer 6 times in his last 10 outings, and since May 25 he has recorded a 2.23 ERA (15 ER / 60.2 IP) with 52 strikeouts.

DIXON'S BIG FLY: Infielder Brenden Dixon hit the 50th Grand Slam in Altoona's franchise history on Saturday, June 13 against Bowie to lead the Curve to a 4-1 win. It was the second for the Curve this season after Joe Perez hit one on May 31 against Portland.

A BIG ADDITION: Utilityman Yoyner Fajardo reached base safely in 23 straight games from June 13-July 13, during which he batted .360/.446/.419 with 5 2B, 6 RBI, 13 BB, 10-11 SB. Since June 1, his .321 batting average is 7th in the Eastern League. Fajardo's on-base streak was the 3rd-longest by an Eastern League player this season.

QUITE A START: From June 21-July 11 (18 games) Altoona starters have been the backbone of the team's success. 9 times in the 18 game stretch, a Curve starter threw a quality start (6.0 IP+ and 3 ER or fewer) with 7 outings lasting 7.0 innings or longer. Altoona's 3.26 ERA since June 21 was 5th-best among Double-A teams. Curve starters went 8-5 with a 2.64 ERA (30 ER / 102.1 IP) allowing 70 hits, 28 walks (0.96 WHIP) and 97 strikeouts from June 21-July 11.

BUBBA'S BURGERS: Bubba Chandler has hit his stride since returning from the injured list on May 29. Chandler has walked just 4 batters in 39.0 IP with 47 strikeouts, recording a 4-2 record with a 2.08 ERA (9 ER / 39.0 IP) with a 0.72 WHIP. Since June 1, his 44 strikeouts are the 4th-most by a Double-A pitcher and he ranks 2nd in WHIP with a 0.69 mark. Chandler is the 22nd player in franchise history to be selected to the MLB Futures Game which took place on July 13 at Globe Life Field, home of the Texas Rangers. Chandler tossed a scoreless seventh inning to finish off a win for the National League.

HE WILL McADOO: Infielder Charles McAdoo made his Double-A debut with a bang on Saturday, June 23 at Bowie. McAdoo made a terrific play in the first inning in the field and then went 2B, BB, 2R HR in his first three at-bats for the Curve. McAdoo homered in each of the first two games he played for Altoona. He's reached base in 15-of-20 games since joining the Curve, batting .263/.356/.500/.856 with 4 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 7 RBI, 11 BB, and 20 K. He ranks 1st among PIT MiLB in H (95), 2B (19), RBI (59), T-3rd in SB (16), and 2nd in OPS (.955), min. 150 AB's in minor leagues.

THE PATRIOTS ARE THE YANKEES?: Raul Dominguez is back for his second season leading Somerset. The Yankees Double-A affiliate features some of the top prospects in the MLB.com top 30 Yankees prospects including No. 2 OF Spencer Jones, No. 10 LHP Brock Selvidge, No. 21 RHP Zach Messinger, No. 22 RHP Trystan Vrieling, No. 25 INF Tyler Hardman, No. 27 RHP Danny Watson and No. 29 INF Benjamin Cowles.

THE FIRST TO PROTEST TAXATION WITHOUT REPRESENTATION: Zach Messinger takes the ball for the Patriots in the series finale. Messinger was NY's 13th round pick in 2021 out of Virginia. Messinger tossed 5.0 innings of 2-run ball against the Curve in the first of the doubleheader on May 12 at PNC Field. Messinger was a Media Studies major at UVA and his father Dennis played college hoops at Olney Central College and his mom, Lisa, played volleyball at the University of Evansville.

TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY

2015 - The Curve offense have a day for the record books in the first game of a doubleheader against Erie. In just 7 innings, the Curve racked up a team record 24 hits and tied a team record with 18 runs in an 18-7 victory. Jose Osuna set team record by scoring 5 runs. The two clubs engaged in an all-timer in game two as the Curve erased a 7-1 deficit in the bottom of the seventh to beat the SeaWolves 8-7.

2004 - The Curve close out a 7-day homestand from July 15-21 and welcomed 44,488 fans, the largest attendance figure over the course of a week in franchise history; Brad Eldred made AA debut with Curve (0-4) during loss to Erie
