YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a seven-game losing streak with a 6-5 win over the SeaWolves. In the bottom of the ninth, **Marco Luciano** won the game with walk-off sac fly to score **Vaun Brown**. The SeaWolves opened the scoring in the first with an RBI single by Ben Malgeri. The Flying Squirrels tied the game, 1-1, with an RBI single by **Brett Auerbach** in the second. In the fourth, Julio Rodriguez gave Erie a 3-1 lead with a two-run homer. Brown pulled Richmond within a run with an RBI double in the fifth. Later in the inning, **Andy Thomas** moved the Flying Squirrels ahead, 5-3, with a three-run homer. Colt Keith tied the game for the SeaWolves in the seventh with a two-run homer.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. Today is the 17th of 24 head-to-head games this year. The Flying Squirrels went 4-2 against the SeaWolves at The Diamond from April 18-23. Erie won five-of-six at UPMC Park from May 9-14. Along with this week's series, the Flying Squirrels will head back to Erie for six games to close the regular season from September 12-17. In the current series, the SeaWolves at the SeaWolves bare outcored the Elving Squirrels 21. have outscored the Flying Squirrels, 35-11.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a seven game-losing streak, their longest since 2018, with Friday's win. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 19-of-their-last-27. Their 8-19 record since May 3 is the worst in the Eastern League. Richmond starters have thrown 165.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 246.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.11 ERA, which is the lowest in Double-A and the second-lowest of all 120 teams in Minor League Baseball, trailing only Low-A Down East (3.09).

THE SEAWOLVES are in first place in the Southwest Division, one game ahead of Altoona, and have won seven-of-their-last-10 games. The SeaWolves' offense leads the Eastern League in runs scored (289), hits (422), total bases (698), RBIs (268) and OBP (.353) while ranking second in batting average (.251), triples (12), homers (58), SLG (.416) and OPS (.769). Erie's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), RHP Ty Madden (No. 4), INF Colt Keith (No. 5), C Dillon Dingler (No. 7), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 18), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 26) and INF Gage Workman (No. 27). Andrew Magno is rated by Baseball America as having the best curveball in Detroit's system, Dingler is rated as the best hitter for average and Workman is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Keith (No. 2), Flores (No. 4), Madden (No. 5), Perez (No. 8), Dingler (No. 14), Hurter (No. 21), Workman (No. 28) and Keider Montero (No. 30).

FURTED (No. 2), workman (No. 25) and kerder Montero (No. 30). **FOR RICHMOND**: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his 10th start of the season and his third against the SeaWolves. After posting a 2.93 ERA through his first seven starts, Teng has allowed 11 runs in his last two starts, both last week at Binghamton, for a 1.91 ERA (11 ER/7.2 IP). He has made six starts against the SeaWolves in his career, going 1-0 with a 3.85 ERA. This year, Teng ranks tied for eighth in the Eastern League in strikeouts (52). He is also second in the league (min. 35 IP) in K/9 (13.25). Since the start of the 2022 season, Teng leads all Double-A pitchers in starts (37), innings pitched (171.2) and strikeouts (221). He is tied for the seventh-most strikeouts in the minors since the start of the 2022 season. His 221 strikeouts with Richmond are the fourth-most in a career in franchise history. Last year, Teng led the Eastern League and set a Richmond franchise record with 169 strikeouts. For 2022 in his first Double-A season, Teng went 6-12 with a 5.22 ERA. He tied the Flying Squirrels' franchise record for the most starts in a season with 28. A native of Taiwan, Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins before being traded to the Giants at the deadline in 2019 along with RHP Prelander Berroa for RHP Sam Dyson. Prior to the 2023 season, Teng pitched for Chinese Taipei in the World Baseball Classic at Taichung Intercontinental Stadium in his hometown. *For more on Teng, see page two*.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Sawyer Gipson-Long makes his 10th appearance and ninth start of the season. He last pitched last Tues-day against Somerset and allowed one run with seven strikeouts over five innings in a win. After starting the season 2-3 with a 5.21 ERA in his first five outings, Gipson-Long has gone 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA his last four starts since May 5. In his two starts against the Flying Squirrels this year, he is 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA (3 ER/10.0 IP). Gipson-Long was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the sixth round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Mercer. He was traded to the Detroit Tigers on August 2, 2022 for RHP Michael Fulmer. Gipson-Long made seven starts for the SeaWolves at the end of the 2022 regular season, going 2-2 with a 4.54 ERA.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history. This year, they are again leading the level in average attendance (6,824) and total attendance (163,775). The Flying Squirrels are ranked eighth of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance.

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder Vaun Brown was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown has reached base in each of his nine games with Richmond. On Friday, he set a Double-A high with three hits and scored the walk-off winning run in the ninth.

GLOW SHOW: Infielder **Jimmy Glowenke** was assigned to Double-A Richmond on Tuesday and is slated to make his Double-A debut. He was selected in the second round (68th overall) by the Giants in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Dallas Baptist. Glowenke started the season with High-A Eugene. Among Northwest League hitters (min. 100 PA) this year, Glowenke ranked sixth in OPS (.956), sixth in batting average (.313), sixth in wRC+ (146), seventh in OBP (.413), tied for seventh in doubles (10) and eighth in SLG (.542). He also had the fourth-lowest strikeouts percentage (14.3) in the league. He picked up his first Double-A hit on Thursday night an PBI single. night, an RBI single, and added two hits on Friday night.

WHERE THERE'S A WILLIAMS THERE'S A WAY: Carter Williams has hit safely in each of his last five games since last Saturday at Binghamton. During that stretch, he is batting .350 (7-for-20) with two homers, a double, two RBIs and five runs scored. He homered in back-to-back on Sunday at Binghamton and Tuesday against Erie. Last year in his first full professional season, Williams hit .336 over 80 games between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, which ranked second among Giants minor league hitters (min. 300 PA).

ROCKET RANDY: Reliever **Randy Rodriguez** has gone 1-1 with one save and a 0.84 ERA (2 ER/21.1 IP) over his last 10 appearances since April 27, striking out 29 batters and with a .114 BAA. He struck out a season-high five batters over two innings on May 21 against the RubberDucks. On Thursday, he threw 2.2 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with no walks and three strikeouts. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 25 IP, zero starts), Rodriguez has the highest K/9 (11.97) and strikeout percentage (32.0) and ranks third in ERA (2.45).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Luis Matos is ranked seventh in batting average (.304). Ismael Munguia is eighth in batting average (.300). Tyler Fitzgerald is tied for second in triples (3). Evan Gates is tied for eighth in saves (4). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for eighth in strikeouts (52).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Colt Keith is second in batting average (.324), tied for fourth in homers (10), second in RBIs (41), third in SLG (.571), third in OPS (.967), second in hits (59), tied for sixth in doubles (11), tied for third in extra-base hits (23), second in total bases (104) and tied for sixth in runs scored (32). Jake Holton is ninth in OBP (.401) and tied for seventh in walks (33), Trei Cruz is 10th in OPS (.889) and tied for fourth in runs scored (34). Wenceel Perez is tied for sixth in runs scored (32). Angel De Jesus is tied for first in games pitched (18).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Vaun Brown (No. 6), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Wade Meckler (No. 23) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
