CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: On Saturday night at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake, the Captains scored 10 runs in the first 2 innings, clinching a series win with a 10-1 victory over the Fort Wayne TinCaps.

Lake County's 10 runs scored were its second-most in a game this year (12, 4/20 vs. Lansing), while the team's 9-run win was its largest margin of victory this season.

All 9 batters in the Captains' order reached base, with 6 hitting safely and driving in at least 1 run, and 4 recording multiple hits.

IT'S MILLER TIME: RHP **Jake Miller** (2-2) made his 5th appearance (4th start) of the season, earning his 2nd win of the year. The right-hander tied his career-high of 5 innings pitched, allowing 5 hits, 1 earned run, and no walks, while throwing a High-A best 6 strikeouts in 74 pitches (55 strikes). Saturday marked the first time in Miller's career in which he went 5+ innings and struck out 5+ batters since 5/5/2022 vs. Columbia (KC) while with Single-A Lynchburg, when he struck out a career-high 10 in 5 innings of work.

FASCIA SHOW: C **Zac Fascia** went 1-for-3 with 4 RBI courtesy of a bases-loaded walk and a 3-run double. Fascia's 4 RBI were his most in a single game during his Minor League career, and most since 3/8/2020 at Western Kentucky while playing collegiately at Purdue. Fascia has now hit safely in 4 of his last 6 games played.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

THAT'S OUR GUY: In Saturday's win, OF **Guy Lipscomb** went 4-for-4 and reached base in all 5 of his plate appearances. Lipscomb's 4 hits marked a new Minor League-high, and were the most in his baseball career since 4/3/2022 vs. Purdue during his junior collegiate season at Belmont. He is batting a team-best .571 with a Midwest League-best .647 OBP in 4 games so far this series.

TOP QUALITY: Through 25 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded a Midwest League-best 7 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs). Cedar Rapids has the next-most quality starts by a Midwest League team so far this season with 4. The other 11 Midwest League teams besides Lake County have a combined 14 quality starts so far this year.

BASH BROS 2.0: Captains INF **Alex Mooney**, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, and INF/OF **C.J. Kayfus** have been the Midwest League's premier slugging tandem. The duo has accounted for 31.8% of Lake County's run production, while hitting 8 of its 20 home runs.

ANOTHER BULLPEN BLANKING: RHP **Zach Jacobs** and RHP **Magnus Ellerts** combined to pitch 4 shutout innings in relief. Lake County's bullpen has pitched 14 straight scoreless innings, dating back to the 8th inning of their 7-6 win vs. Fort Wayne on Wednesday.

COPA DE LA DIVERSIÓN: According to MiLB.com, "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" is a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities."

Today, on Cinco de Mayo, the Captains will play as their Copa de la Diversión alter ego: **Los Picantes de Lake County**. As part of its alter ego, the team uses a flaming pepper logo and wears alternate uniforms. According to MiLB.com, "Lake County's 'Picantes' moniker represents the area's spice of life, both literally and figuratively. The identity celebrates both the chile pepper's place in spicier LatinX cuisine and the community's edgier, fiery personalities."

The Captains are 1-0 as **Los Picantes de Lake County** this season, last defeating the Fort Wayne TinCaps (Las Manzanas Luchadoras de Fort Wayne) by a score of 1-0 in 10 innings. Picantes INF **Jose Devers** scored the game's only run on a throwing error after OF **Justin Boyd** hit a single. Lake County went 4-3 as **Los Picantes de Lake County** last season, and a perfect 7-0 in 2022.

CONGRATS, CCI: 19-year MLB veteran and 2007 AL Cy Young Award winner **CC Sabathia** was named the 48th member of the Cleveland Guardians Hall of Fame on Thursday. While he did not pitch for Lake County, Sabathia went 2-0 with a 1.08 ERA in three starts for its predecessor, the Columbus RedStixx (Columbus, Georgia).

21st SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,760 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,388-1,372 (.503).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

COLLADO COLLECTING BASES: Captains INF **Maick Collado** has reached base at an incredible rate in his first 17 career High-A games. The 21-year-old has a .479 OBP, which ranks 4th in the Midwest League. Collado also ranks top-10 in the MWL in batting average (.309, 10th) and walks (17, tied for 8th). He is also currently on a 16-game on-base streak, which is the second-longest active streak in the Midwest League and longest by a Captain this year. During this stretch, he is hitting .333 (17-for-51), 5 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 5 RBI, 17 walks, and a .938 OPS.

