- The Captains scored early and often to down Beloit 12-3 on Saturday night, clinching a series win over the Sky Carp. - After a scoreless first inning, Lake County scored four runs on six singles in the second inning, chasing Karson Milbrandt from the game. Then, in the third, the Captains tallied five more runs on just two hits and four walks to make it
- Lake County made it 10-1 in the fifth, before the Sky Carp got on the board in the sixth, scoring on RBIs from Tanner Allen and Josh Zamora.
- Joe Mack ripped a seventh inning homer to make it 10-3, but the Captains scored in their final two at bats to push the lead to 12-3.

#### **SECOND HALF SWINGING**

Beloit's .270 batting average in the second half is tops in the Midwest League. Their .766 OPS ranks 3rd. Through 28 games, the team is averaging 5.5 runs per game and 9.8 hits per game. In the first half, the Sky Carp averaged 4 runs and 7.4 hits per game.

#### **SUNDAY FUNDAY**

In Beloit's two Sunday home games since the All-Star Break, the Sky Carp offense has exploded for 28 runs on 32 hits, defeating Cedar Rapids 13-6 on July 16 and Quad Cities 15-7 on July 23. Beloit's 15 runs last Sunday marked a season high. Overall, the Carp are 6-9 on Sundays this season.

#### **MAKING HAY WHILE THE SUN SHINES**

The Sky Carp have won each of their last three day games, including Wednesday's matinee, 8-5.

#### **OPPORTUNITY KNOCKS...**

In the Sky Carp's four losses this week, the team has gone a combined 4-29 (.137) with runners in scoring position, including a 2-8 mark last night.

#### **FLY AWAY. BALL!**

Thanks to Joe Mack's solo homer last night, the Sky Carp have now homers in six straight games and have belted seven home runs this week. Beloit has homered 29 times in the second half through 29 games. In the first half, the Sky Carp went yard 38 times in 65 games.

#### THE BIG (FIRST) THREE

The Sky Carp have allowed at least one run in the first three innings in 13 of their last 15 games. Of Beloit's 523 runs allowed this season, 40% (210) have come in the first three innings. When the Sky Carp keep the opponent scoreless through 3, they are 20-6.

#### **BASHING BRADSHAW**

With his two home run performance Friday night, Davis Bradshaw became the first Sky Carp to have a multi-homer game this season. With the two longballs, Bradshaw boosted his league-leading batting average to .328. Interestingly, Beloit's last multi-homer game also came at Classic Park, when Cody Morissette belted three on June 17, 2022.

#### IMPERFECT 10 (OR MORE)

With last night's 12-3 defeat, Beloit is now 0-16 when allowing 10 runs or more. The Sky Carp have tallied 10 runs or more in five games, winning all five.

#### **STAYING UP LATE**

In each of Beloit's last 13 wins, the team has scored at least one run in the seventh inning or later. Tanner Allen's 2-run double in the seventh inning Wednesday gave Beloit insurance in a 3-run win.

#### **HELLO. OHIO**

Beloit will spend their entire 12 game road trip in the state of Ohio, marking the team's only two-week road trip of the 2023 season. The Sky Carp's 460 mile trip to Eastlake from ABC Supply Stadium marks their longest road trip by
