INDY BITS

ABOUT SUNDAY: The Indianapolis Indians put up five unanswered runs in the final three innings, but the comeback attempt fell short in a 6-5 loss to the Columbus Clippers on Sunday at Victory Field. Following a two-hour, 16-minute rain delay five outs into the game, José Tena crushed a solo home run off a Finesas Del Bonta-Smith changeup to give Columbus the lead in the third inning. The Clippers tallied four additional runs between the fifth and sixth innings courtesy of a sacrifice fly, two singles and a solo blast from Zac Fascia. Trailing by six runs, Indianapolis rallied with a four-run seventh inning. Henry Davis ended the shutout bid with a solo home run, his second homer in as many games. The Indians offense followed with four doubles in their next six batters, with Malcom Nuñez and Gilberto Celestino combining for the next three runs. The final run of the game was scored in the ninth when Matt Gorski launched his 15th home run off Anthony Gose.

RAIN, RAIN, GO AWAY: The Indians last series vs. Columbus was riddled with inclement weather, with a postponement beginning the week and a Sunday matinee highlighted by a two-hour, 16-minute rain delay bookending the rain-shortened five-game set. Sunday's delay — beginning just five outs into the game — was the longest for the Indians since a two-hour, 24-minute delay preceded a three-hour, 21-minute game on July 29, 2019, vs. the Clippers at Victory Field.

HANK'S TANK: Henry Davis launched his second home run in his past two games on Sunday vs. Columbus, going yard to lead off the Indians four-run seventh inning after putting the Indians on the board in the second inning on Saturday night. It was his first time hitting home runs in consecutive games since hitting three total in back-to-back contests on April 23 and April 26, 2023. Sunday marked his ninth Triple-A homer of the season and his second in seven games since joining the Indians on a rehab assignment (he was later activated and optioned) on June 4. In his first stint with Indianapolis, he launched seven home runs in 23 games and logged a .642 slugging percentage and 1.078 OPS. In 30 total games with the Indians this season, he is hitting .290 (31-for-107) with 24 runs, nine doubles, nine home runs, 21 RBI, a .626 slugging percentage and 1.041 OPS.

MATT'S BACK TO MASHING: Matt Gorski launched his 15th home run of the season in the ninth inning on Sunday, bringing the Indians within one run of Columbus. It was his first home run in 17 games since June 18 vs. Iowa, which is his longest stretch since going 22 games without a homer from April 7-May 12. He then homered 10 times in his next 18 games through June 2. Gorski is getting hot at the right time as the Indians head West for three games at Omaha and six games at Iowa. Gorski homered four times — including a two-homer game on May 21 — in six games at Iowa's Principal Park earlier this season. He currently ranks among league leaders with 36 extra-base hits (T-8th), good for a .526 on-base percentage and .818 OPS in 72 games with Indianapolis.

HELLERBALL: After giving up a one-out hit and a hit batter, the Indians defense showed out in the eighth inning to keep Ben Heller's 14.1-inning scoreless streak intact on Sunday afternoon. Liover Peguero made a sliding over-the-shoulder catch in shallow center field to record the first out of the frame, and a nifty play turned by Peguero caught José Tena between third and home. Heller has not allowed a run across his last 14 outings (14.1ip) since May 21 at Iowa, recording a 0.63 WHIP and .087 batting average against (4-for-46). His 14-game shutout streak is tied for the longest in the International League this season.

TONIGHT: The Indians begin a nine-game road trip at Omaha and Iowa tonight with a three-game set at Werner Park in Papillion, Neb. The Indians traveled to Omaha from May 23-28, a six-game series shortened to just three games as the Midwest underwent challenging weather over the weekend. In 10 total games this season, the Storm Chasers lead the Indians 8-2. Beginning the series tonight for Indianapolis is RHP Aaron Shortridge (0-0, --), making his first Triple-A start since 2023 after beginning the season on the injured list (see below). Countering for the Storm Chasers is LHP Anthony Veneziano (3-2, 4.18), who has made five appearances (three starts) vs. the Indians since 2023. In those games, he is 2-0 with a 2.55 ERA (5er/17.2ip) and 13 strikeouts.

SHORTY'S BACK: Aaron Shortridge makes his first start after being activated from the injured list today at Omaha. The right-hander began the season on the injured list and began a minor league rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates on June 17. He made five appearances (four starts) between the FCL and High-A Bradenton, going 0-1 with a 1.76 ERA (3er/15.1ip), 25 strikeouts, 0.91 WHIP and .222 batting average against. Over his last two starts, he tossed 8.0 shutout innings with 14 punchouts. Shortridge made his Triple-A debut with the Indians on Sept. 20, 2023 vs. Rochester, earning the win with 5.0 one-hit, one-run innings four walks and three strikeouts. He spent the majority of the 2023 season with Double-A Altoona, going 11-8 with a 5.01 ERA (7er/138.1ip) and 118 strikeouts in 29 games (27 starts).

THE SKENES OF IT ALL: Former Indianapolis Indian and the No. 1 overall selection in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft, RHP Paul Skenes took to the mound last Tuesday at Globe Life Field, home of the Texas Rangers, as the National League's starting pitcher for the MLB All-Star Game. Skenes faced Cleveland Guardian Steven Kwan, Baltimore Oriole Gunnar Henderson and New York Yankees Juan Soto and Aaron Judge, walking Soto as the lone blemish in his only inning. He was the first Indian to be named an All-Star Game after appearing with the Indians in the same season since Freddy Sanchez in 2007 and the sixth former Indians pitcher to start the All-Star Game following his time with Indianapolis.

B-REY ON BASE: Joining Paul Skenes on the National League All-Star roster was former Indians outfielder Bryan Reynolds. He entered as a defensive replacement and went 1-for-2 with a single in his first at-bat. It was Reynolds' second All-Star selection, his first coming in 2021.

THIS DATE IN 1970: The Indians swept a doubleheader on the road at Iowa, 6-3 and 1-0. In the opener, Don Anderson launched his fourth home run and drove in three runs. In Game 2, Ross Grimsley stymied the Oaks in a 9.0-inning complete game, limiting Iowa to just one hit and three walks with 13 punchouts. Grimsley improved his record to 8-5 on the season.