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-five in the MWL in fewest walks (26, 1st), wins (7, tied for 1st), strikeouts (129, 2nd), innings pitched (118.0, 2nd), WHIP (1.18, 3rd), and ERA (3.59, 5th).

MOONEY MAKES HISTORY: On Saturday, April 27, Captains INF **Alex Mooney**, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, tied a pair of franchise records. The 2023 7th-round pick went 5-for-5 with 3 doubles, becoming the 16th Captain to record a 5-hit game, and the 13th to record a 3-double game. Mooney recorded the first 5-hit performance by a Lake County player since **Bobby Ison** on 8/7/2016 vs. West Michigan, and the first 3-double performance since current Double-A Akron RubberDucks OF **Chase DeLauter** on 7/9/2023 at Lansing.

PLENTY OF '23 IN LC: 6 players on the Captains' current active roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF/OF **C.J. Kayfus** was drafted in Round 3, C **Cooper Ingle** in Round 4, INF **Alex Mooney** in Round 7, OF **Jonah Advincula** in Round 8, RHP **Jay Driver** in Round 9, and RHP **Zane Morehouse** in Round 14.

The Lake County bullpen has pitched 14 straight scoreless innings, which date back to the team's 7-6 win vs. Fort Wayne on May 1. The Captains' bullpen ranks 4th in the MWL with a 3.51 ERA so far this season.

The only other 2 duos to both have this rank are Double-A Spokane's Chase Doldander & Sean Sullivan and Triple-A Norfolk's Cade Povich & Chayce McDermott.

LAST TIME OUT: Austin Peterson (3-1) started Game 1 of this week's series on April 30 and recorded the longest outing by a Captains pitcher so far this year. The right-hander went a season-high 7.2 scoreless innings, allowing 4 hits and a season-high 1 walk (tied), and throwing 6 strikeouts in 86 pitches (67 strikes). **Peterson** earned his third victory of the season, recording his second quality start of the year.

OFF TO A STELLAR HIGH-A START: Through his first five High-A starts, **Peterson** leads the Midwest League with 28.2 innings pitched, and is tied with Captains teammate **Parker Messick** and Cedar Rapids' Andrew Morris for the Midwest League lead with 33 strikeouts. He also ranks tied for 3rd in WHIP (0.94) and 8th in ERA (2.51).

2024 AGAINST THE TINCAPS: In 2 starts against Fort Wayne, **Peterson** is 1-1 with a 0.74 ERA, 14 strikeouts and 1 walk in 12.2 innings of work. Back on April 13, he fanned 8 and walked none in 5 innings in his first career High-A road start.

2023 IN REVIEW: Peterson made 24 starts with Single-A Lynchburg last season, which were tied for the most in the Carolina League with RHP and fellow Hillcat **Alonzo Richardson**, as well as Charleston RiverDogs (TB) RHP **Marcus Johnson**. Peterson recorded 4 quality starts, tied for the third-most in the Carolina League.

POUNDING THE ZONE: Last year, **Peterson** finished fourth in the Carolina League with 102 strikeouts. He also ranked second in the Cleveland player development system with a 3.78 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and posted the second-lowest walk rate among qualified arms in the Carolina League (5.4%). The right-hander threw 1,219 strikes, the second-most in the Carolina League.

THE GREAT EIGHT: In 2023, **Peterson** posted two starts of 8.0 shutout innings on June 30 versus the Delmarva Shorebirds (BAL) and July 21 versus the Fayetteville Woodpeckers (HOU). He threw just 83 and 84 pitches, respectively, in these starts, retiring 48 of a combined 55 batters faced.

A STAR IN STORRS: After making 25 appearances at Purdue in 2019 and 5 appearances at Wabash Valley Community College (IL) in 2020, **Peterson** was a two-time All-Big East pitcher at UConn. In just two seasons with the Huskies, he struck out 226 batters, tied for the sixth-most in program history. In 2022, the right-hander was named a 1st Team NCBWA All-American, NCBWA District Co-Player of the Year, New England Pitcher of the Year, and 1st Team All-Big East. In his final year with the Huskies, **Peterson** struck out a program-record 147 batters, the third-most in the country. He also went 8+ innings in three starts. In 2021, **Peterson** was named 2nd Team All-Big East, ranking fourth in the conference with a 2.58 ERA, and leading the conference with 33 strikeouts looking.

BOILERMAKER BEGINNINGS: Peterson began his college career at Purdue, where he led its freshman class with 49 strikeouts, 25 appearances, and 48.0 innings pitched. He earned his first college victory on March 9, 2019, pitching a season-high 5.1 innings of relief and fanning a then-career-best 9 batters in the 9-8 win.
