### Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Logan Allen** to the mound tonight, as they look to win consecutive games for the first time since a 5G win streak from 3/28-4/2 (only consecutive wins all season). Buffalo will counter with RHP **Trey Yesavage**. Columbus is 10-4 (.714) versus right handers this year. Yesavage has never pitched against Columbus in his career, with tonight being his eighth game in Triple-A.

### vs. the Bisons

Since 5/23/09, the Clippers are 40-65 (.381) against the Bisons, despite being outscored by only 40 runs (472-512). Among those 105G, the Clippers are 19-22 (.463) in games decided by at least four runs and 21-43 (.328) in games decided by three or fewer. In Buffalo, the Clippers have been victorious in 10 of the last 14G, winning both series played since the expansion of the International League.

### Deficit Shmeficit

The Clippers overcame a 2-0 deficit on Sunday (most comeback wins in the IL, 10), after Wednesday's 4-run comeback (third of the year; no other IL team has more than one, nine teams don't have any). Columbus owns five wins when trailing by at least three (three teams have two wins, five teams have zero). In all, the Clippers have trailed in 20 of 21G this year (only team without multiple no-trail games).

### On the Screws

The lineup has produced 19HR in the last 9G (312AB; had 13HR in first 12G, 398AB) with 33 of 57 runs scored in the last 9G being the result of a long ball (58%; homers provided 19 of first 69 runs scored, 28%). However, the Clippers are tied for last in the IL with homers off LHP (1HR in 155AB, **George Valera**), as only 3% of the team total are off southpaws (largest HR split in the IL, next closest is 8%).

### Walters Rehab

**Andrew Walters** (right lat surgery) has remained with the Clippers on rehab, as **Hunter Gaddis** and **George Valera** ended their assignments last Monday. Walters has pitched four times so far, giving up a homer in two outings (2-run shot on 4/7 at Worcester and a solo bomb on 4/10 at Worcester). All-time in Columbus, two thirds of his 15ER allowed have come on 6HR (one every 32.3BF).

### Double Time

**Travis Bazzana** doubled again Saturday and now leads the IL in two-baggers (9). He has seven of them since last Sunday, to go along with his first homer since 9/7/25 (86AB between), raising his SLG by 148 points in the last week. Bazzana is still looking for his first multi-RBI game of the year (3x20 with RISP), but he is posting a 1.173OPS with nobody on base, including a pair of triples (leads IL).

### Gearing Up

**Kahlil Watson** snapped a 19AB hitless streak Saturday, going 3x4 with a triple and a couple bombs (second career 2HR game, 6/18/25 with Akron), and had a quartet of doubles to go along with a homer last week (+293 in SLG over last 7G, had 1XBH in first 12G). Watson walked twice on Sunday and is now tied for 2nd in the IL with 19BB (t-7th with 26K; one of two IL batters in top ten of both).

### Bounce Back

**Stuart Fairchild** was only 4x27 (.148) in 8G (4/4-4/14) after going 4x4 on 4/3 vs. Indianapolis, having gone hitless in each of 17AB until his 2-run homer on 4/15. He is now 8x17 in his last 4G, scoring in all of them (six runs total). **Milan Tolentino** was just 6x33 (.182) in 10G (4/3-4/14) after doubling twice on 4/2 vs. Indy, but he is 10x17 with 4HR and 10RBI in his last 5G (IL Batter of the Week last week).

### Eye is for Ingle

**Cooper Ingle** has drawn 18BB in his first 47PA (38%) this season, following a Triple-A debut that saw 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .245 (27x110) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .455OBP and a +15 differential in the walk to strikeout department (39 to 24). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, his 39BB are for 2nd most in the IL (**Travis Bazzana** is 3rd, 38).

### Delayed Start

**Kody Huff** was 1x8 with 5K in March, but has rebounded to hit in 13 of 14G during April (.309, 17x55), drawing 8BB to 10K. He has 17RBI this month (t-3rd in the IL), while also scoring 14 times (t-2nd in the IL with **Stuart Fairchild** and **Cooper Ingle**). His 10G hit streak to start April was a career best and, of IL hitters with at least 10 balls in play last week, Huff's average exit velocity was 3rd (97.2).

### This Date in Clipper History

4/21/2011

The Clippers clobbered Louisville by a score of 19-3 at Huntington Park, led by **Chad Huffman's** historic performance. The Huff-man went 4x5 and tied franchise records in runs scored (5) and homers (3), while establishing a new club mark in RBI (10). He played in a team-high 132 games for Columbus in 2011, including all eight postseason games for the Triple-A Champs (.355, 2HR, 5RBI).

### Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,417 to 1,368).

### Challenging Times

The Clippers are 28-27 (.509) in pitch reviews this season, with batters going 16-18 (.471) and pitchers/catchers going 12-9 (.571). They have run out of challenges in 11G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

### Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 0-1 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-34 when playing past regulation (.595, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 84G to require extra play, 67 have been resolved after one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

### Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

### Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

### Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

### Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

### Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

### Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 15th in the IL this year (.976), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 12G this season (7-5, .583), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

### Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

### Good Baseball

**Milan Tolentino** moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

### To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

### Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 397-416 (.488), 367-370 with Columbus (.498).
